Were no match for Your love



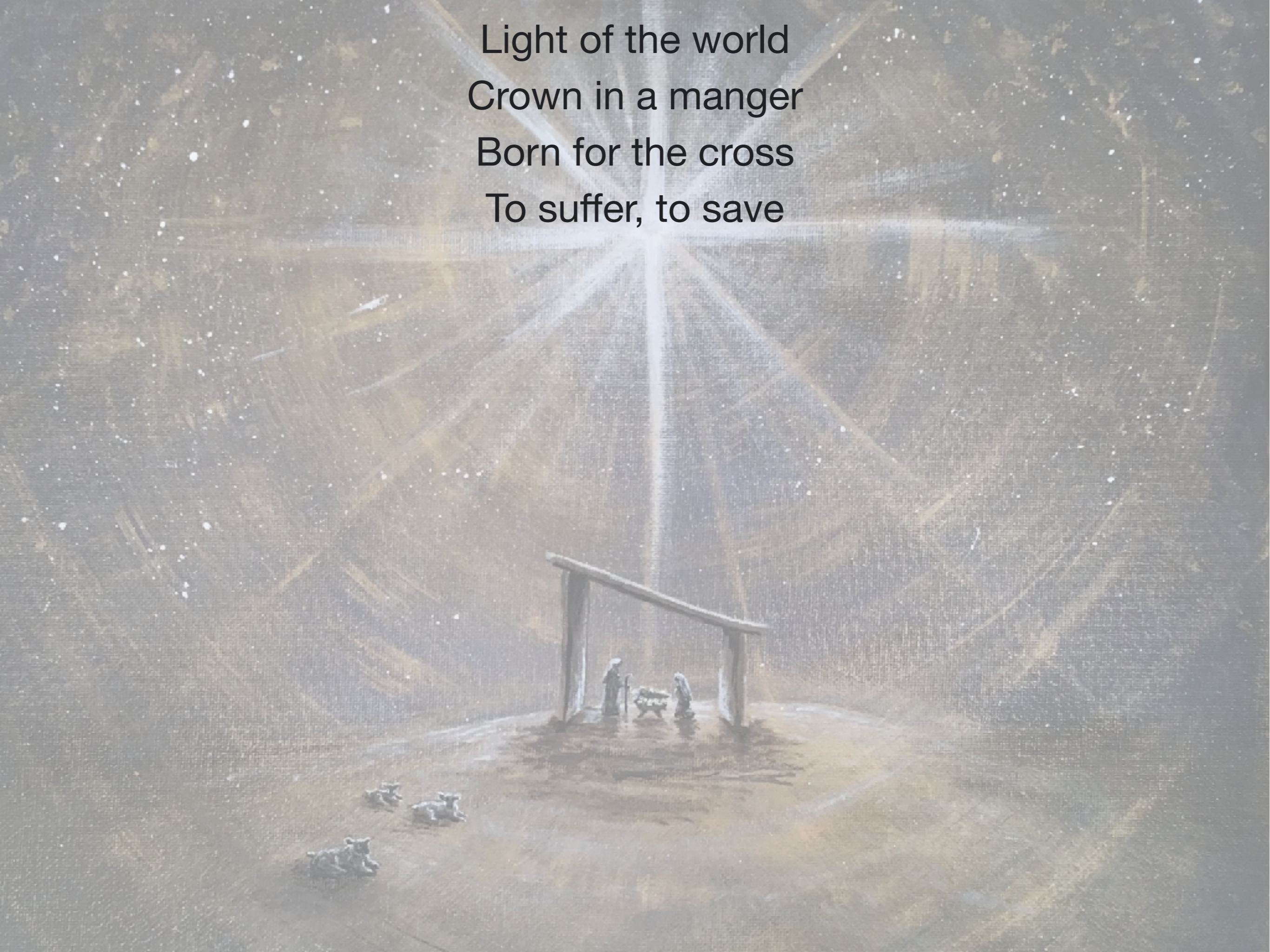

