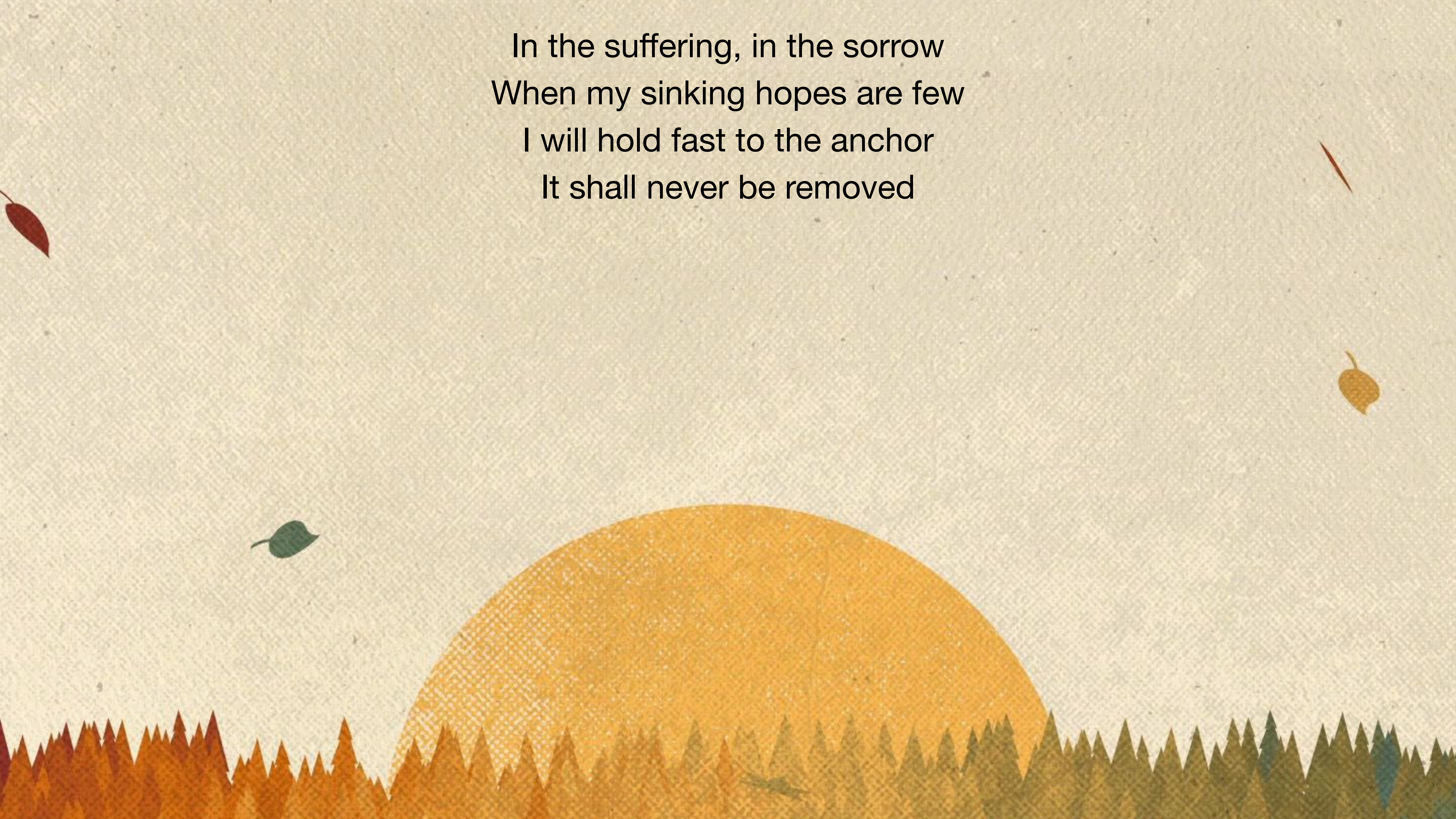


# Christ the Sure and Steady Anchor

