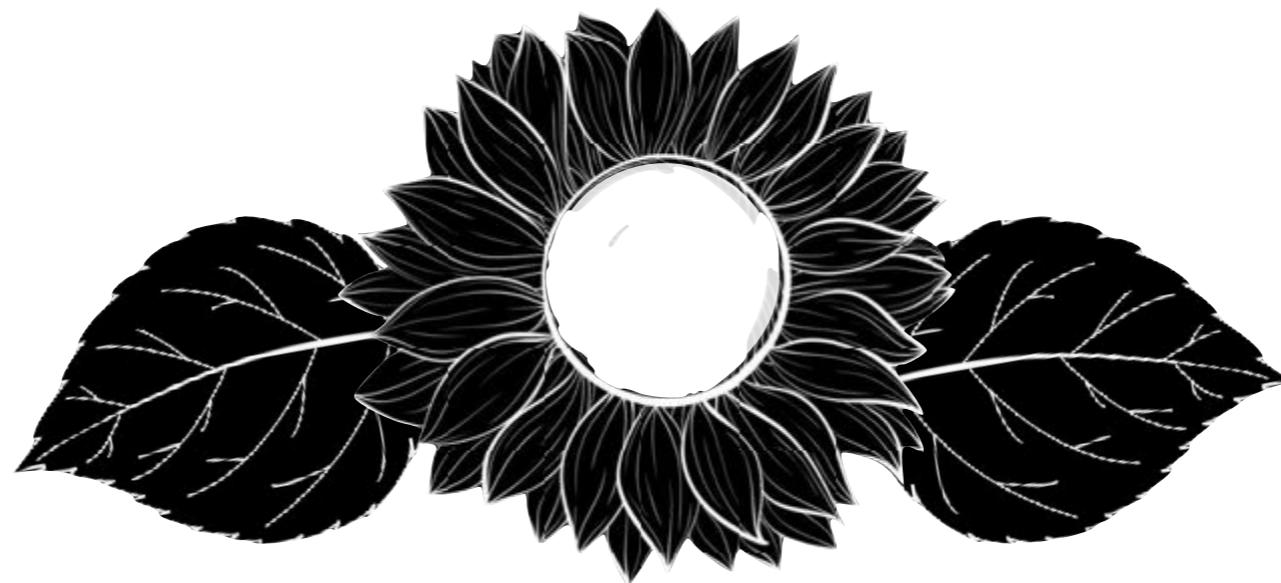


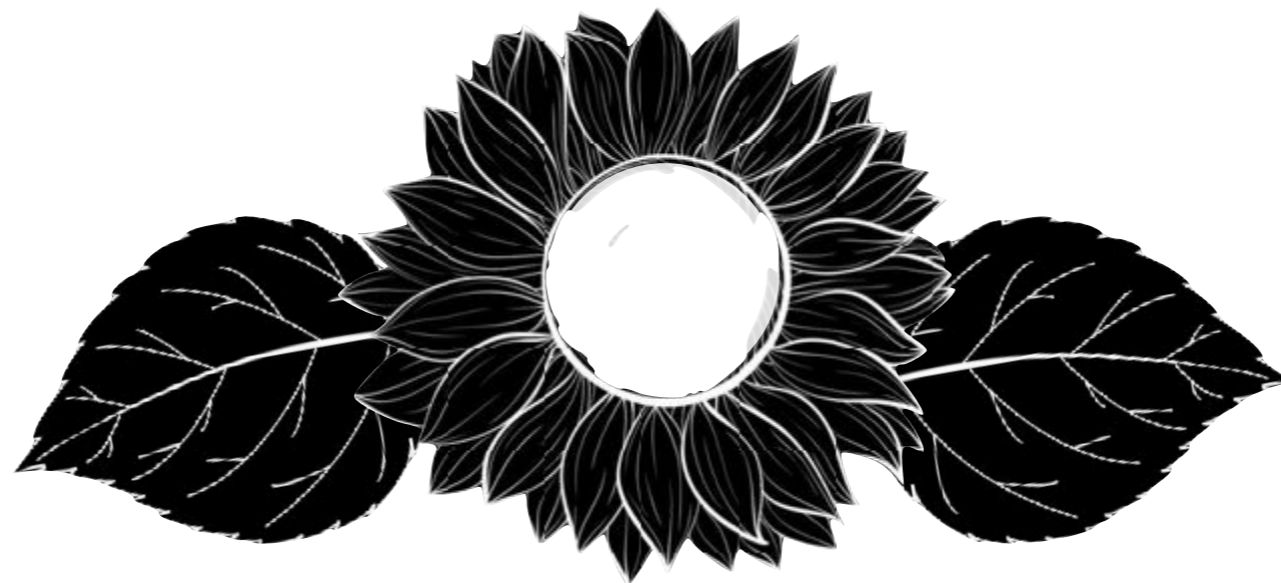


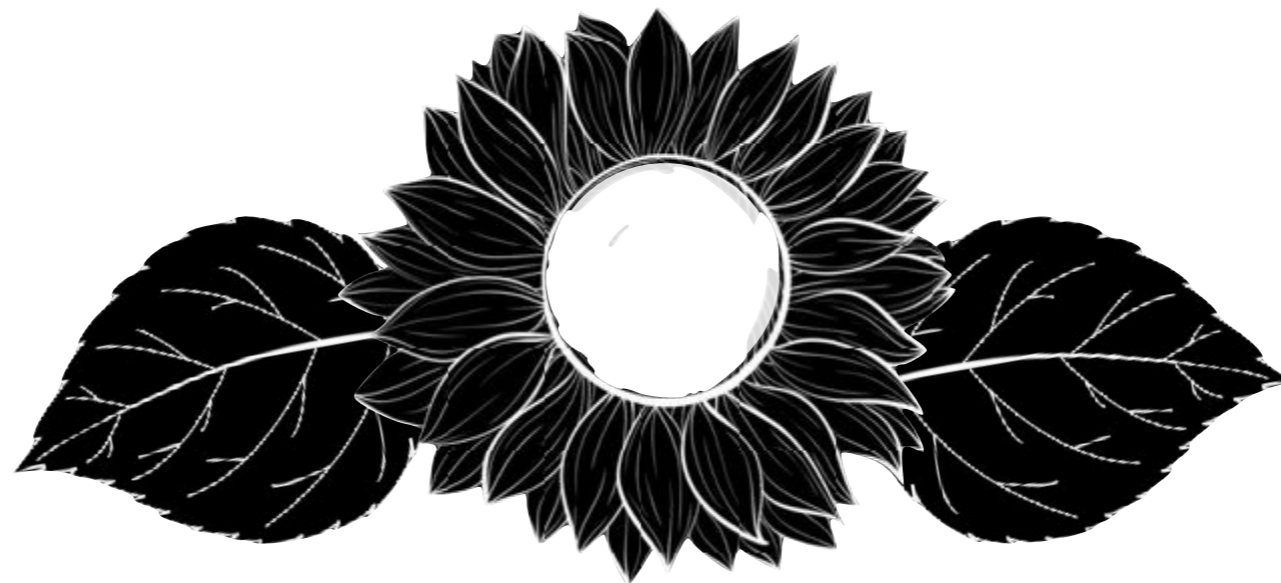


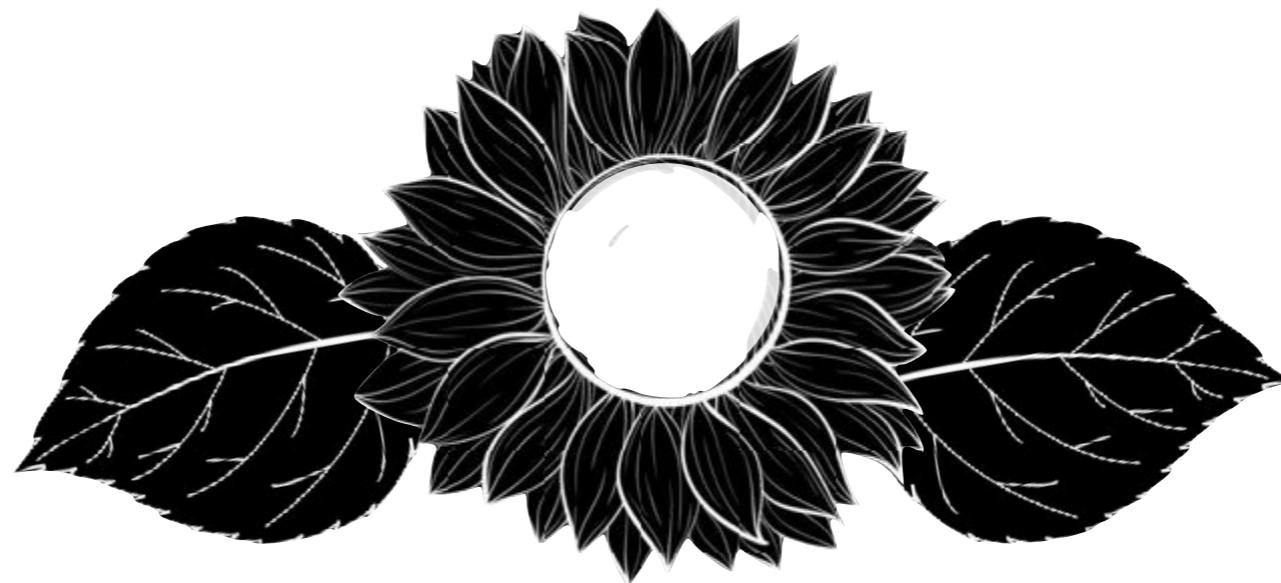












It was the precious blood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God.

Through Christ you have come to trust in God.