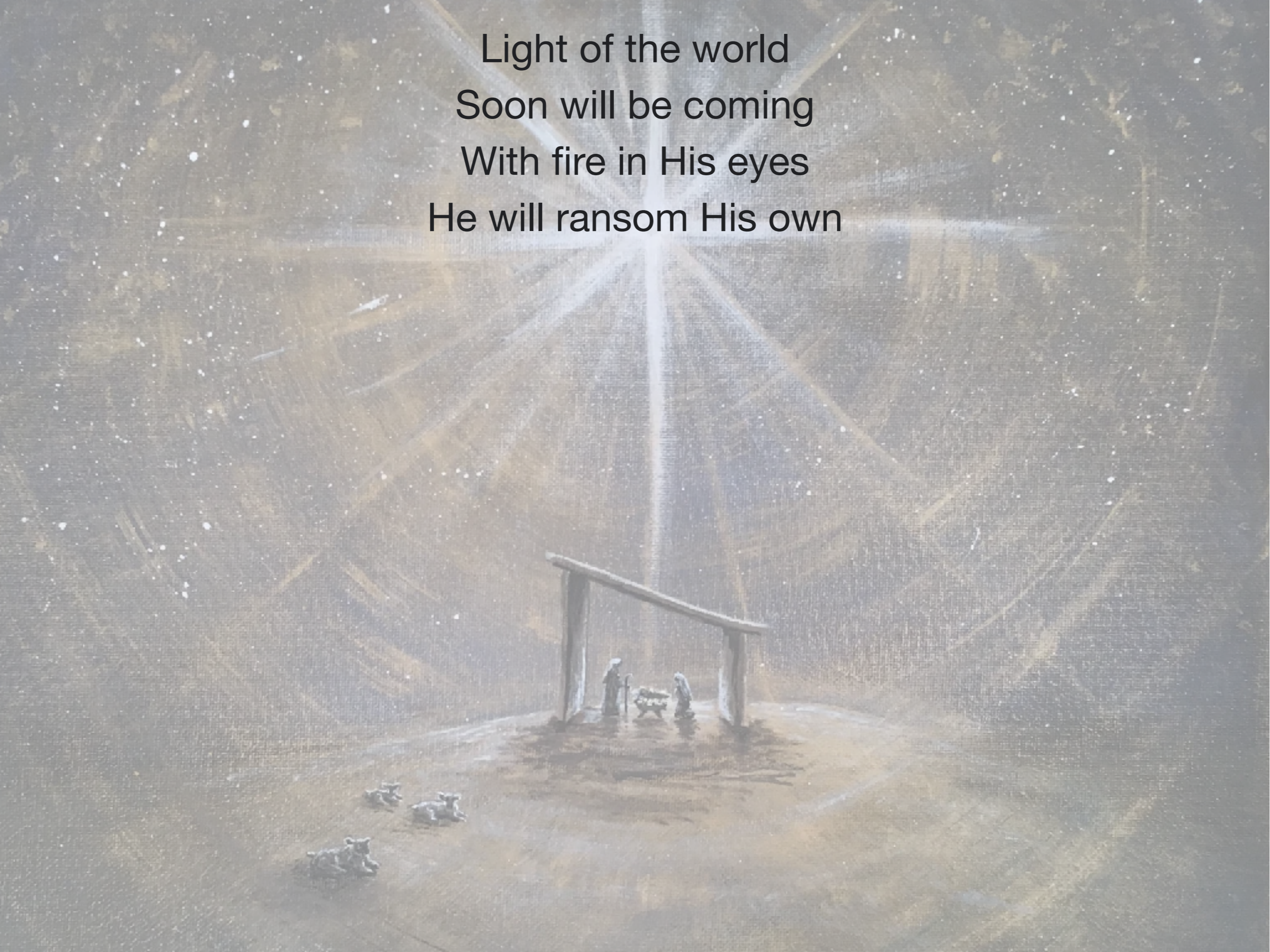

Giving glory to Immanuel!

