What is our hope in life and death

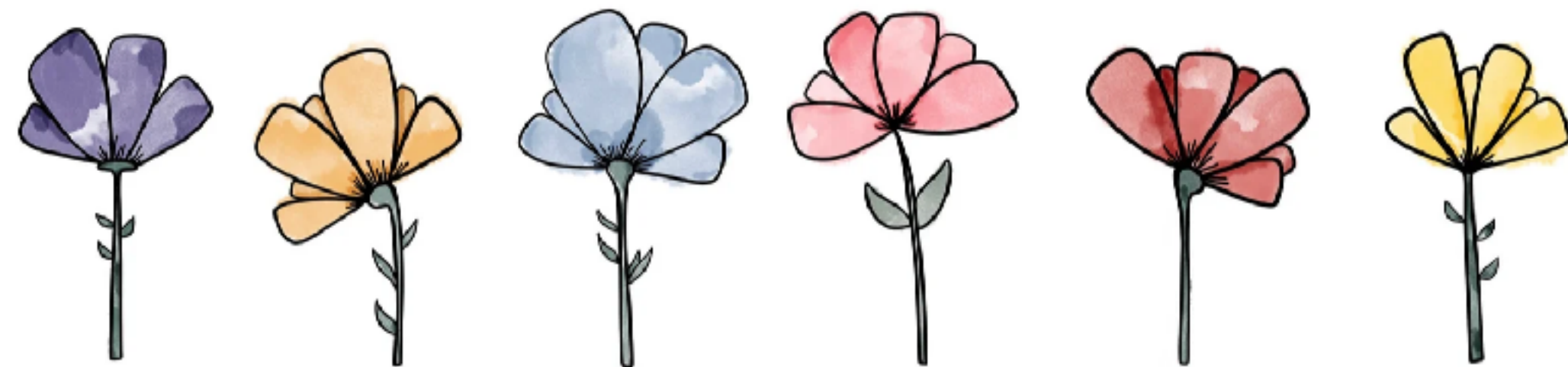

What is our only confidence

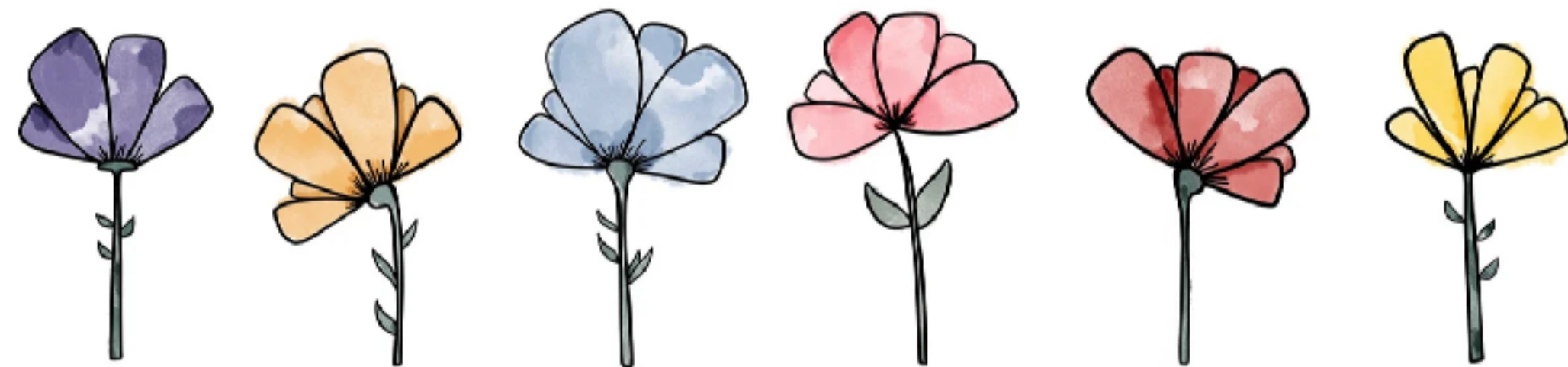
That our souls to Him belong

In our great Redeemer's blood



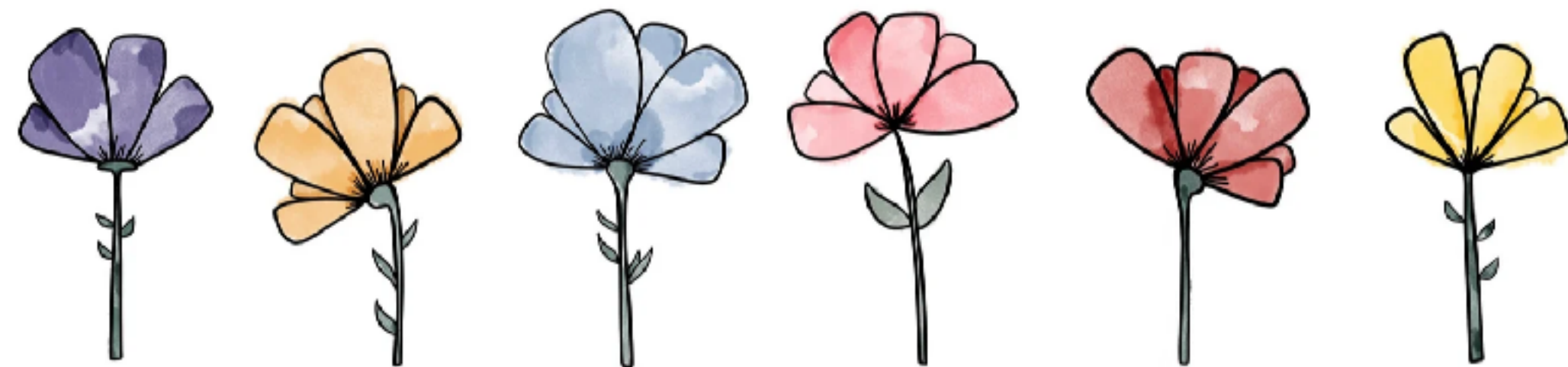