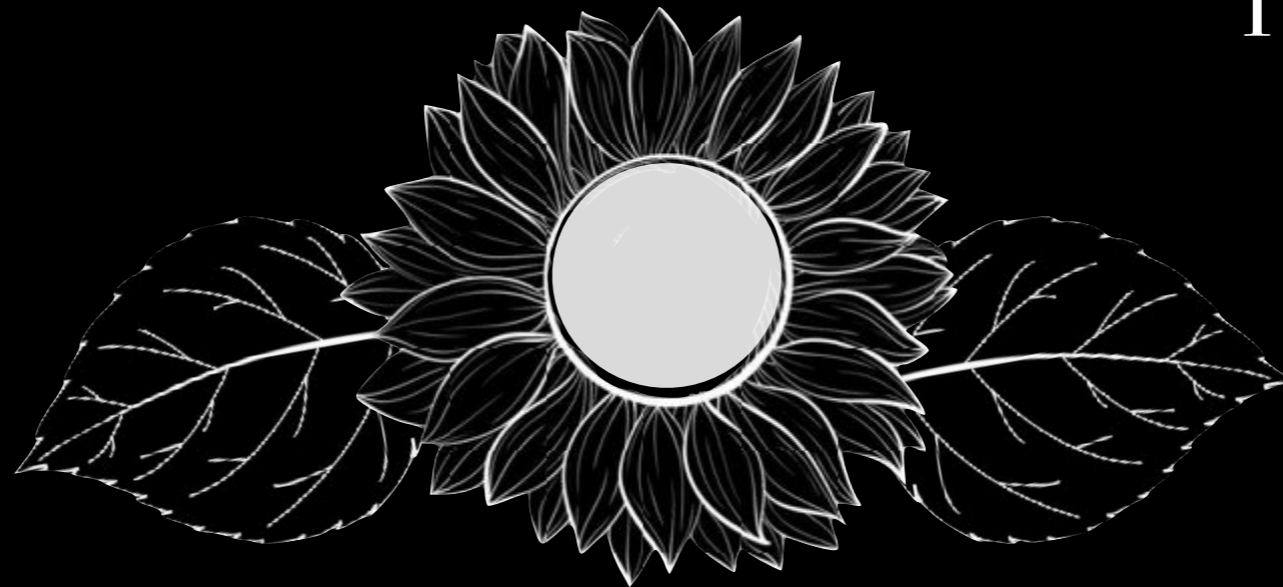

Thrown into a sea without bottom or shore

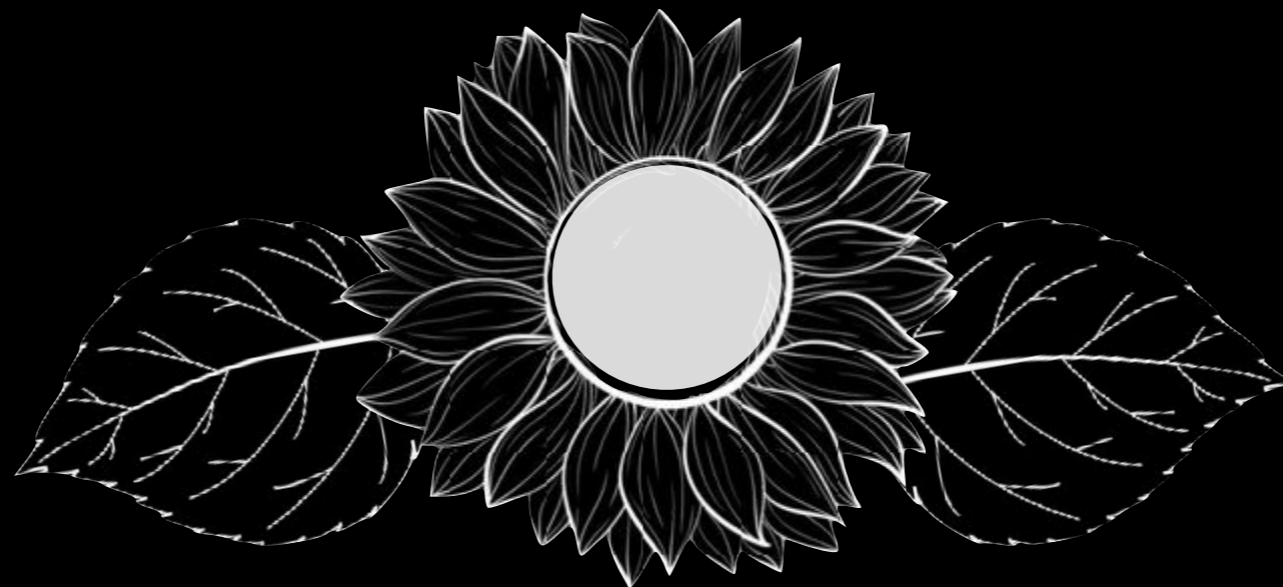