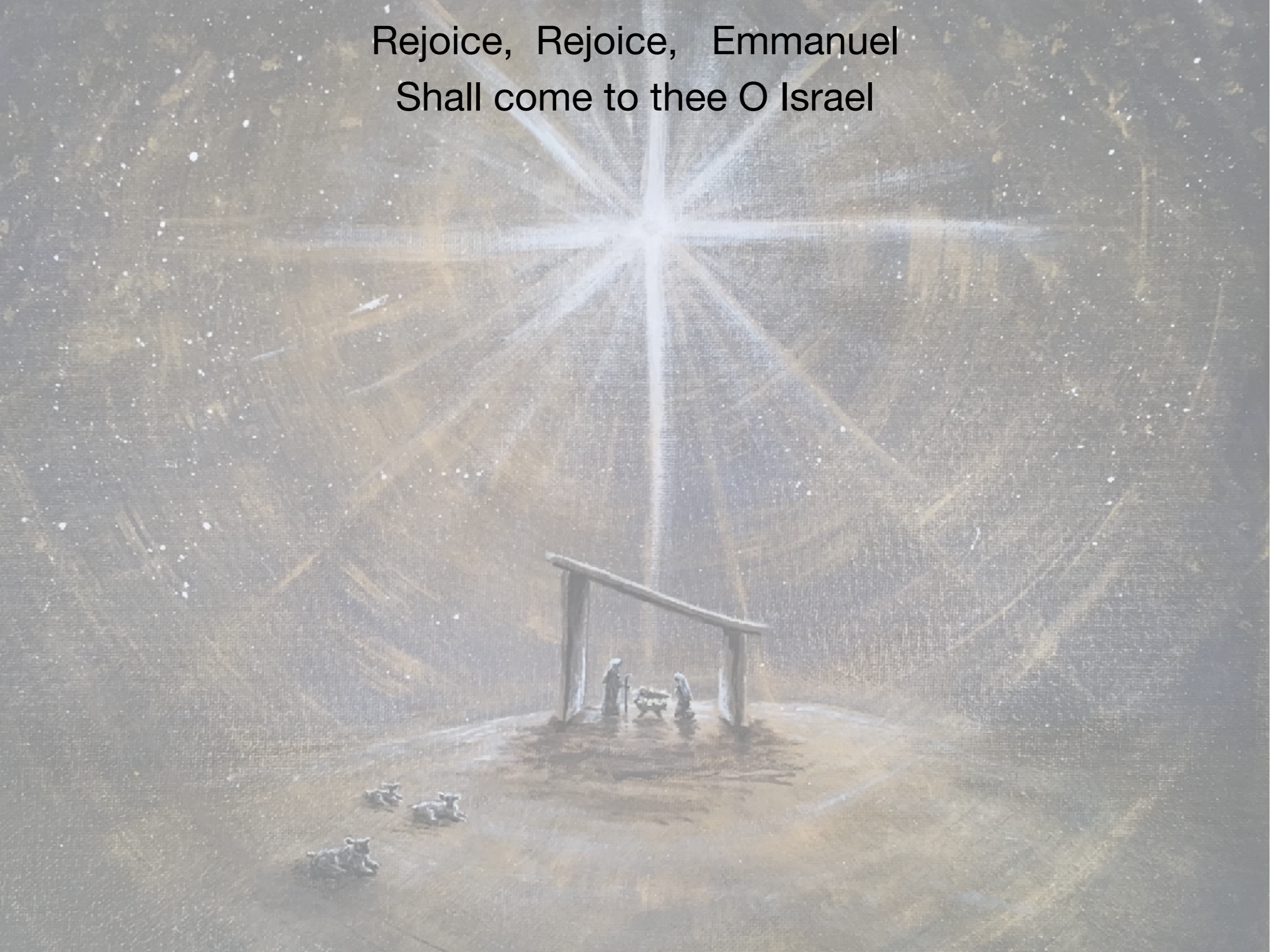


O Come O Come Emmanuel (Veni Emmanuel)