Who holds our faith when fears arise

Unto the shore the rock of Christ



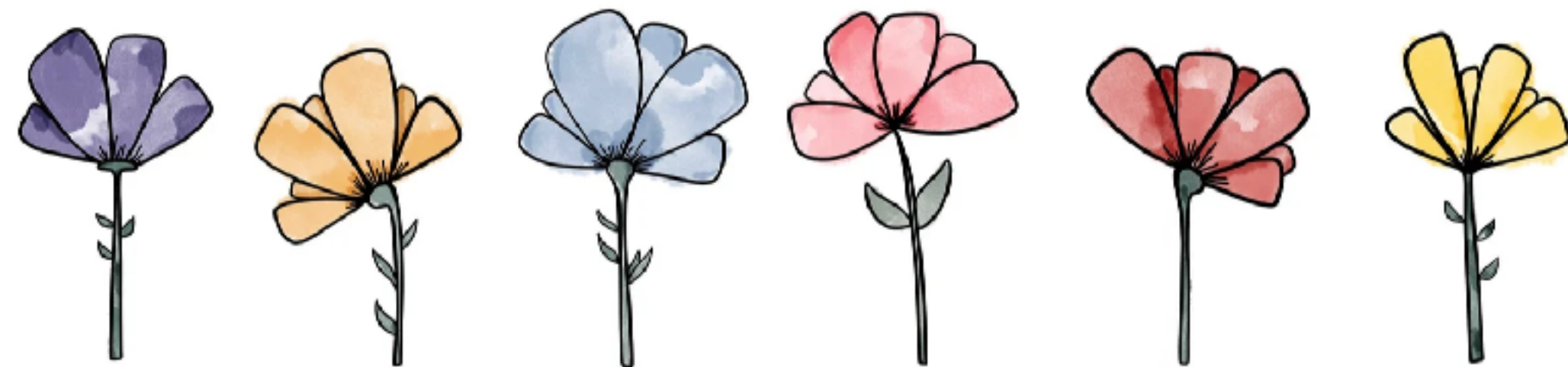

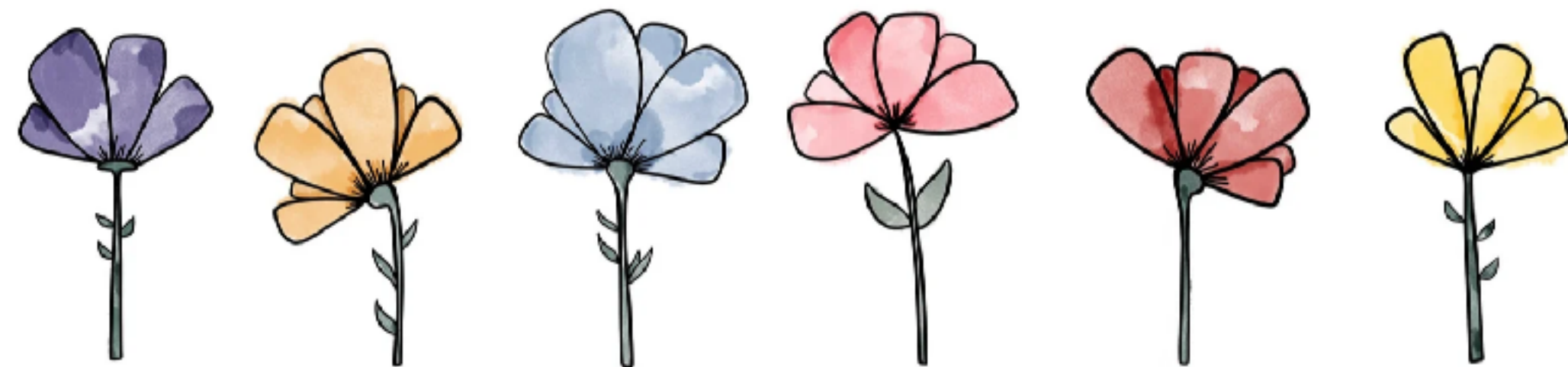

the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.