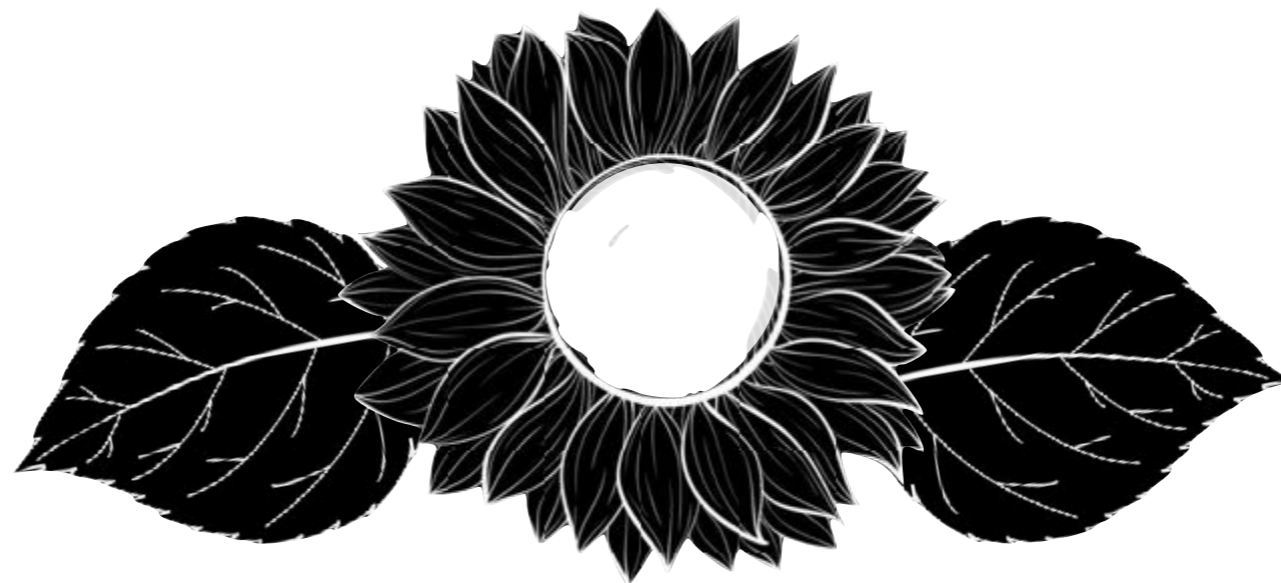


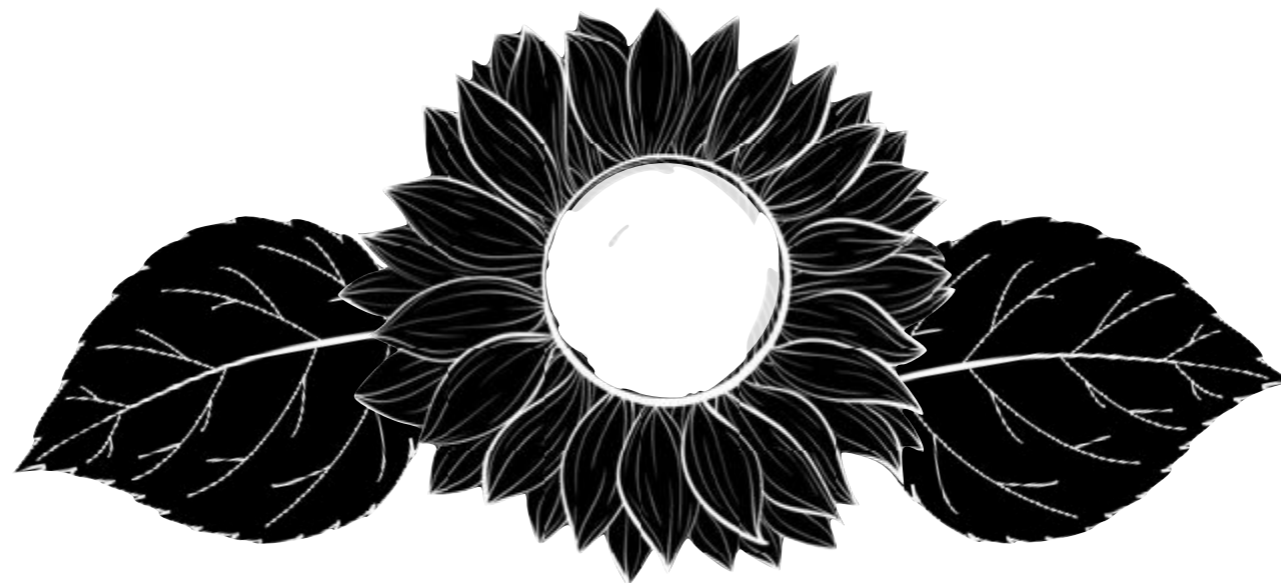


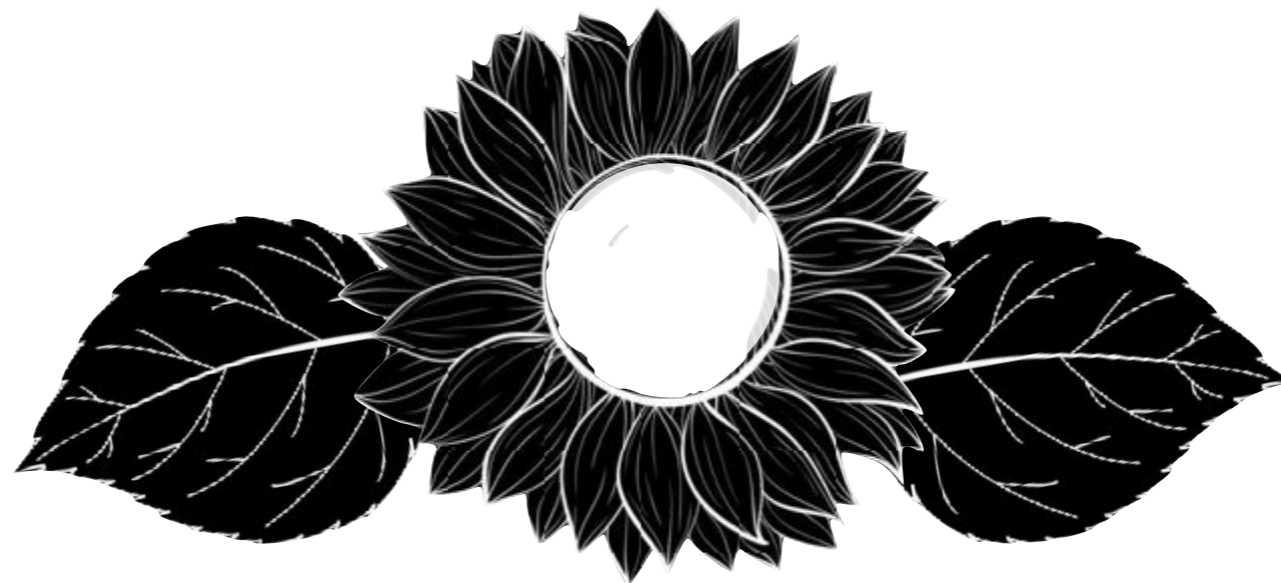






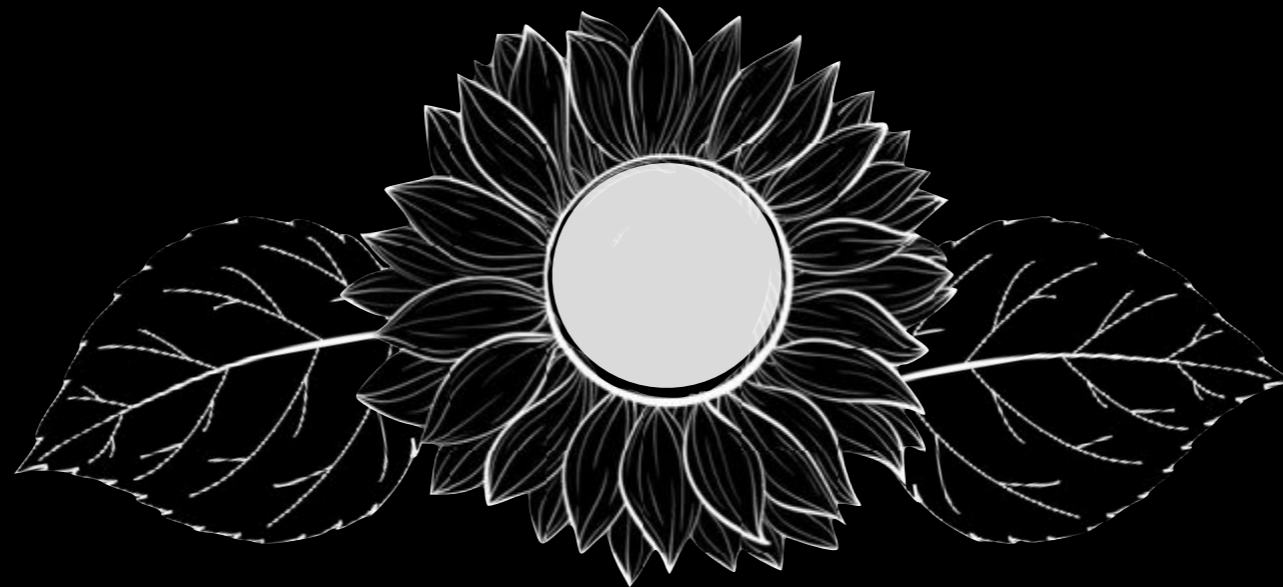