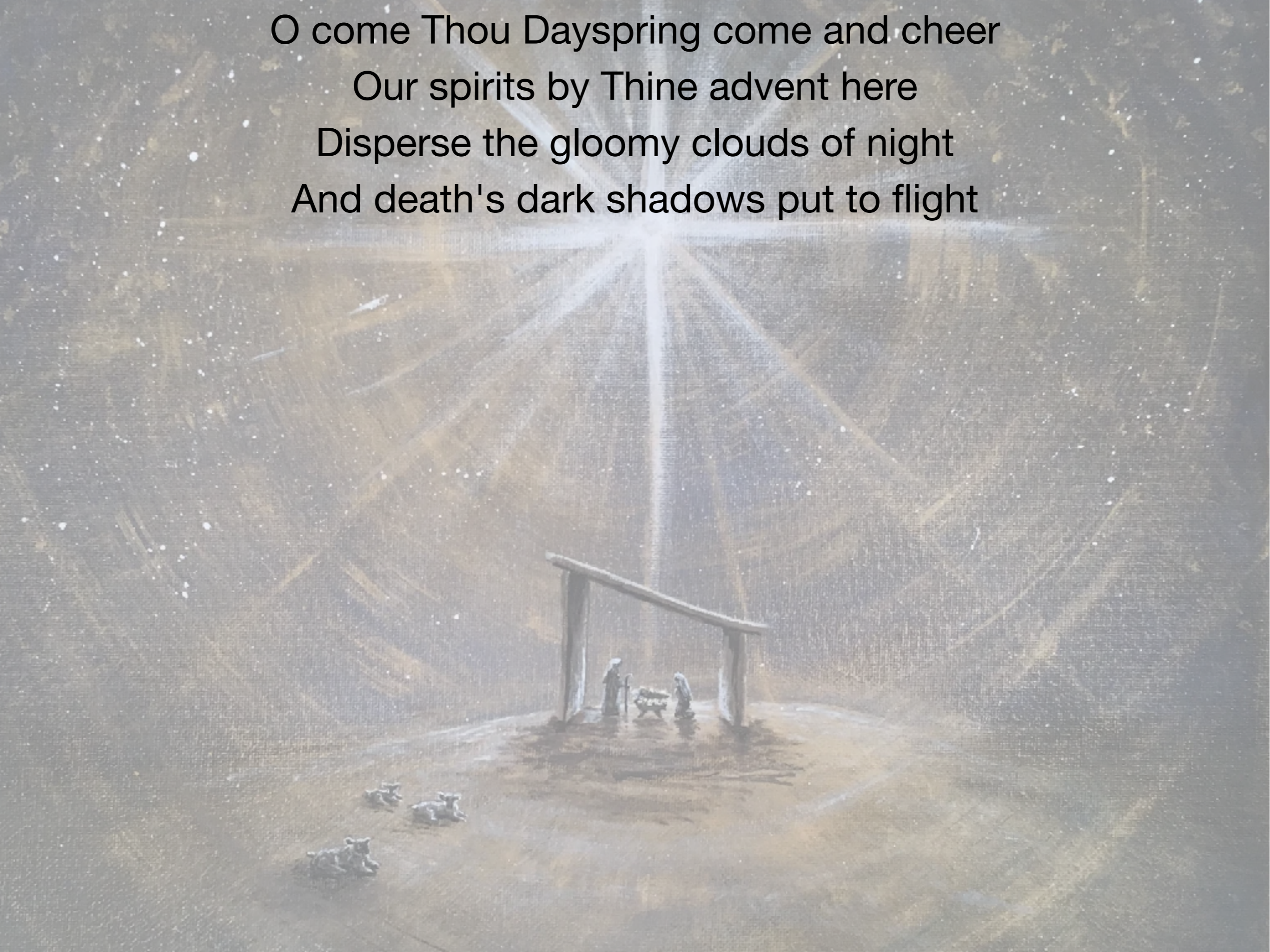
O come O come Emmanuel

Until the Son of