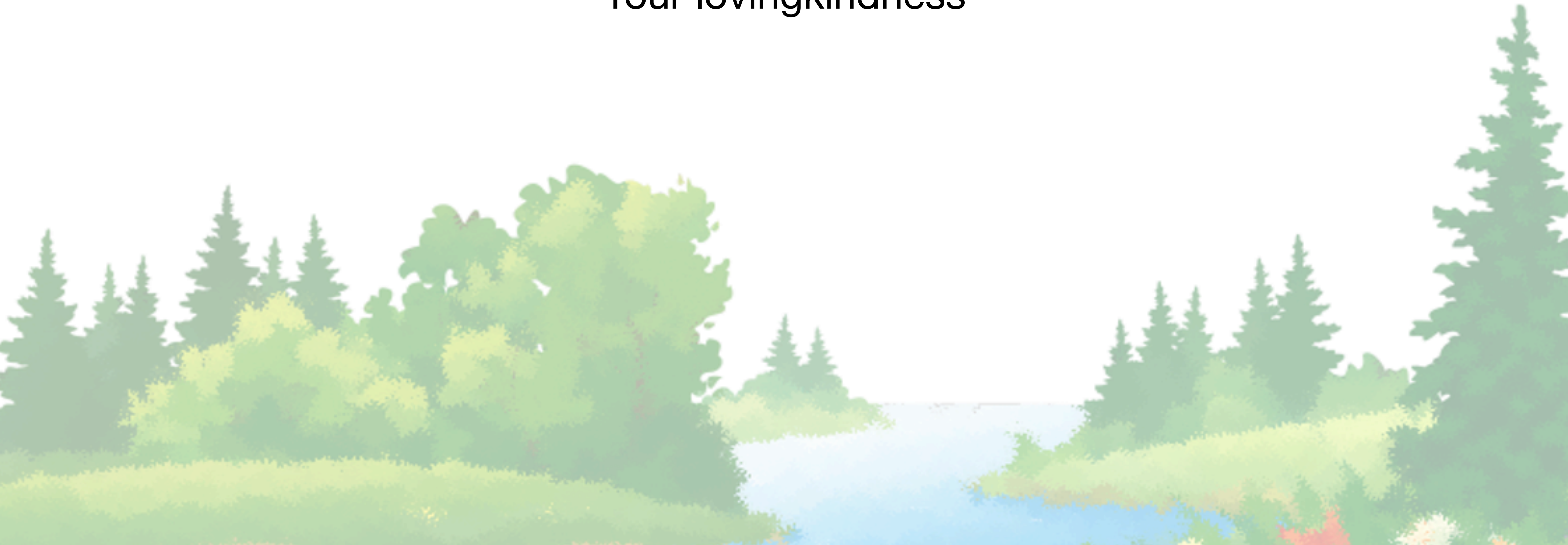

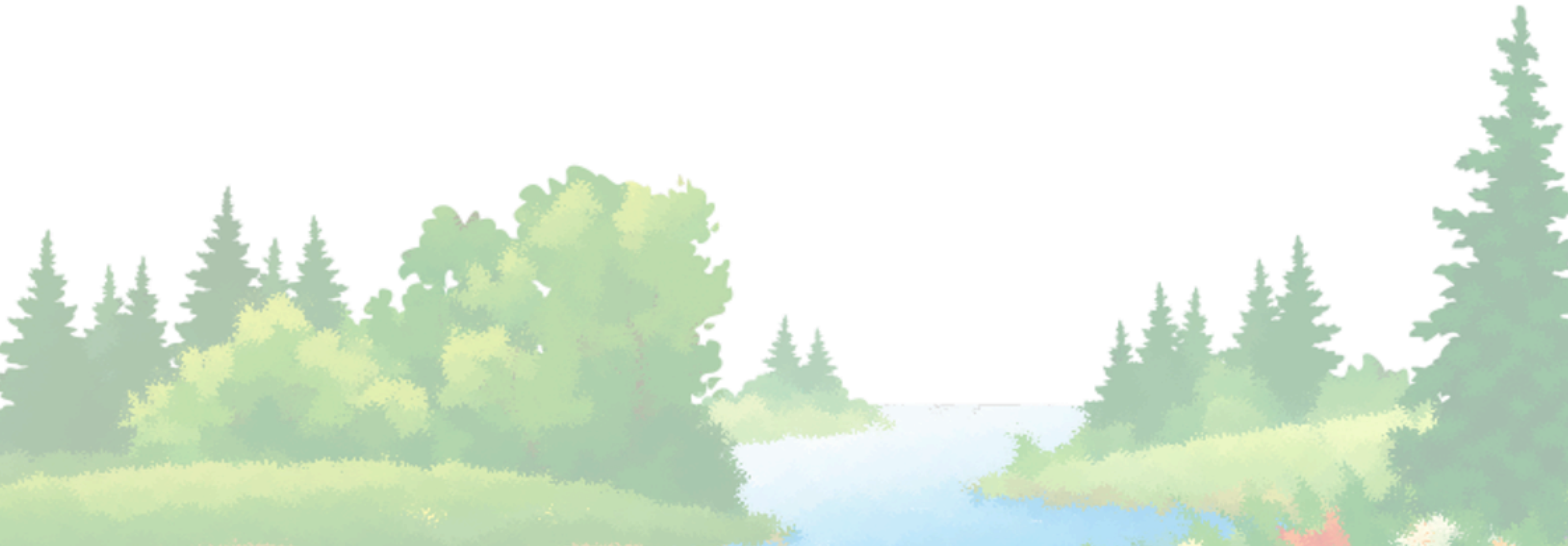

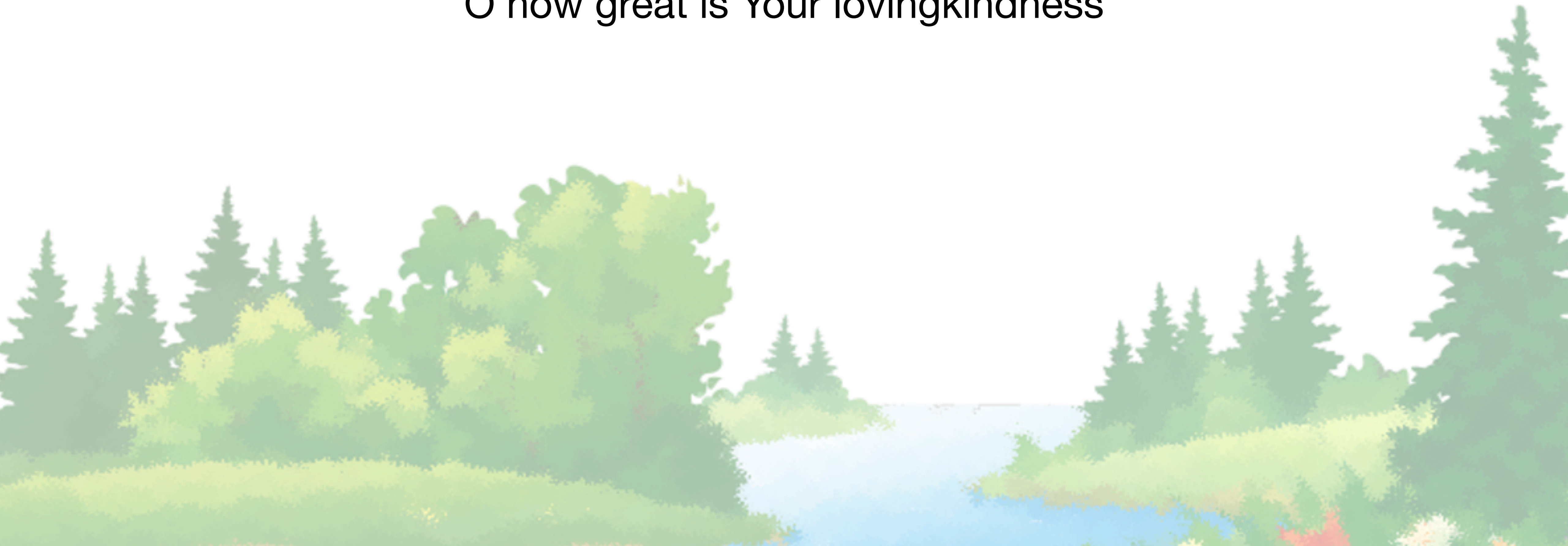