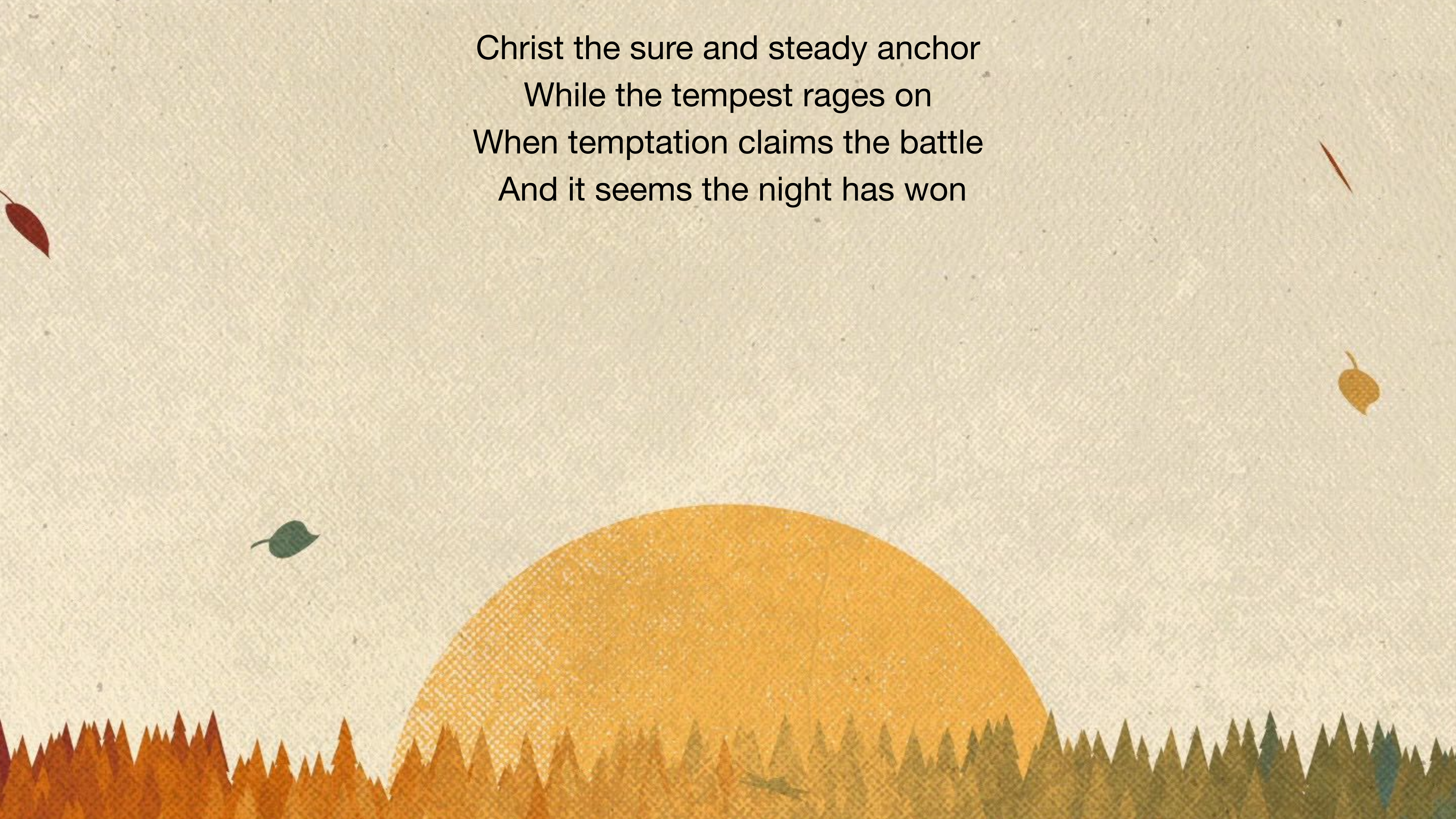
Christ the sure and steady anchor

