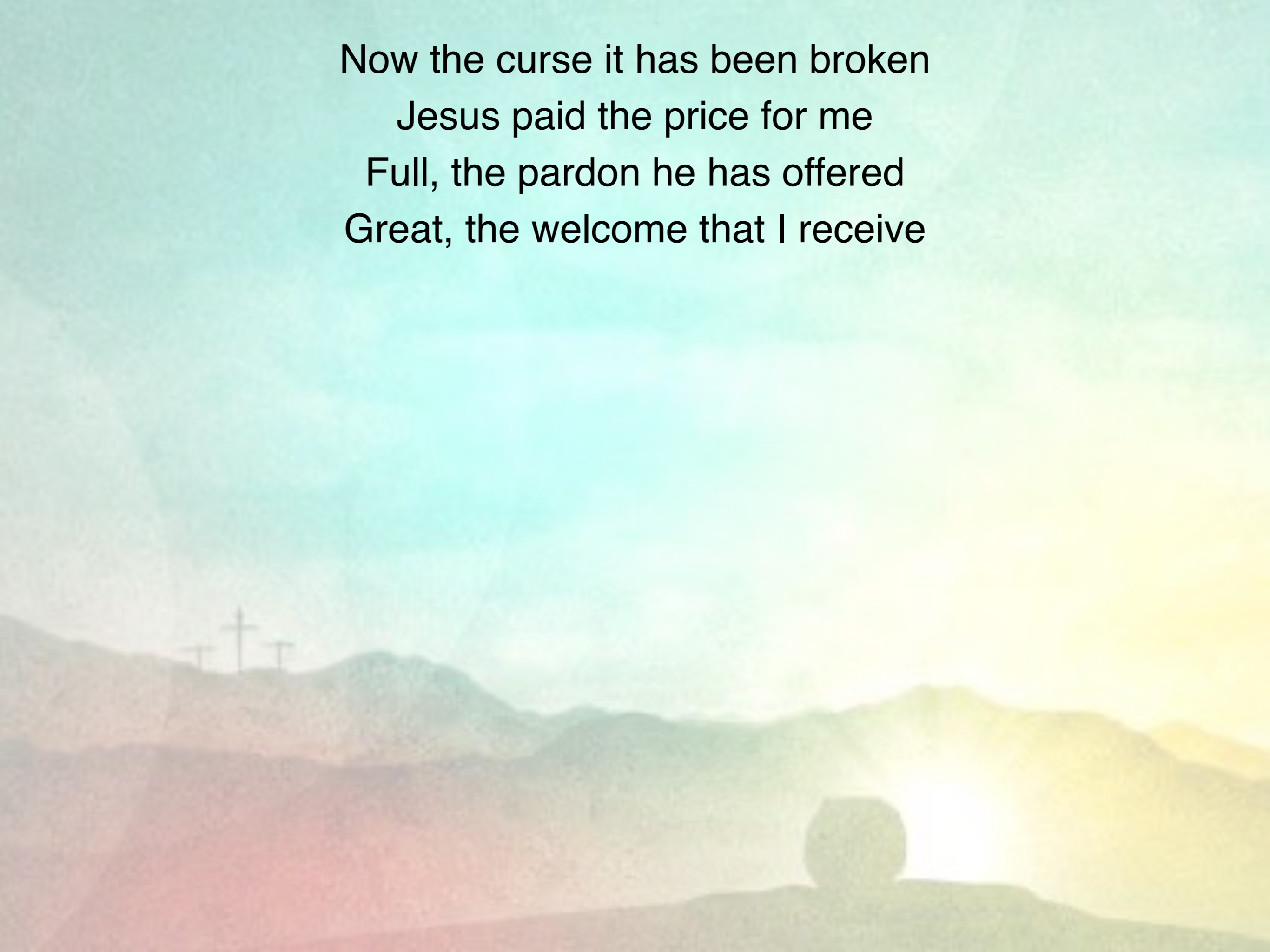
How I love the voice of Jesus