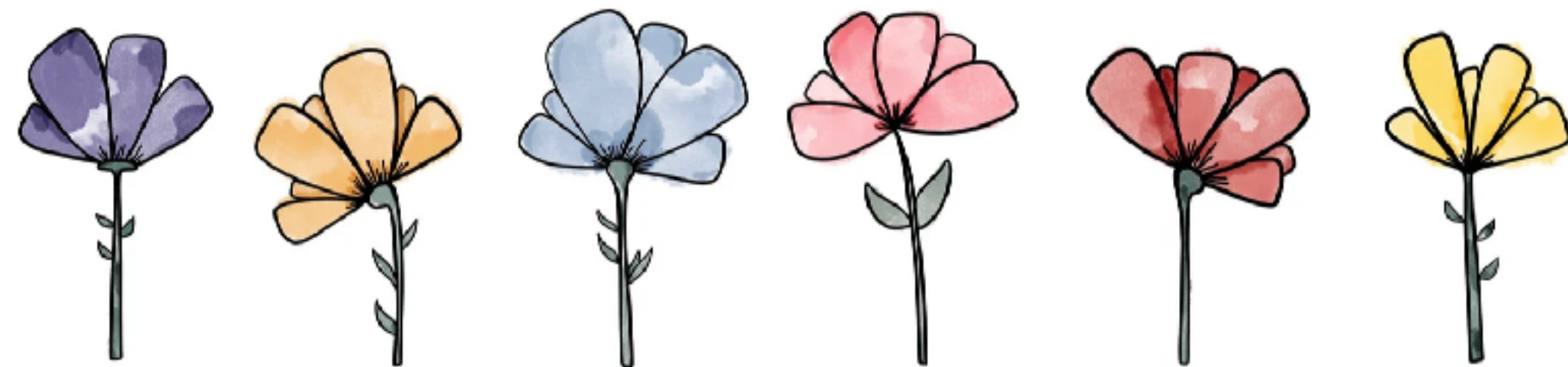

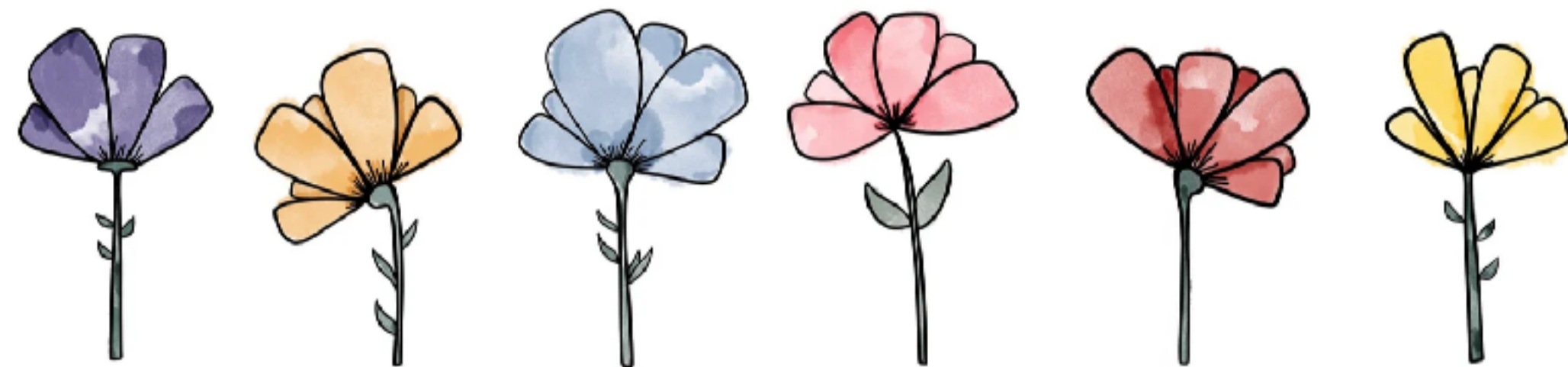
My hope is built on nothing less

but wholly lean on Jesus' name.



