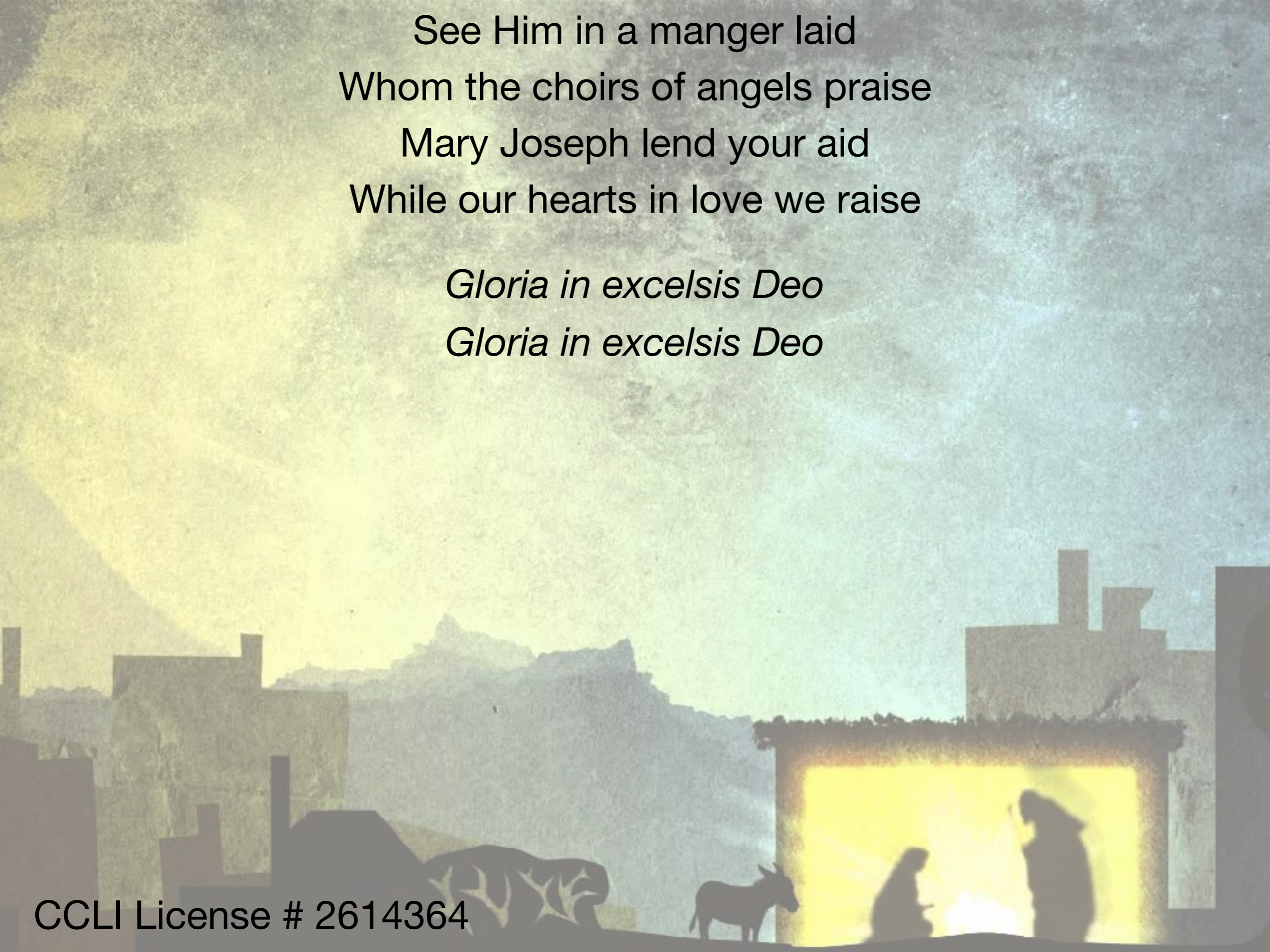



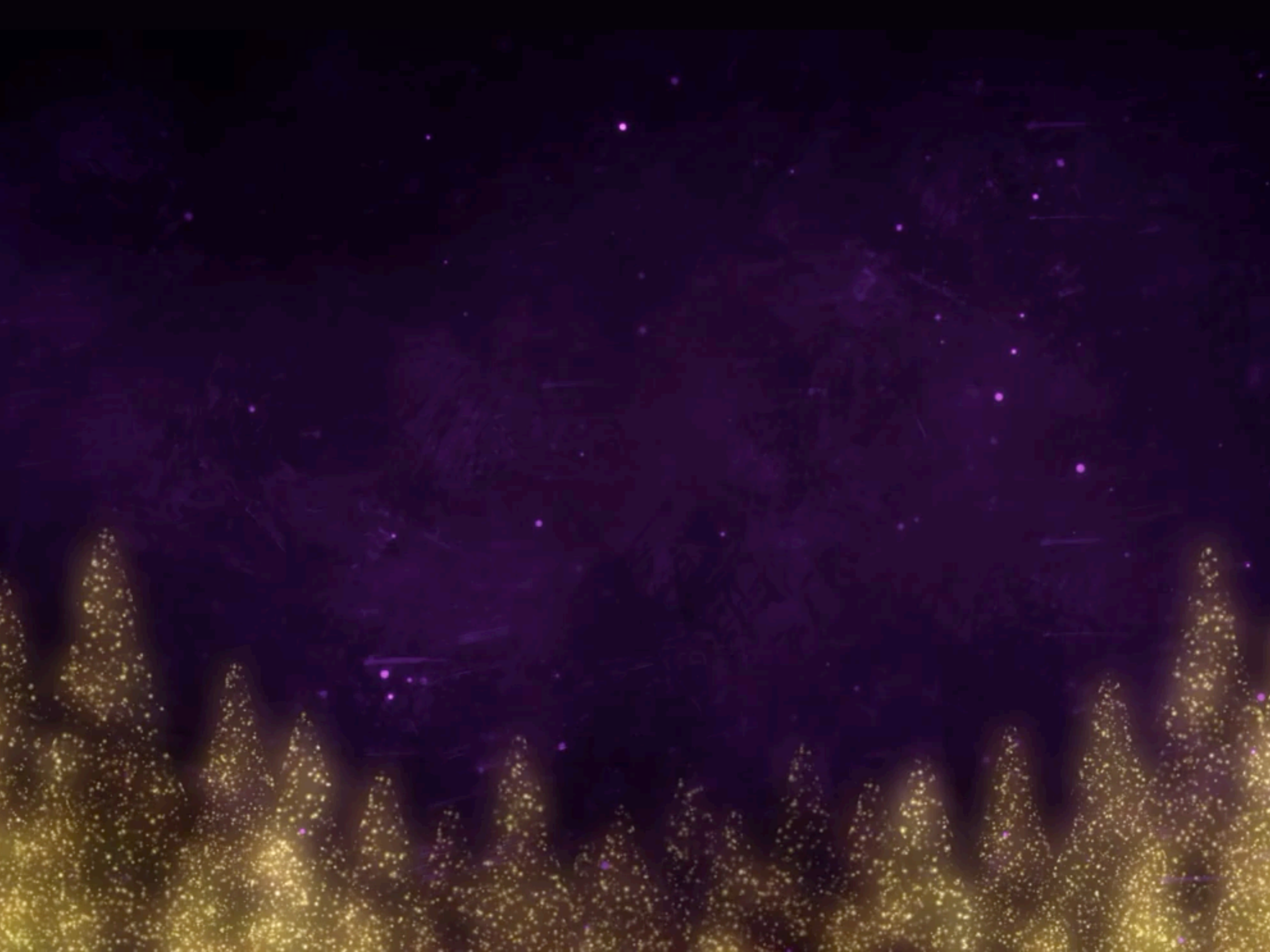