Let praises now awake the dawn

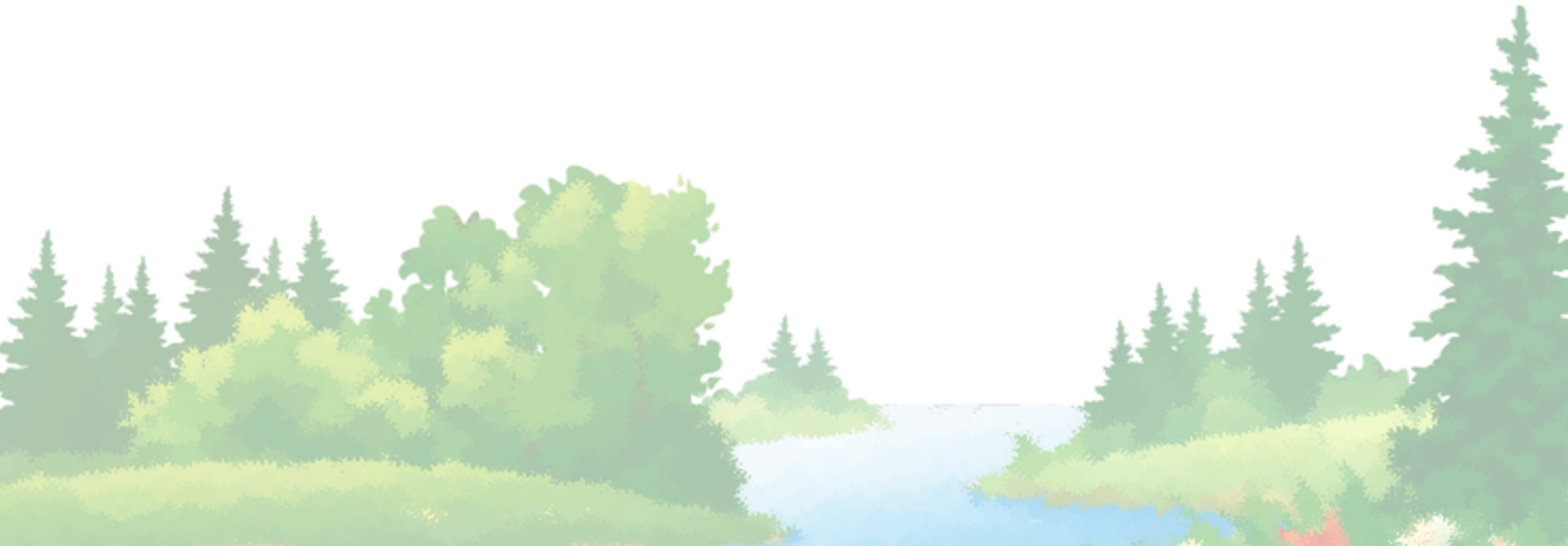


Good and Gracious King

