And peace upon the earth



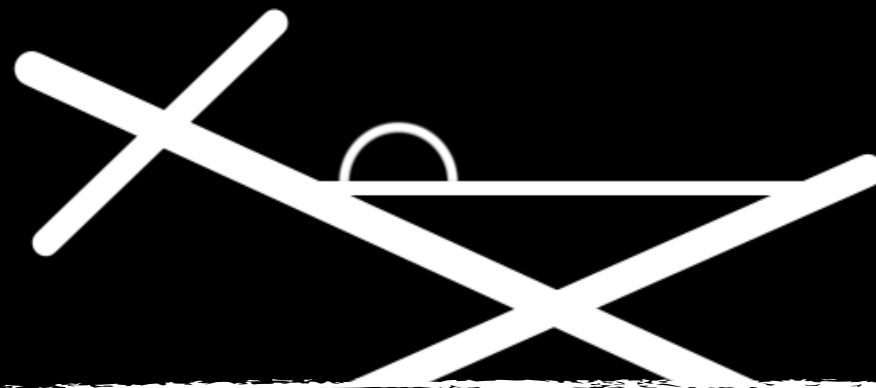

O crown Him all the world



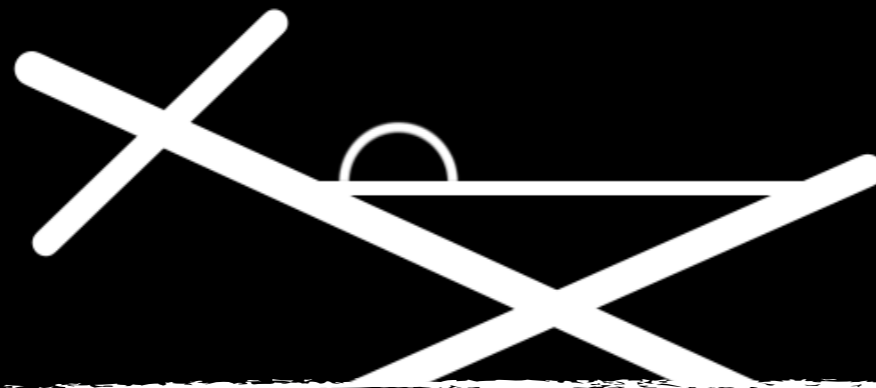

All music but its own



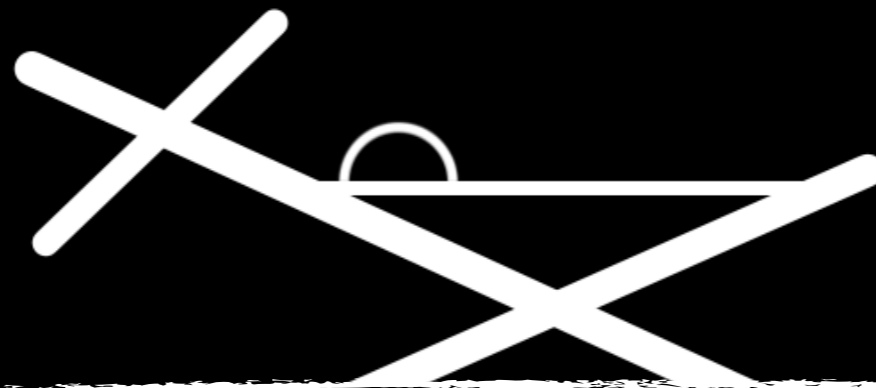

There in the stable the hope of our hearts



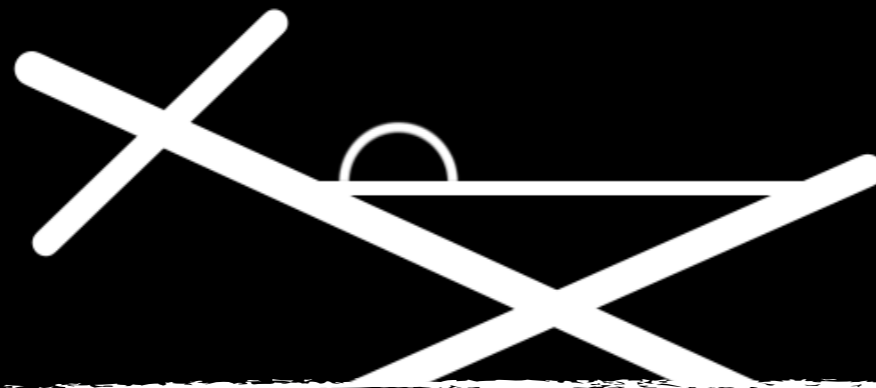

Opening to the sun above