And it seems the night has won



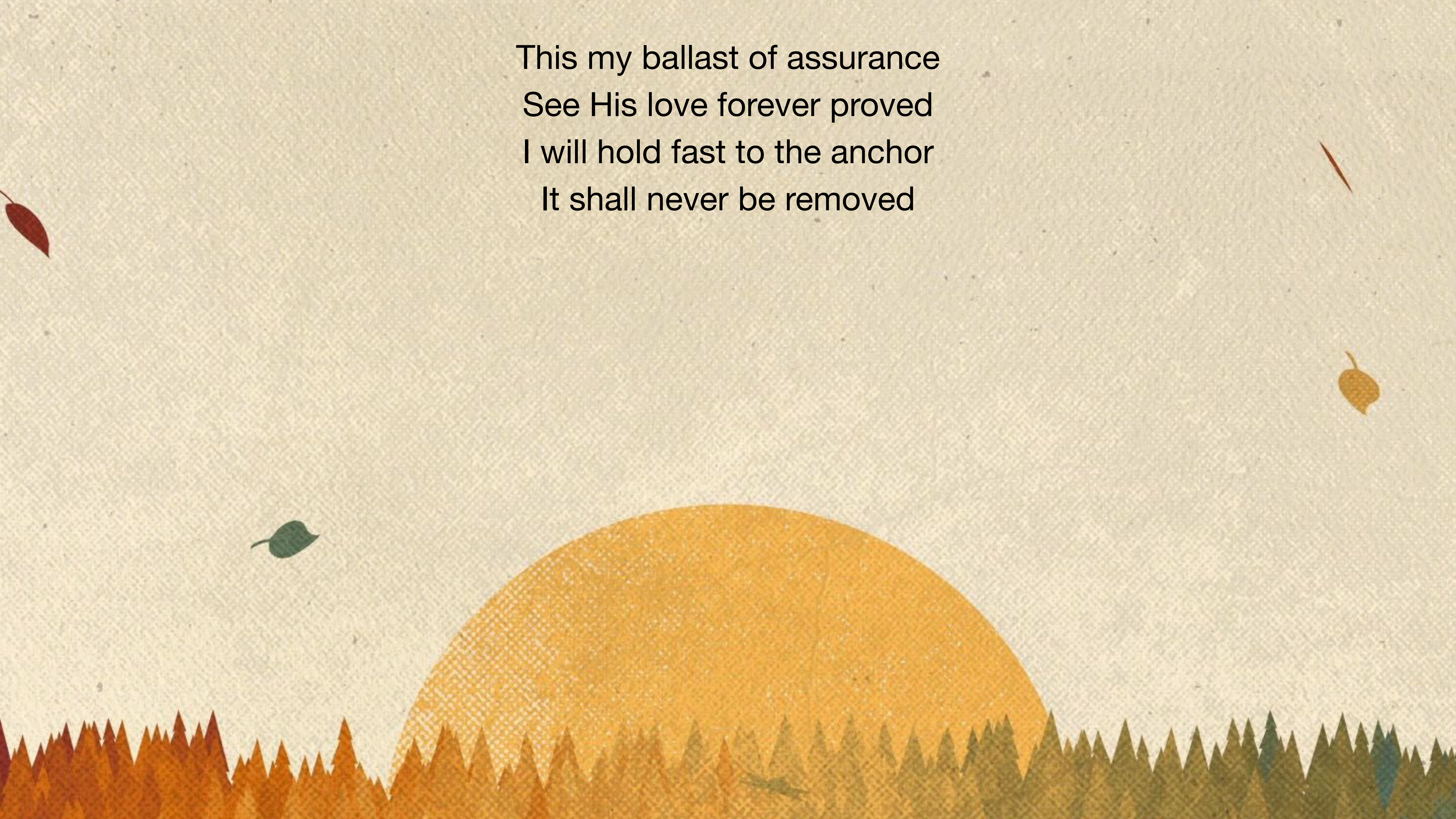
Deeper still then