From a good and gracious King



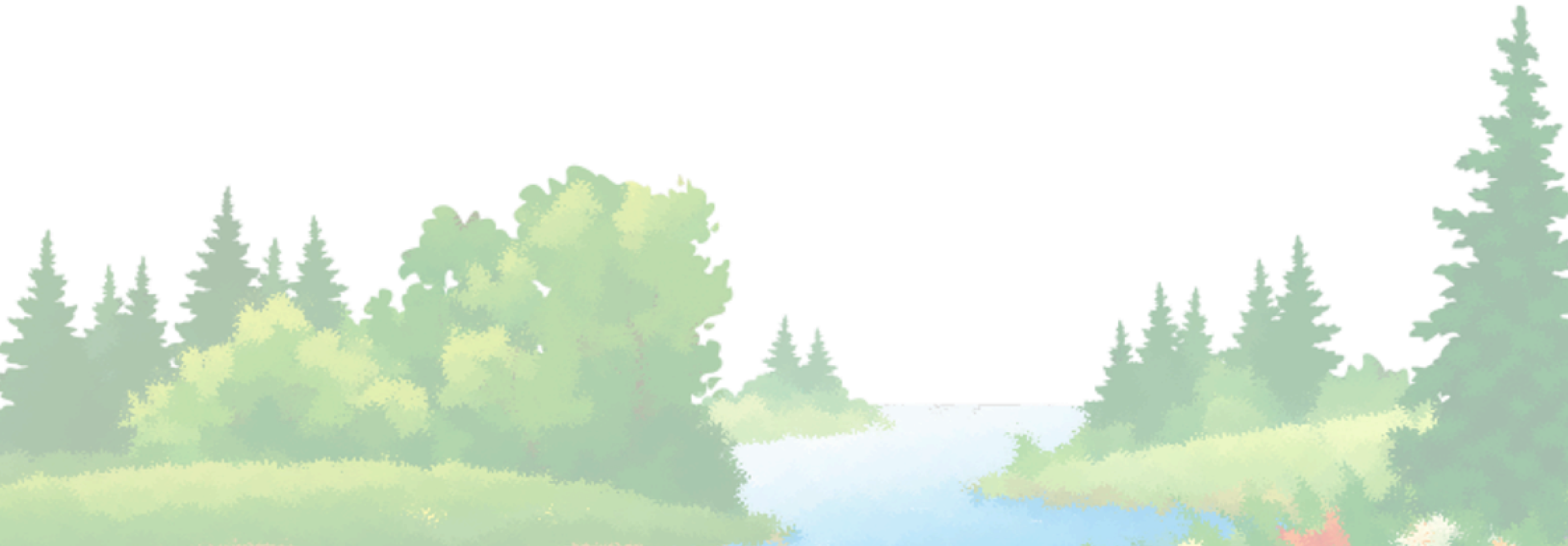

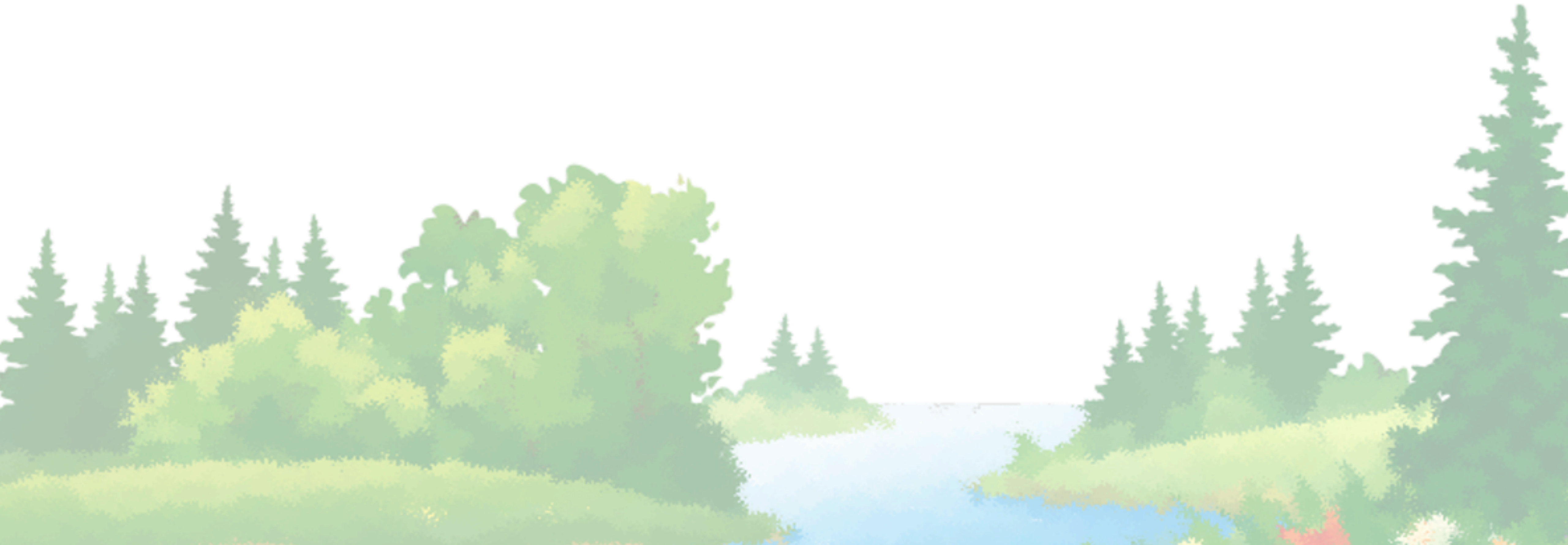