God has come to dwell with us



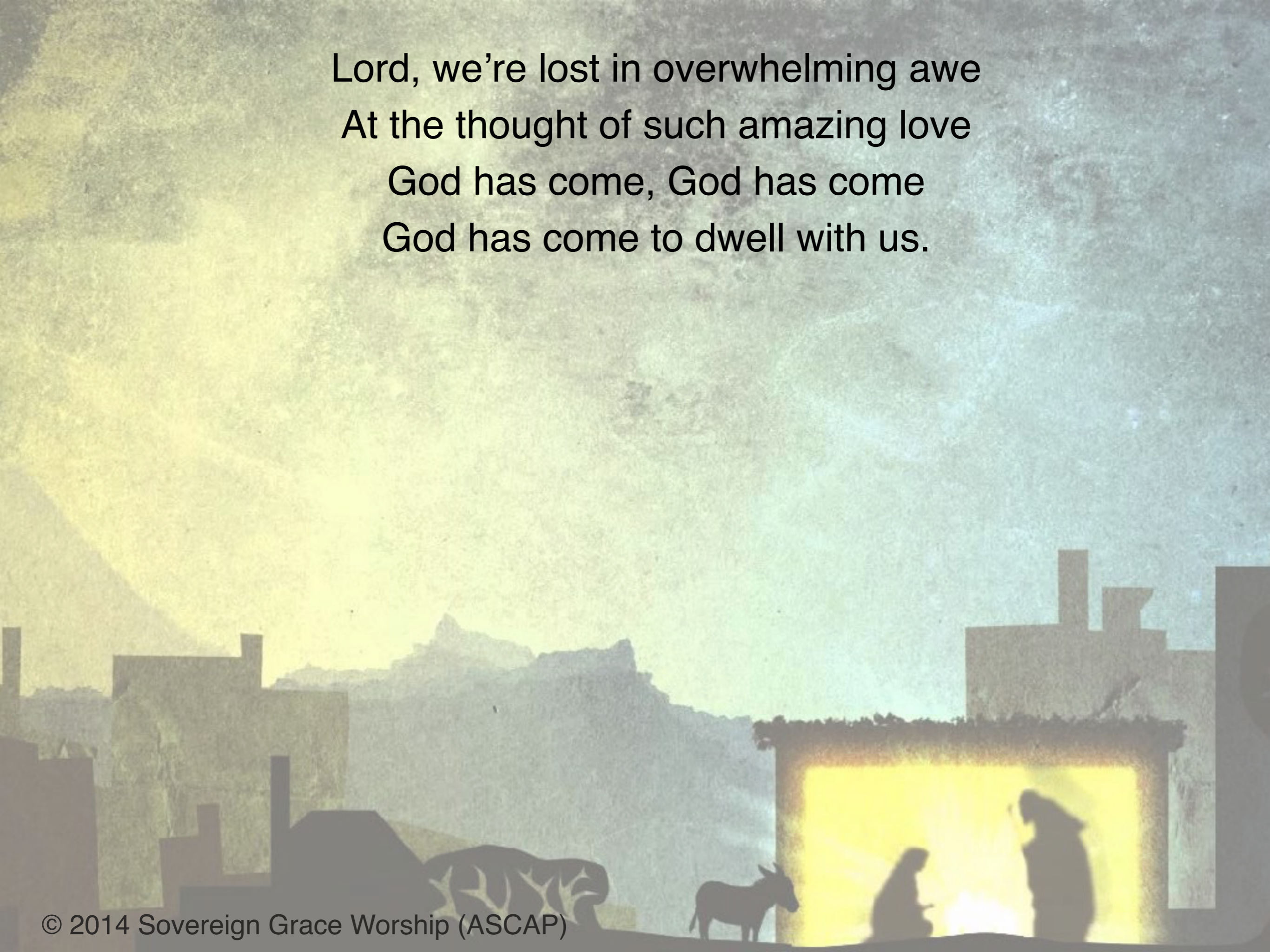
Heaven's joy will drink our bitter cup