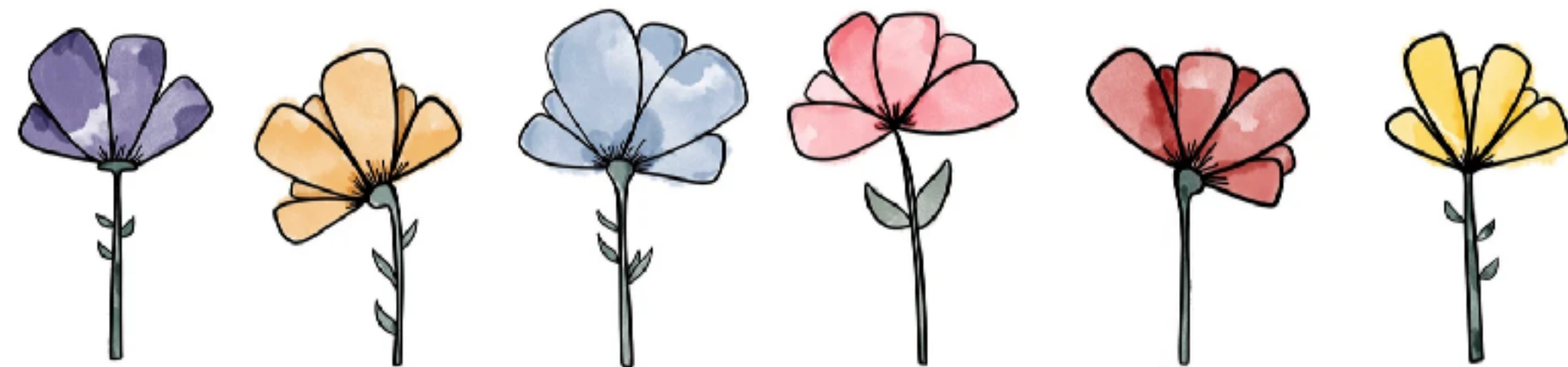

my anchor holds within the veil.