God appear



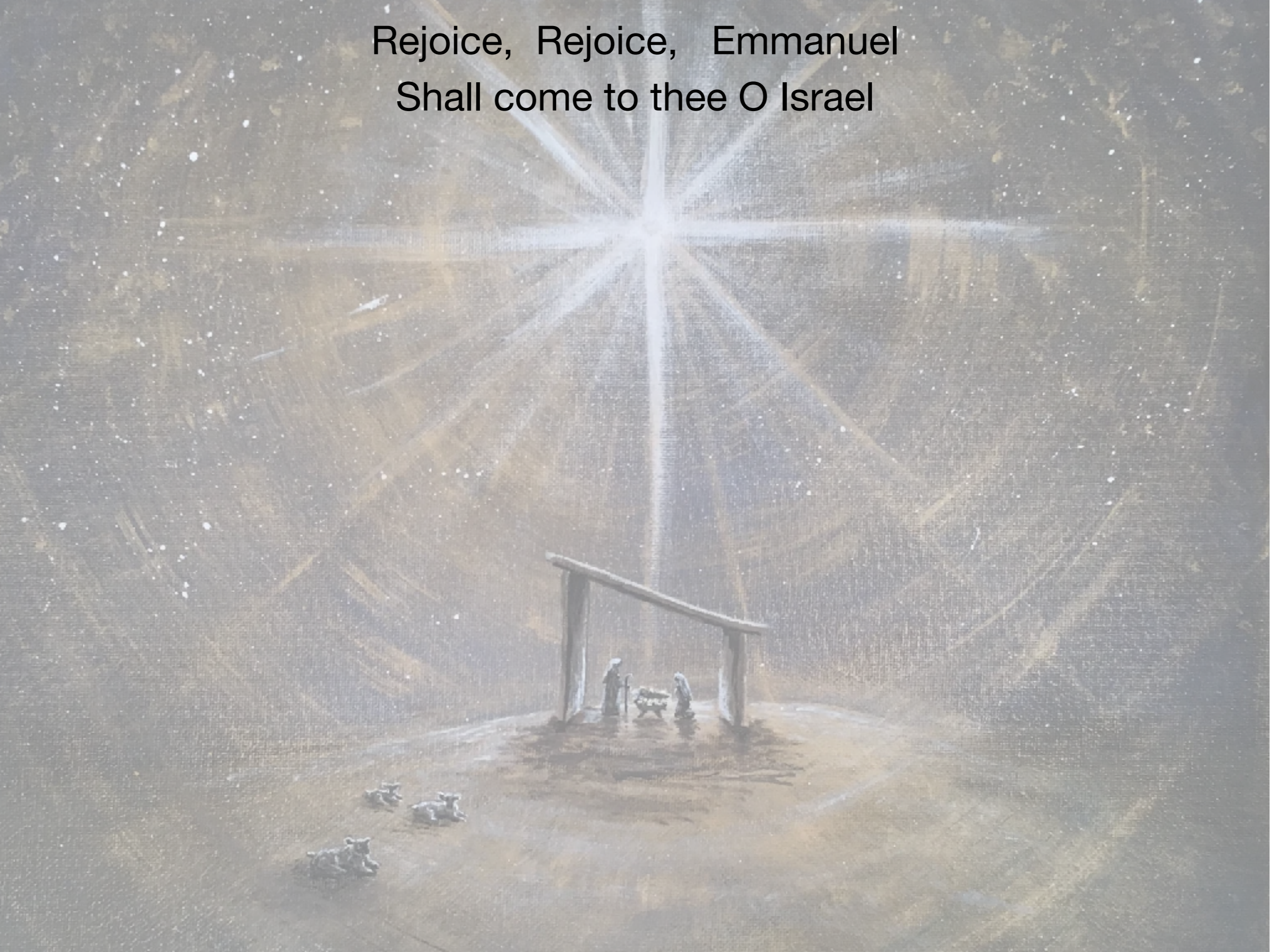
Rejoice, Rejoice, Emmanuel