goes the anchor

It shall never be removed



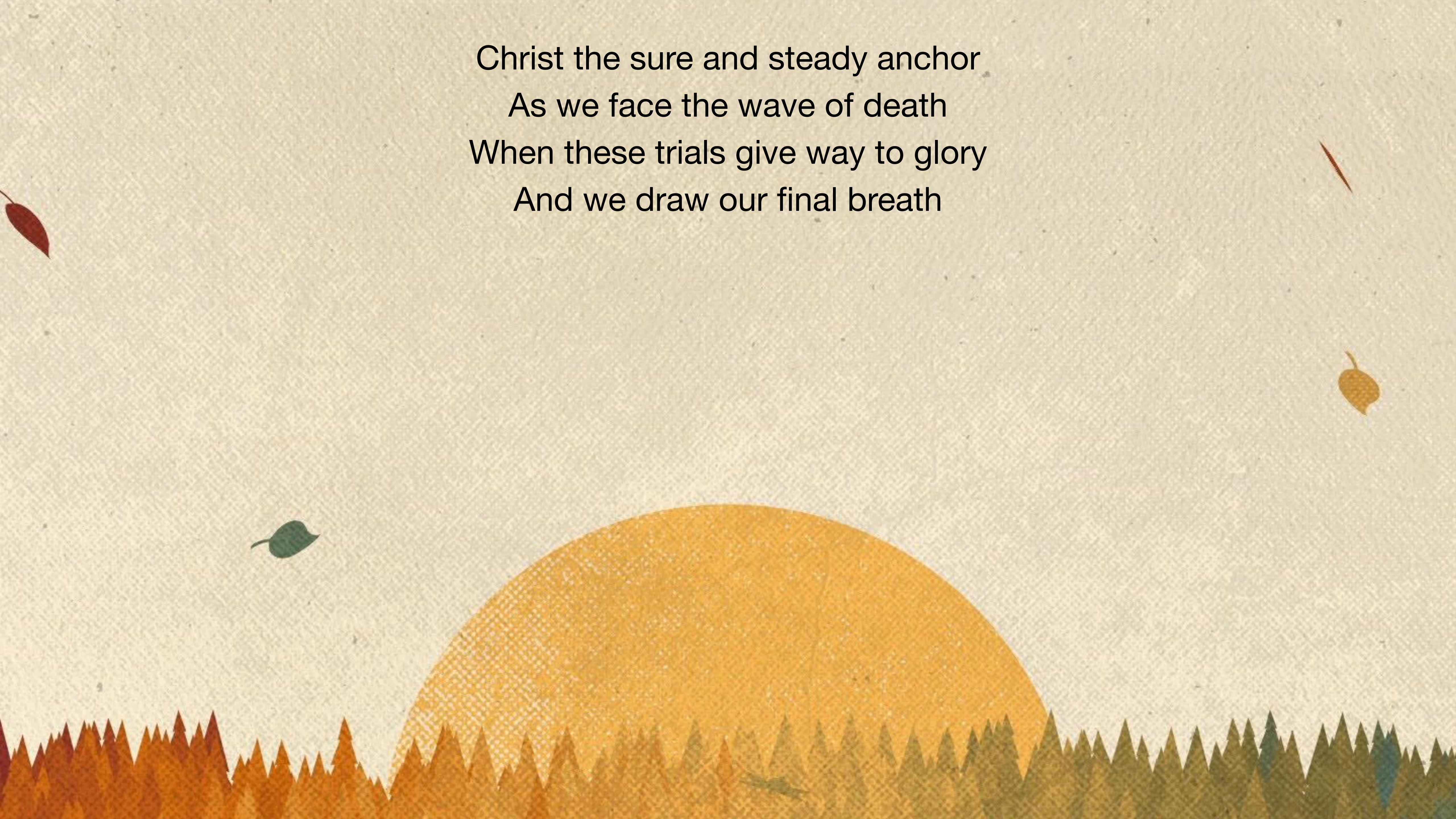