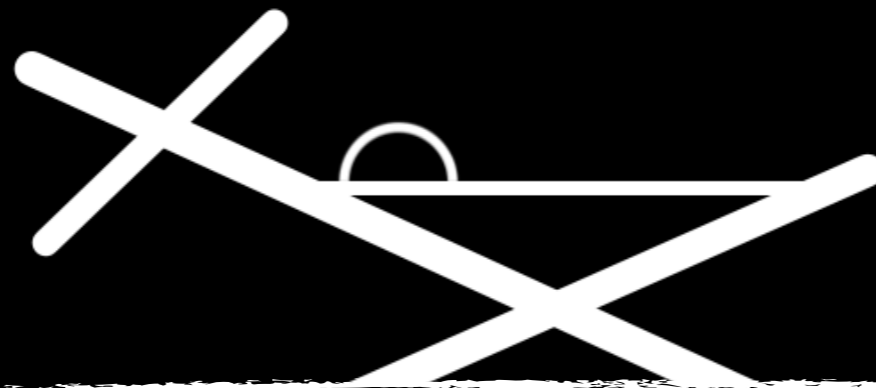
Melt the clouds of sin and sadness

Fill us with the light of day



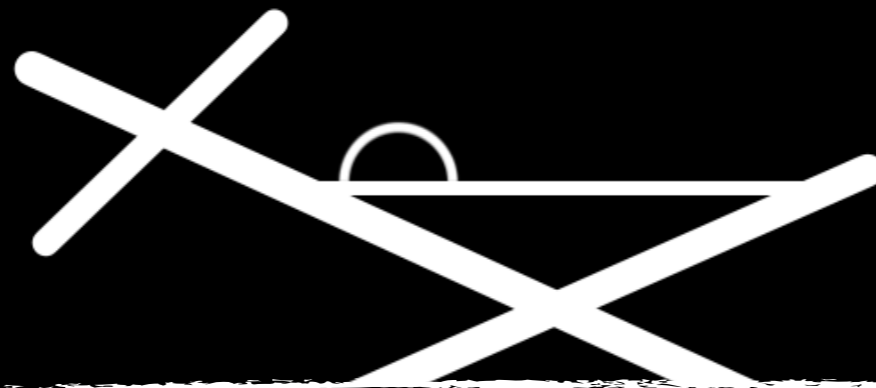
Rejoice, Rejoice, Emmanuel

Center of unbroken praise



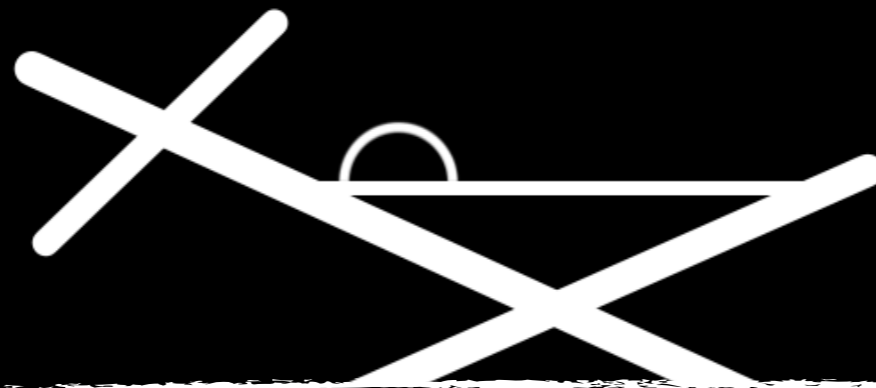
Field and forest vale and mountain

Brother love binds man to man



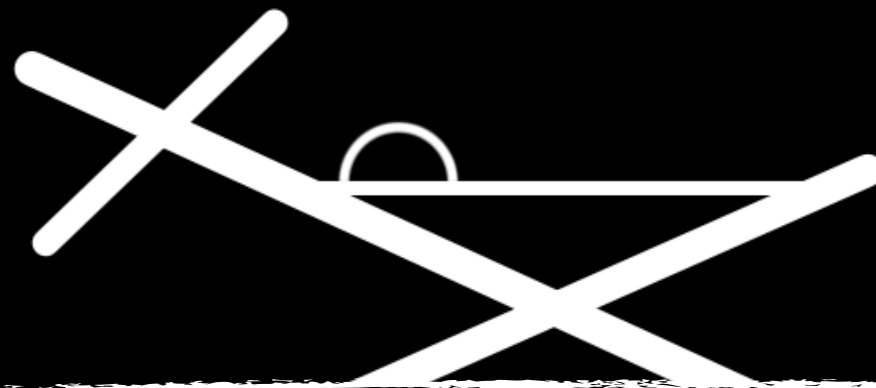