And death's dark shadows put to flight



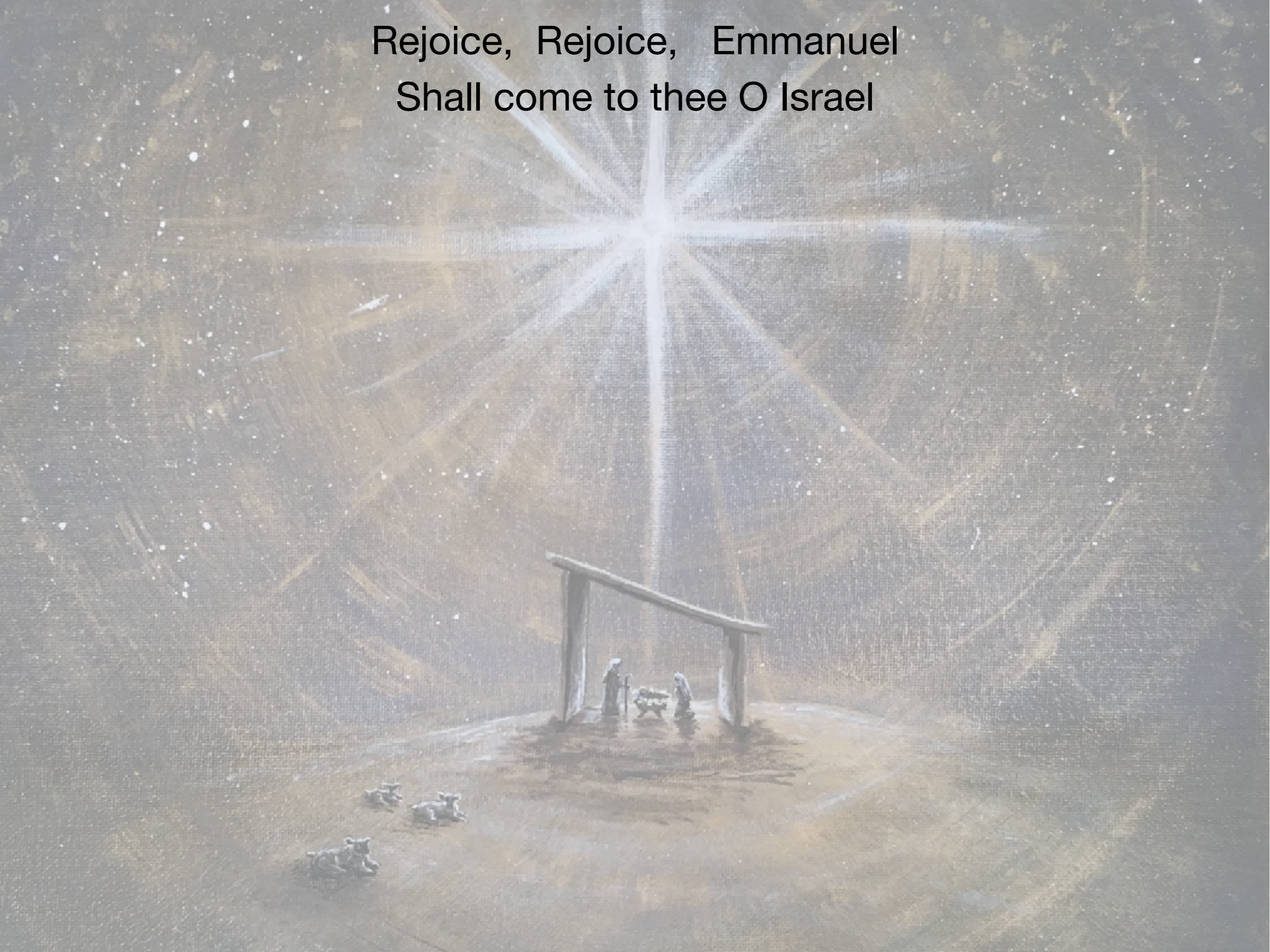