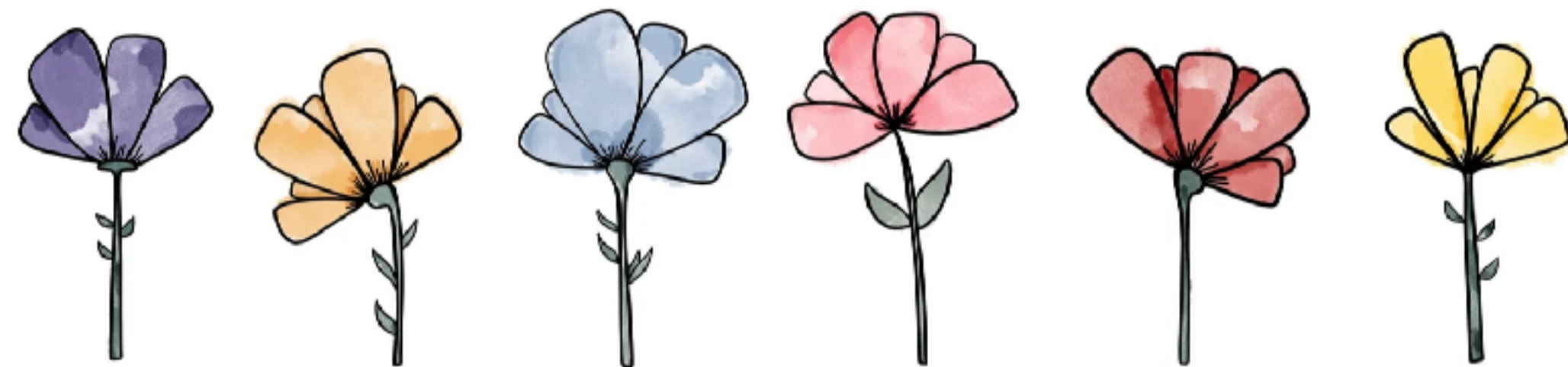

And spoke Your name into the night



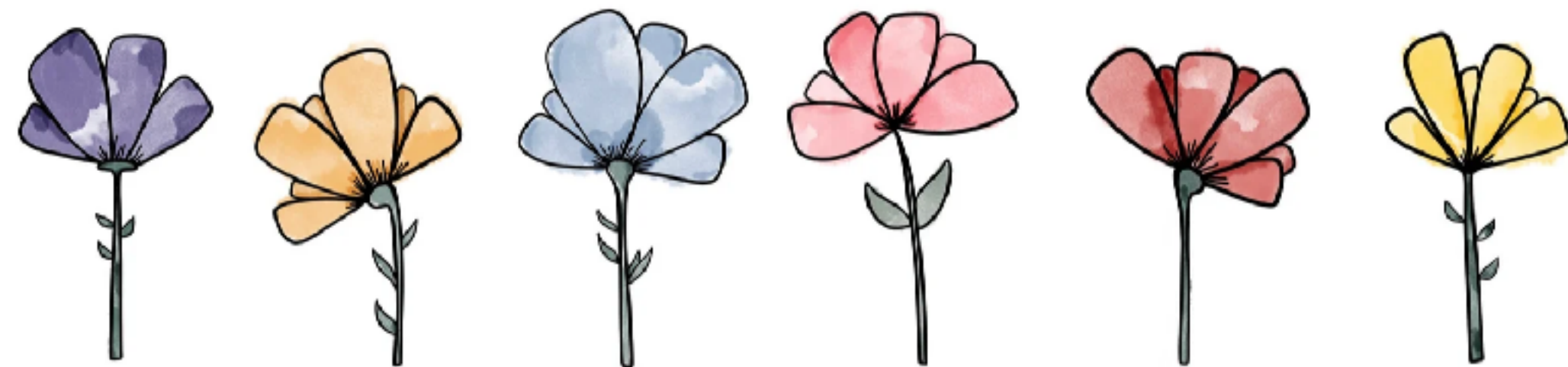
Then through the darkness Your loving-kindness