Ever singing march we onward

From the Squalor of a Borrowed Stable [Immanuel]

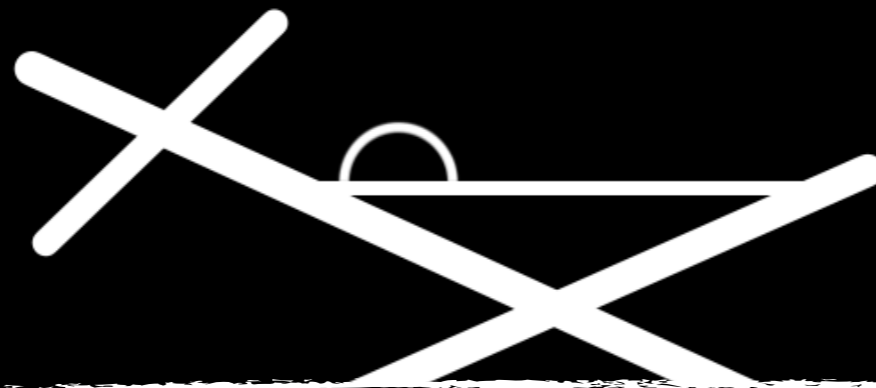
From the squalor of a borrowed stable,

Came the Savior of the human race.



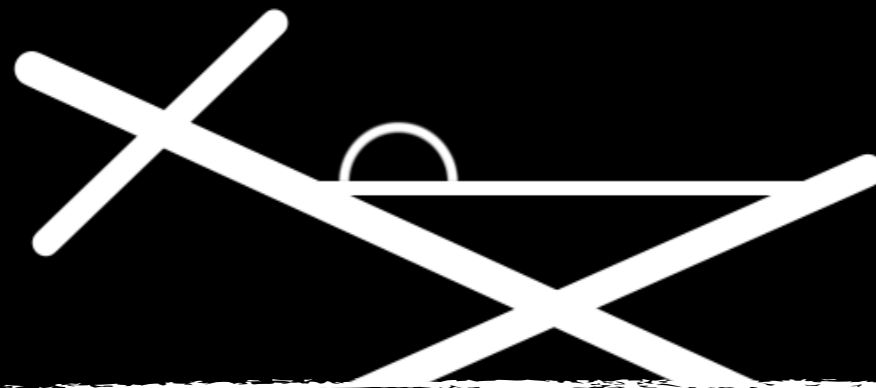
But the skies were filled with the praise of heaven,

Filled with mercy for the broken man.