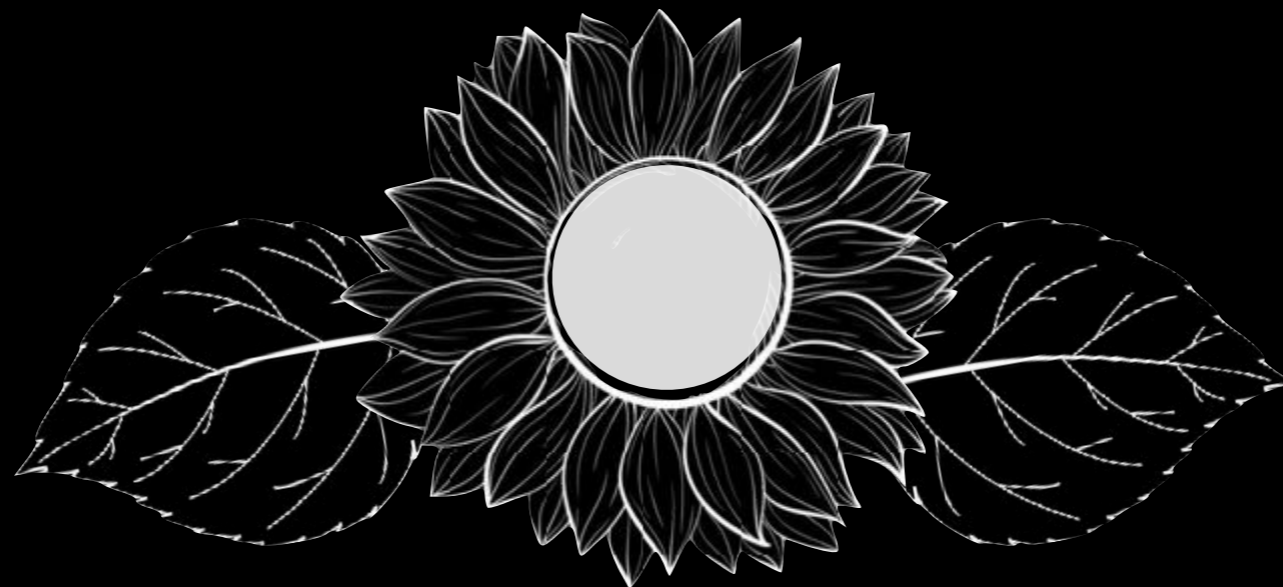


# I Will Trust my Savior Jesus

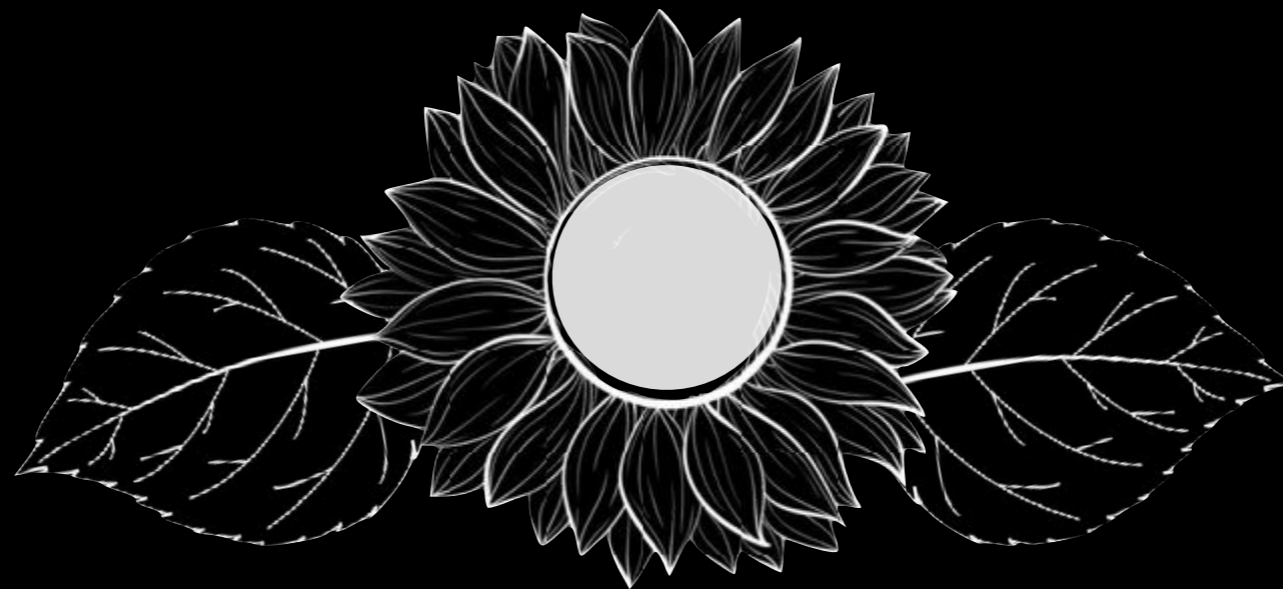