# My Soul Will Wait (Psalm 62)

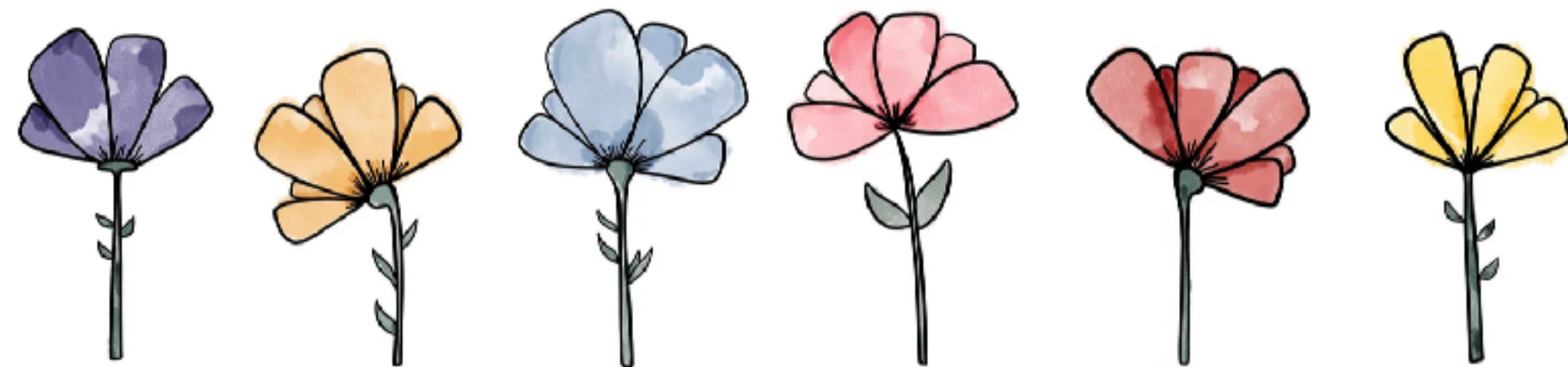
When the enemy surrounds

And my fears are pressing in



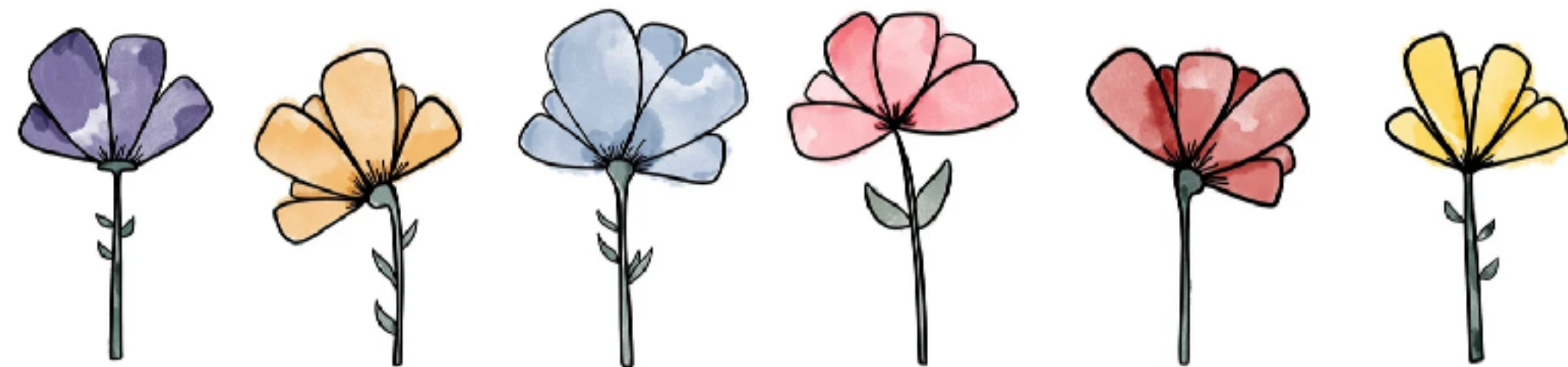

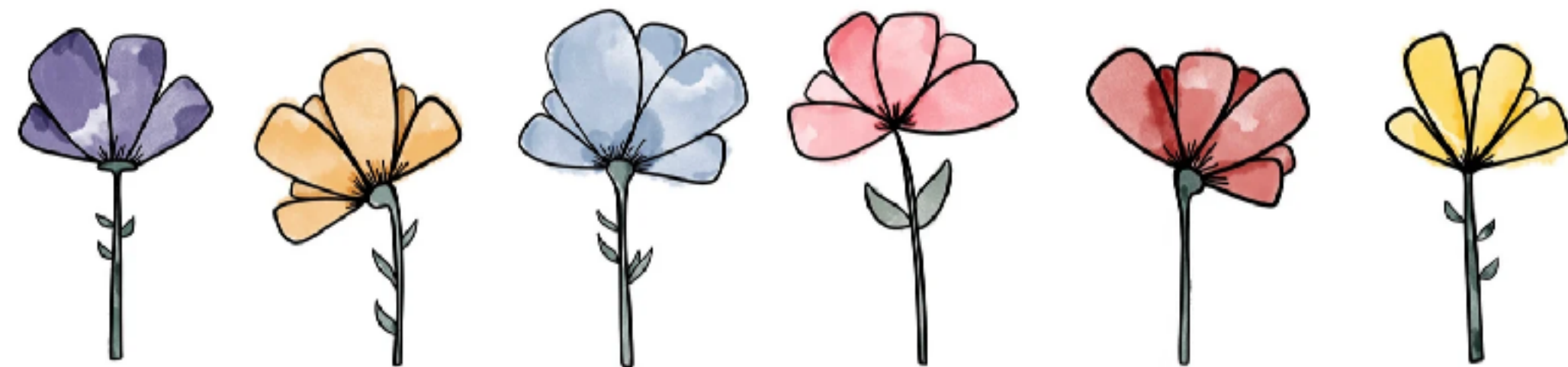

They will vanish like a breath