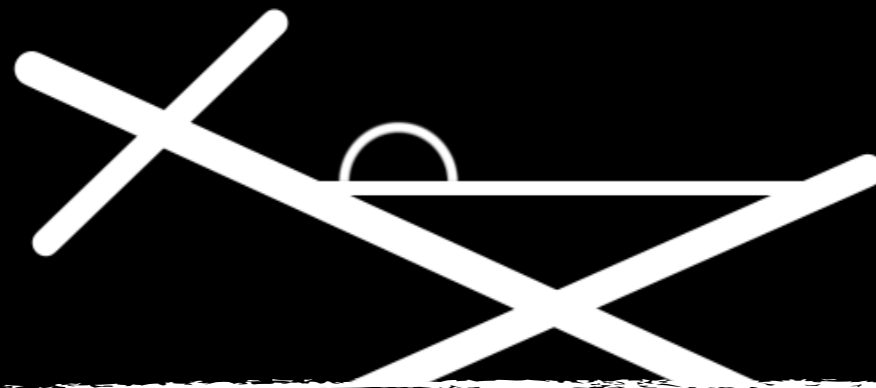
Yes, He walked my road and He felt my pain,

I will follow my Immanuel.



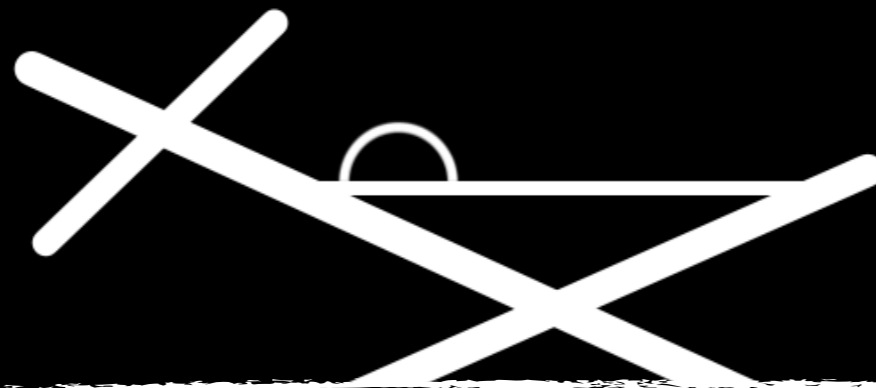
Through the kisses of a friend's betrayal,

He was suffering to save the lost.



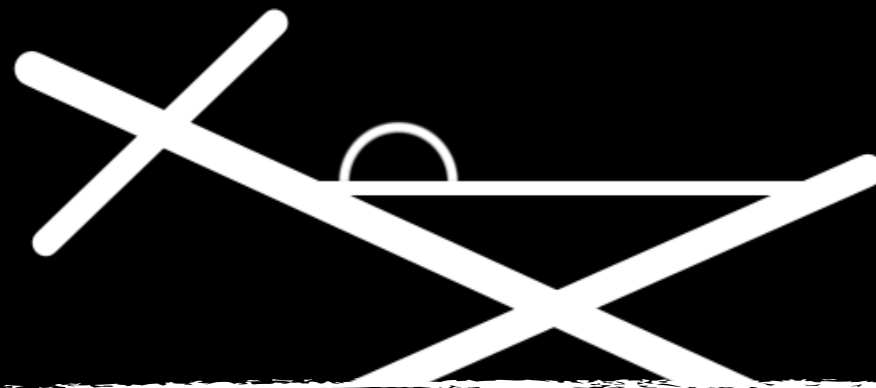
He fights for breath, He fights for me,