He has spoken this hope to me



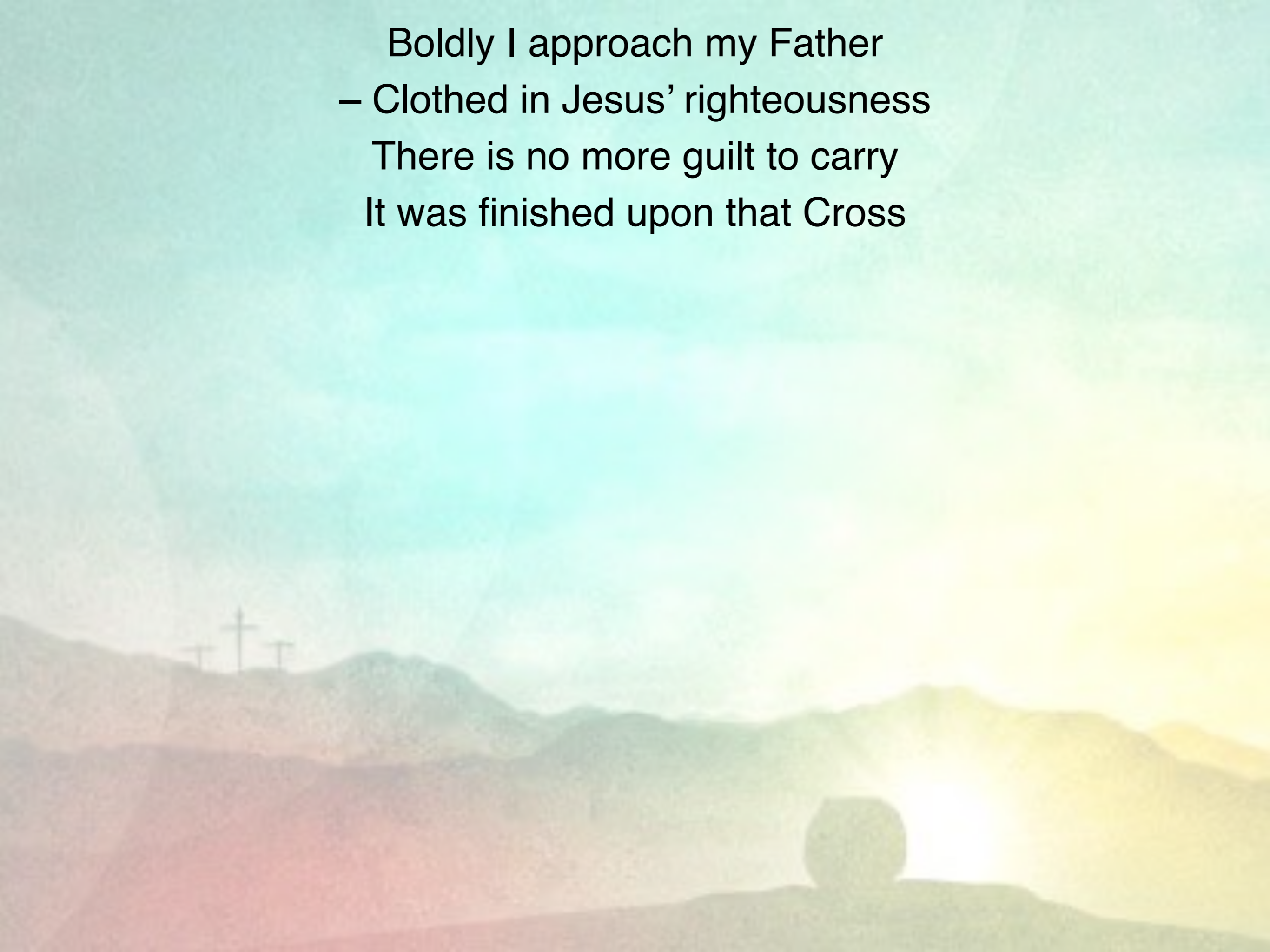

