By His blood He'll win us

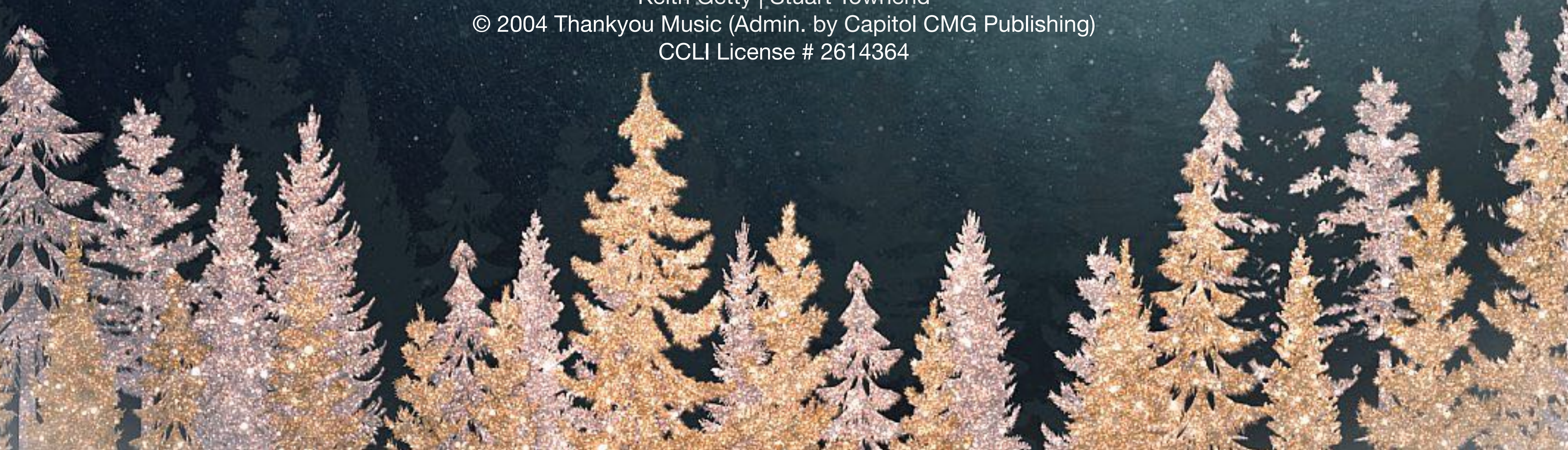