Christ the sure and steady anchor

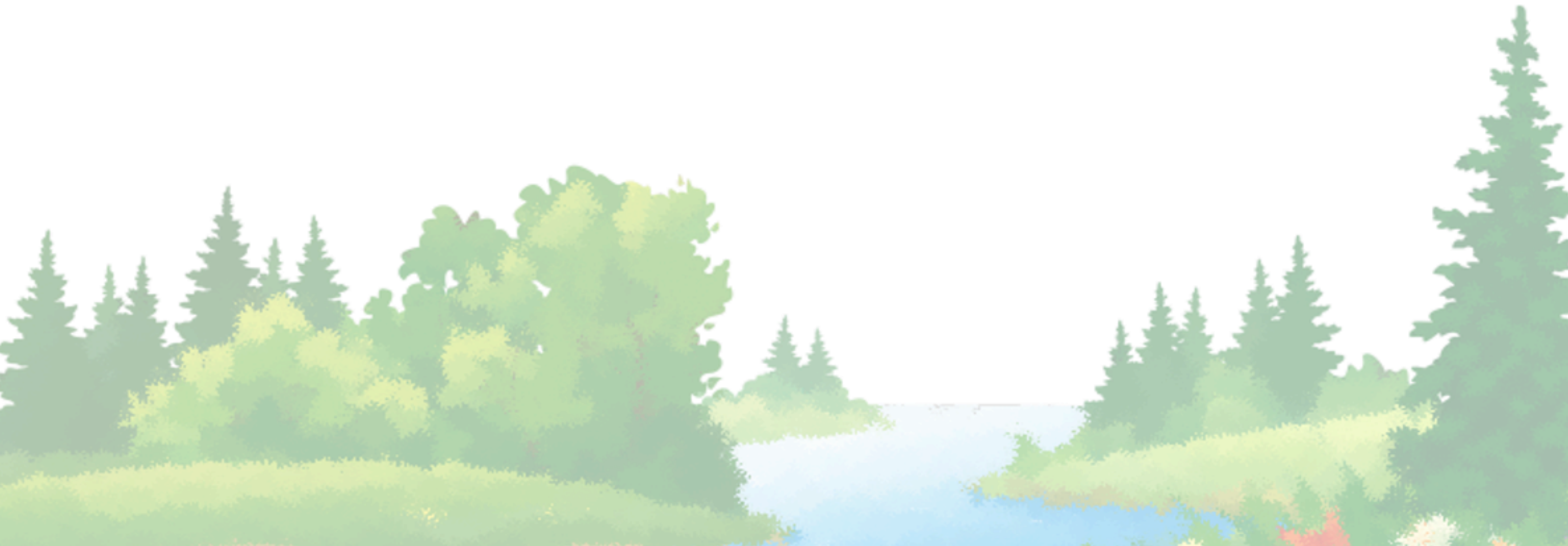
In the fury of the storm