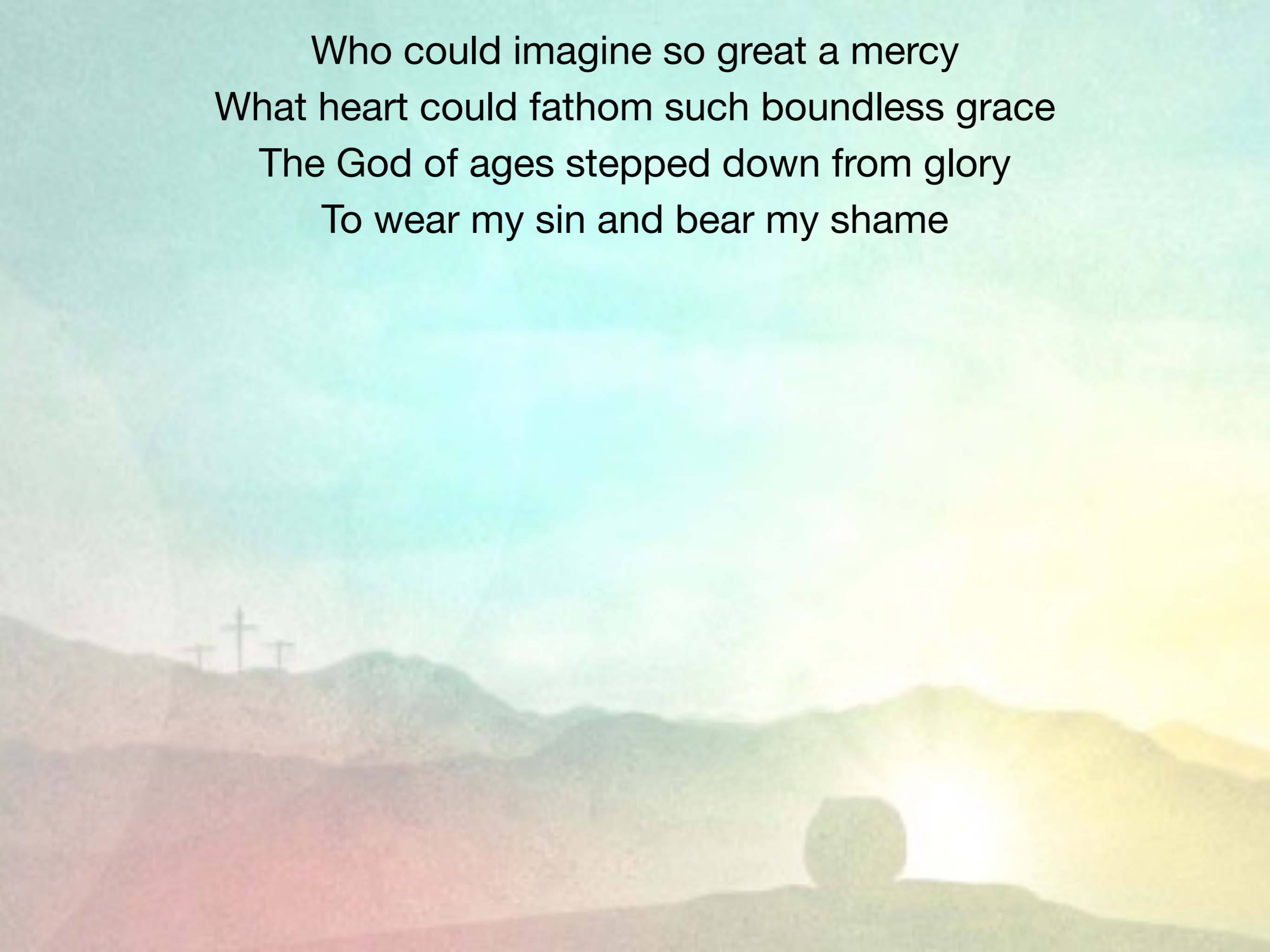
How great the chasm that lay between us