Now lift your eyes to Calvary



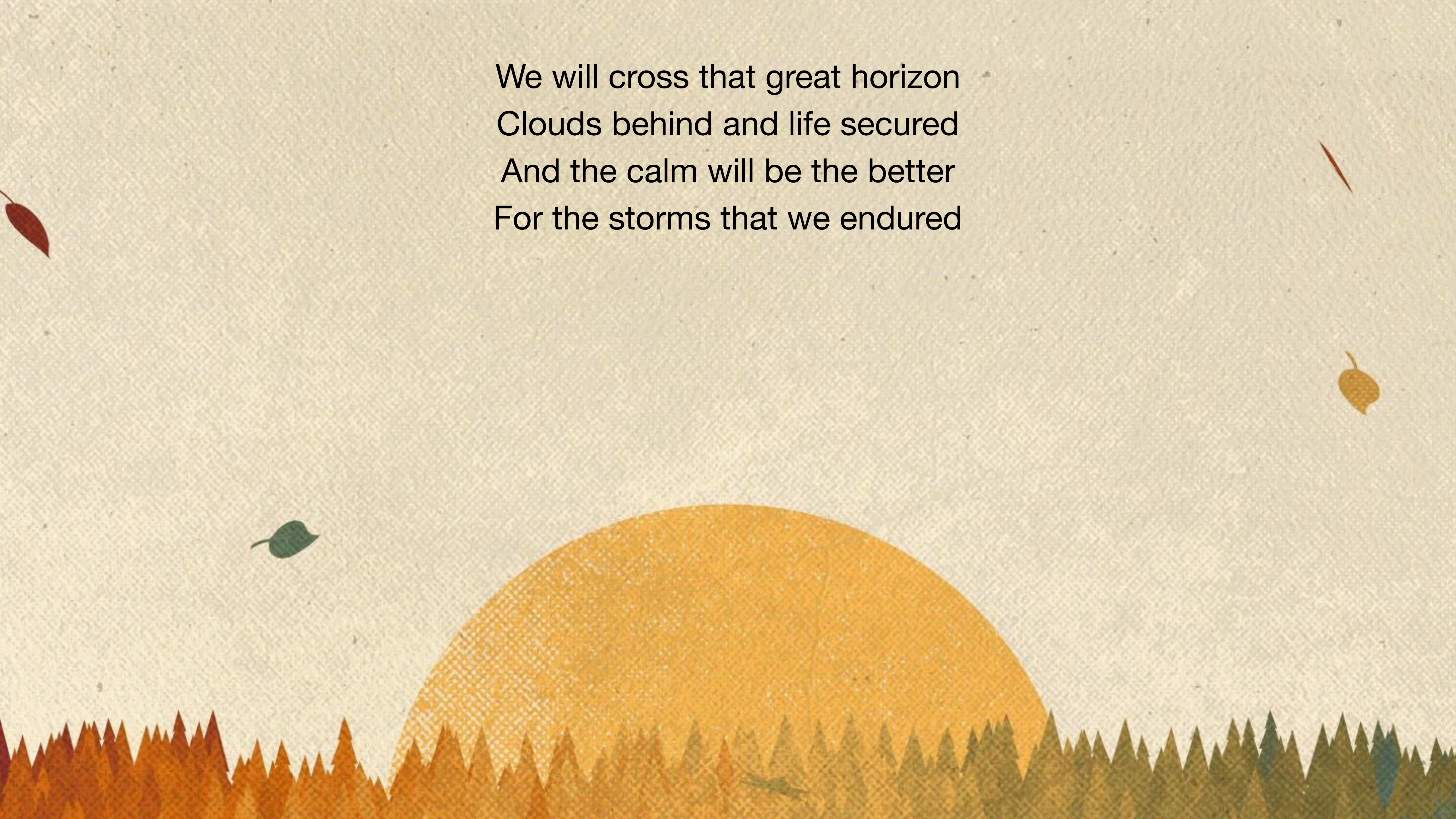