It shall never be removed



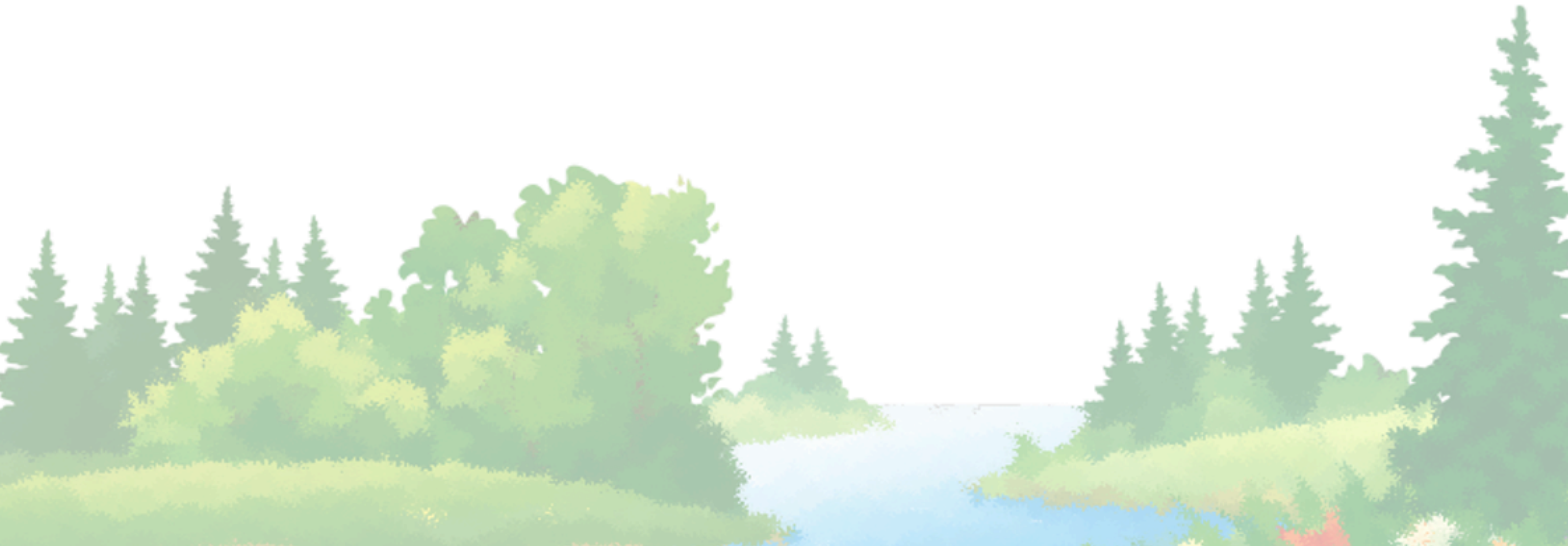
Christ the sure and steady anchor