I will trust my Savior Jesus,

Seems the hardest thing of all



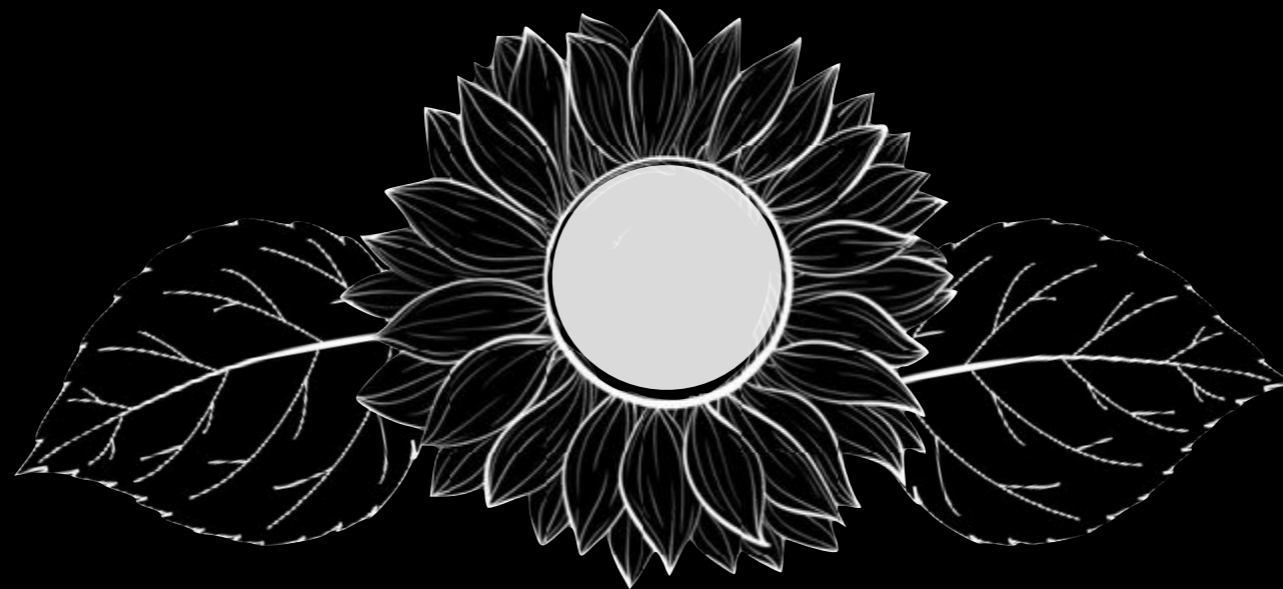

Is the safest place of all



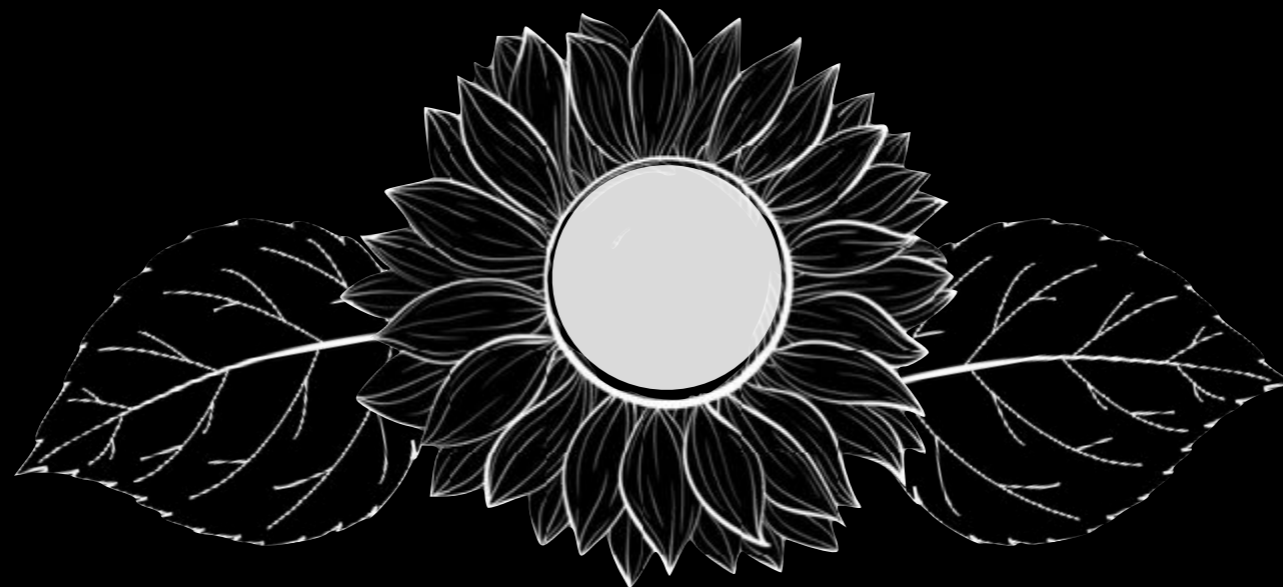