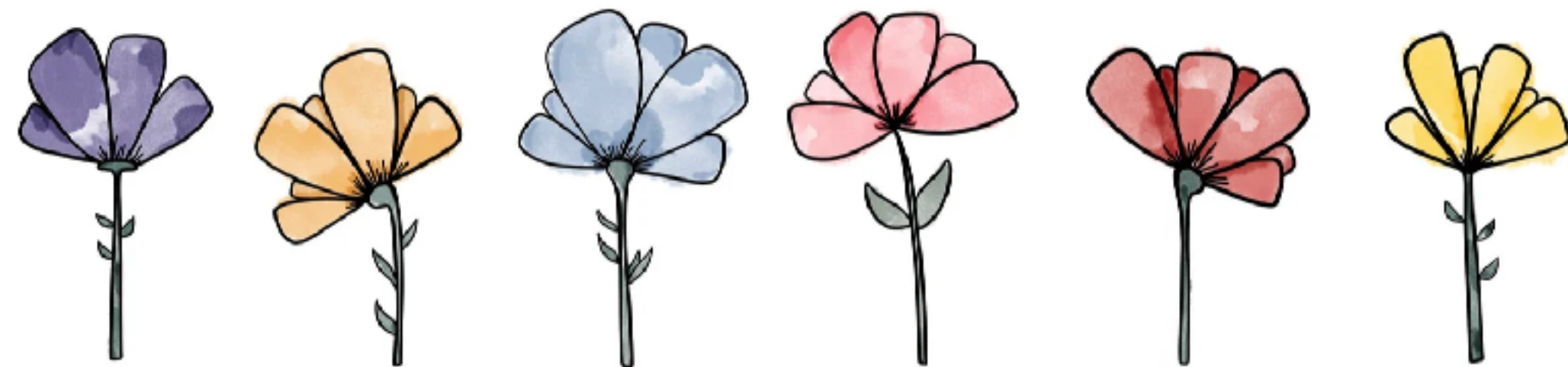

In Your power I'm secure



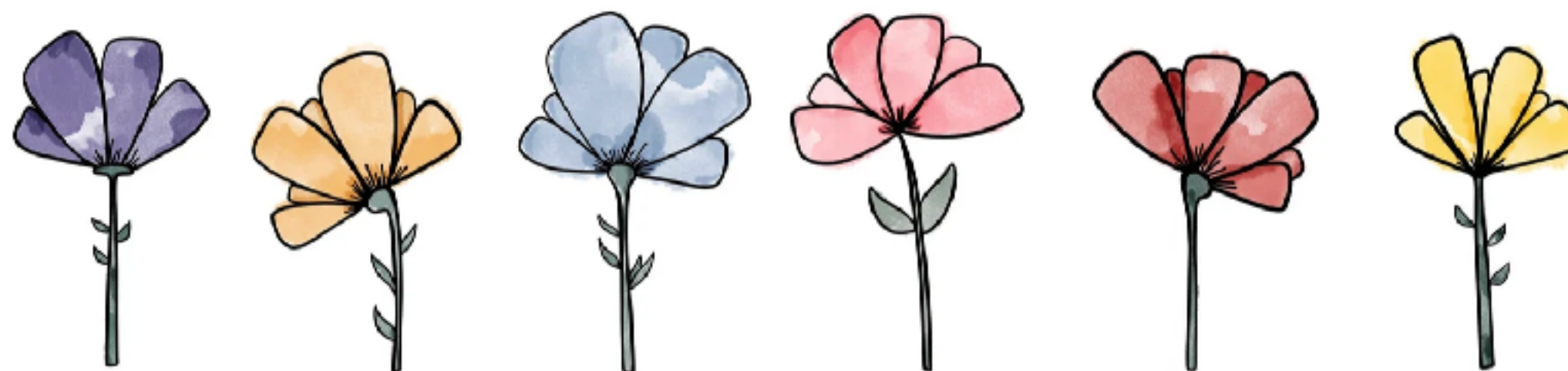

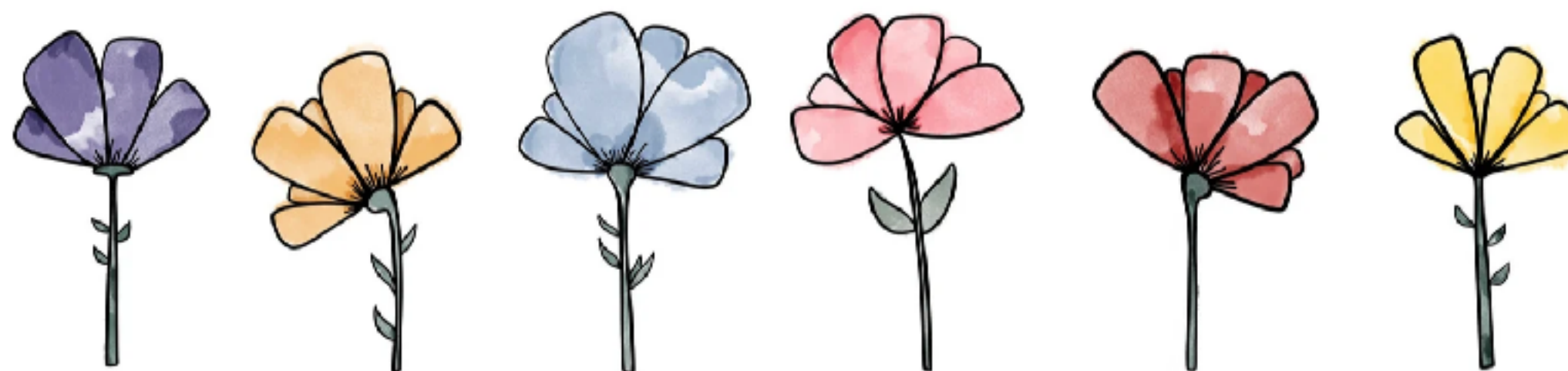

I have peace that's undeserved



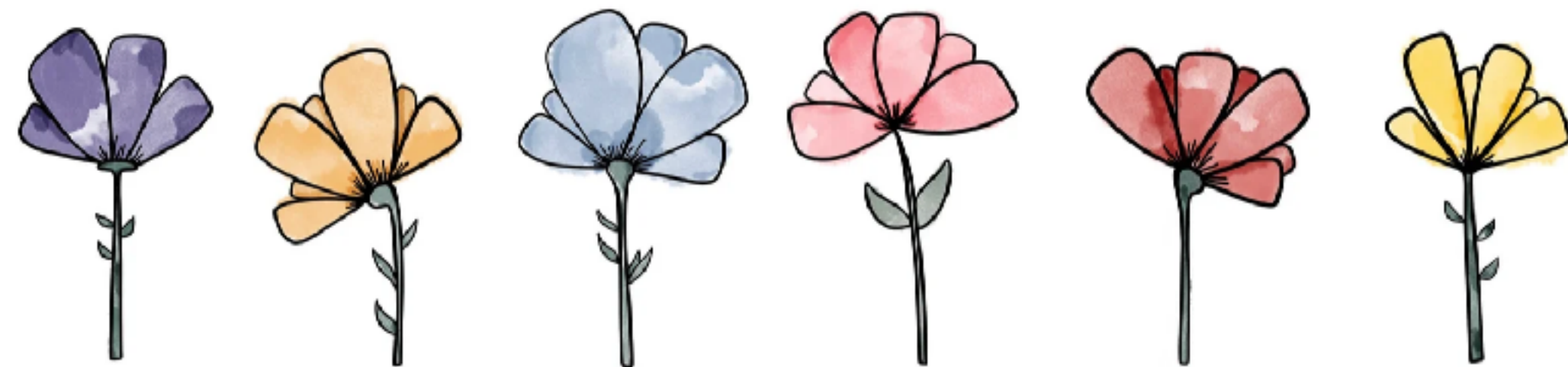