And it seems the night has won



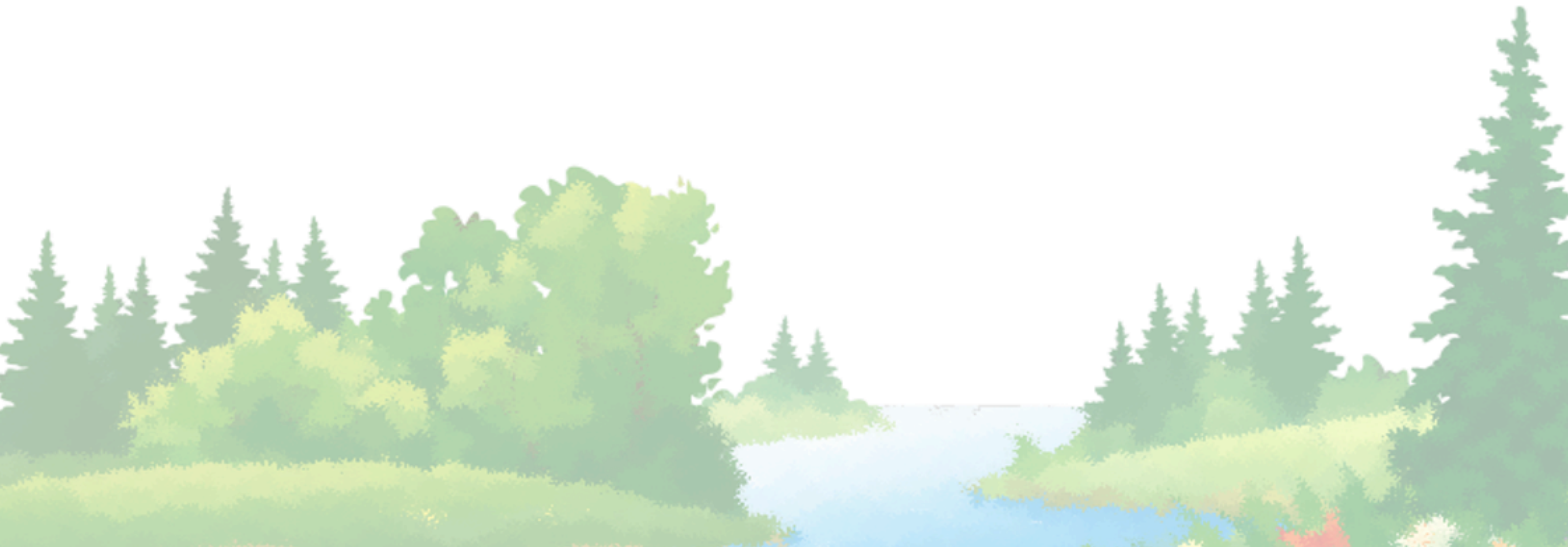
Deeper still then goes the anchor