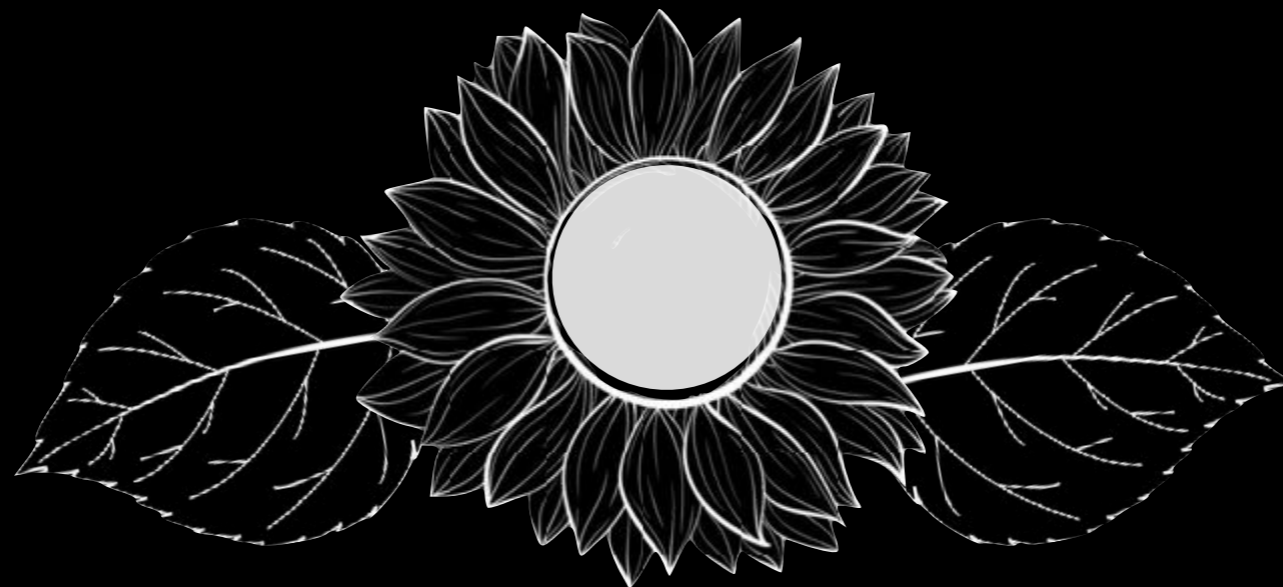


# BLESSED IS THE ONE

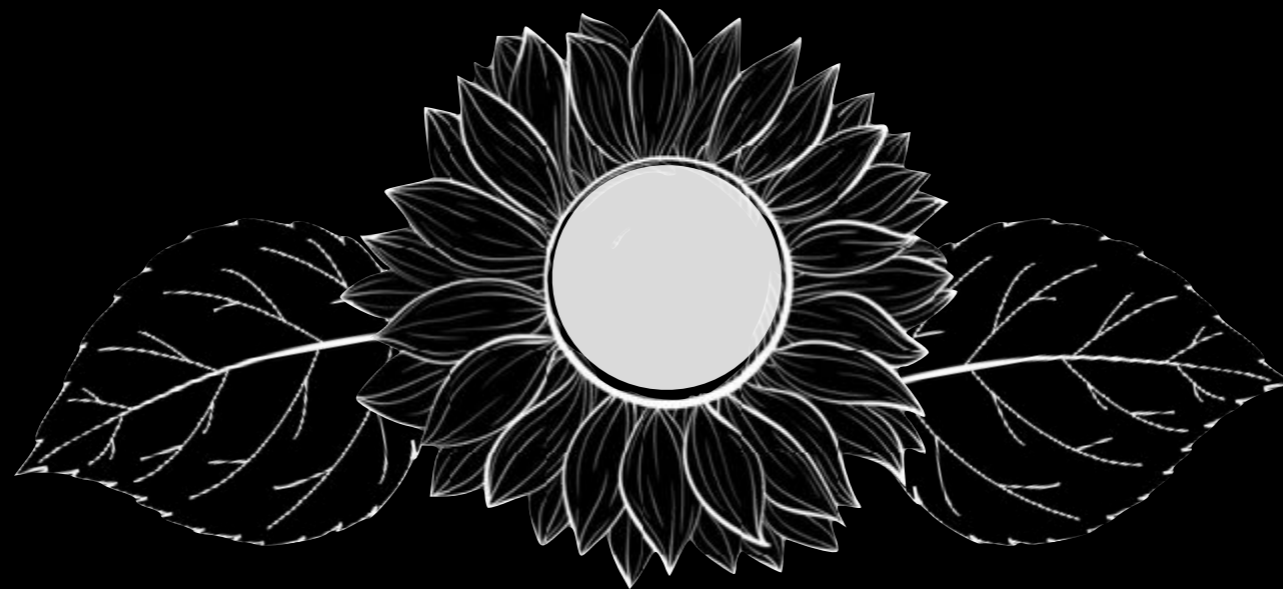
Blessed is the one;