To the setting of the sun,

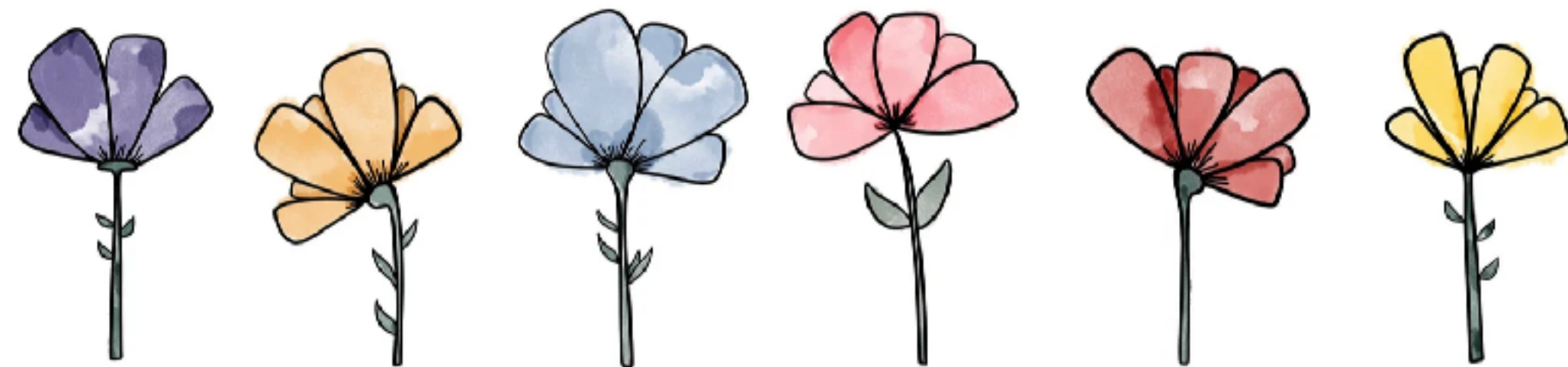
I will stand on every promise of Your word.

That in freedom I might live



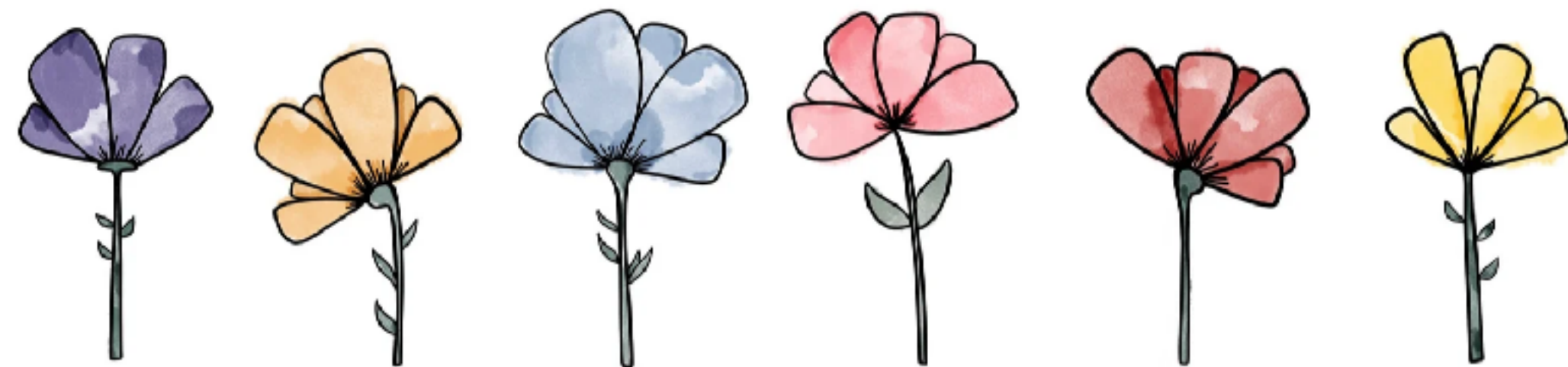
So I stand on ev'ry promise of Your word