Now lift your eyes to Calvary



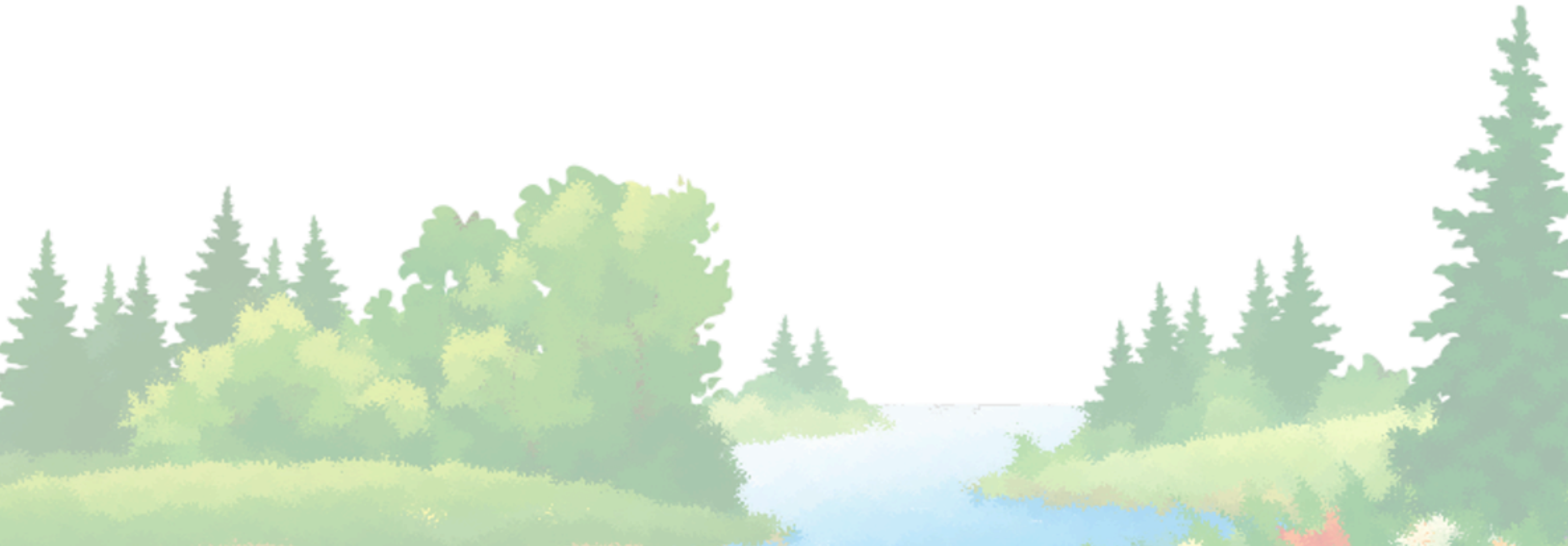
This my ballast of assurance