Deep within His grace



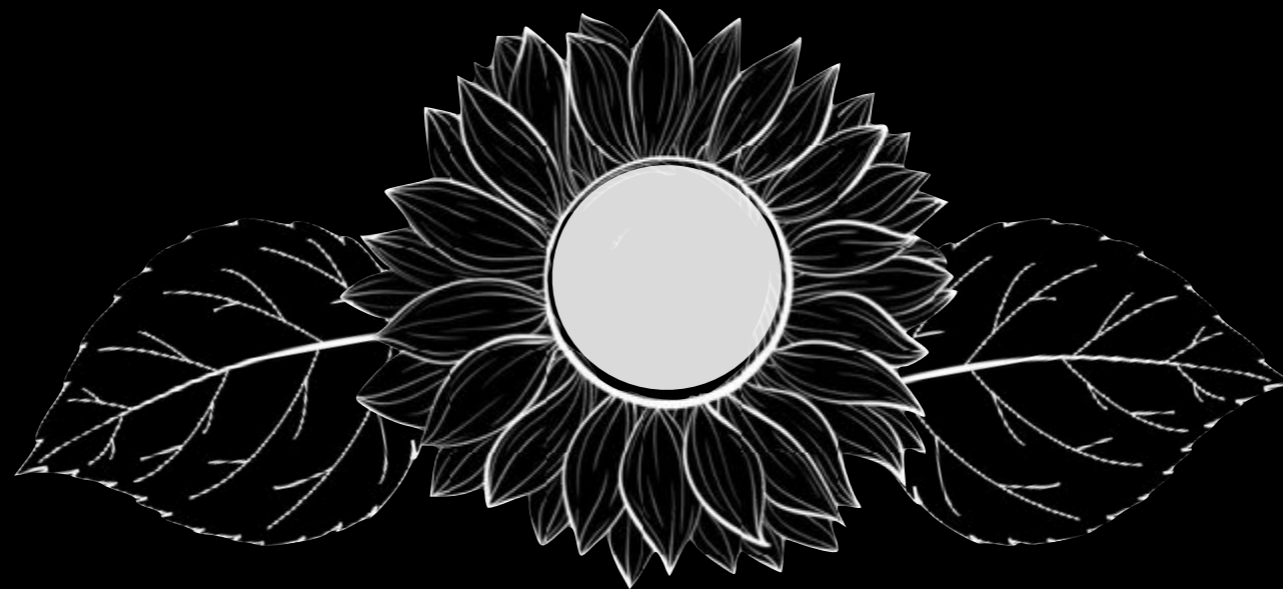

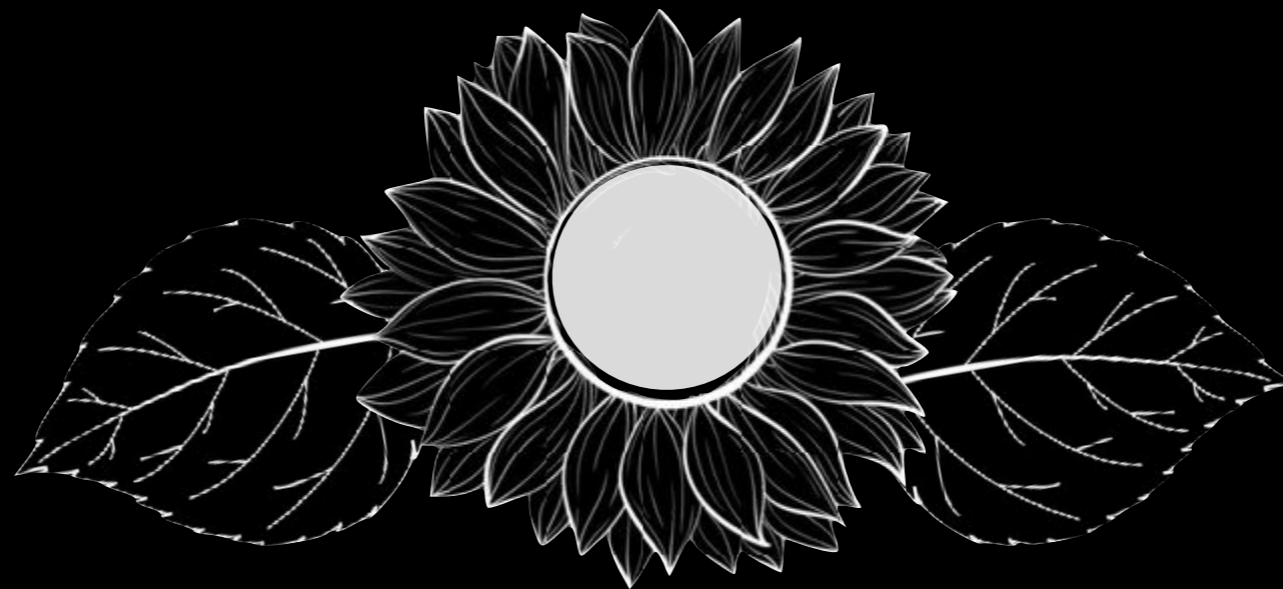

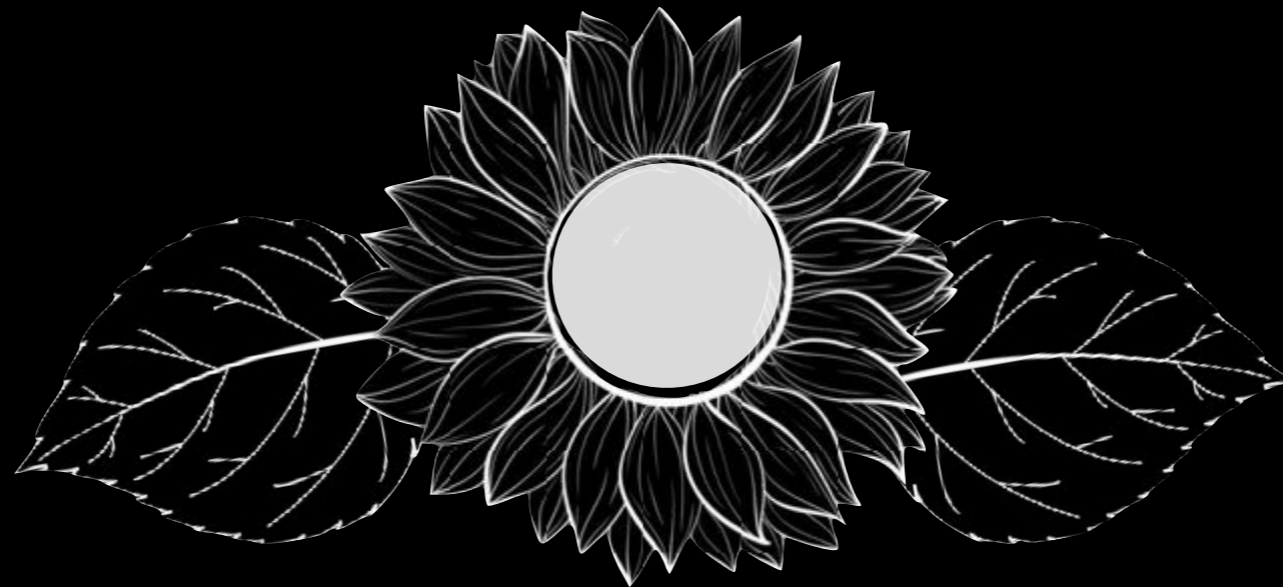
