We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.

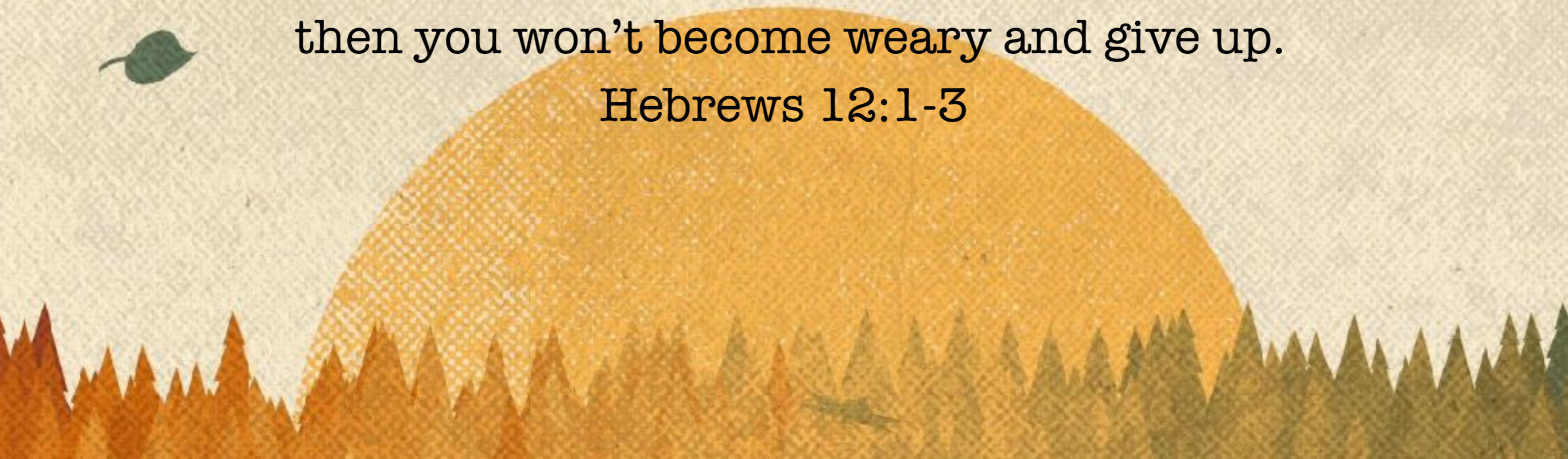
Because of the joy awaiting him,
