Emptied Himself of all but love



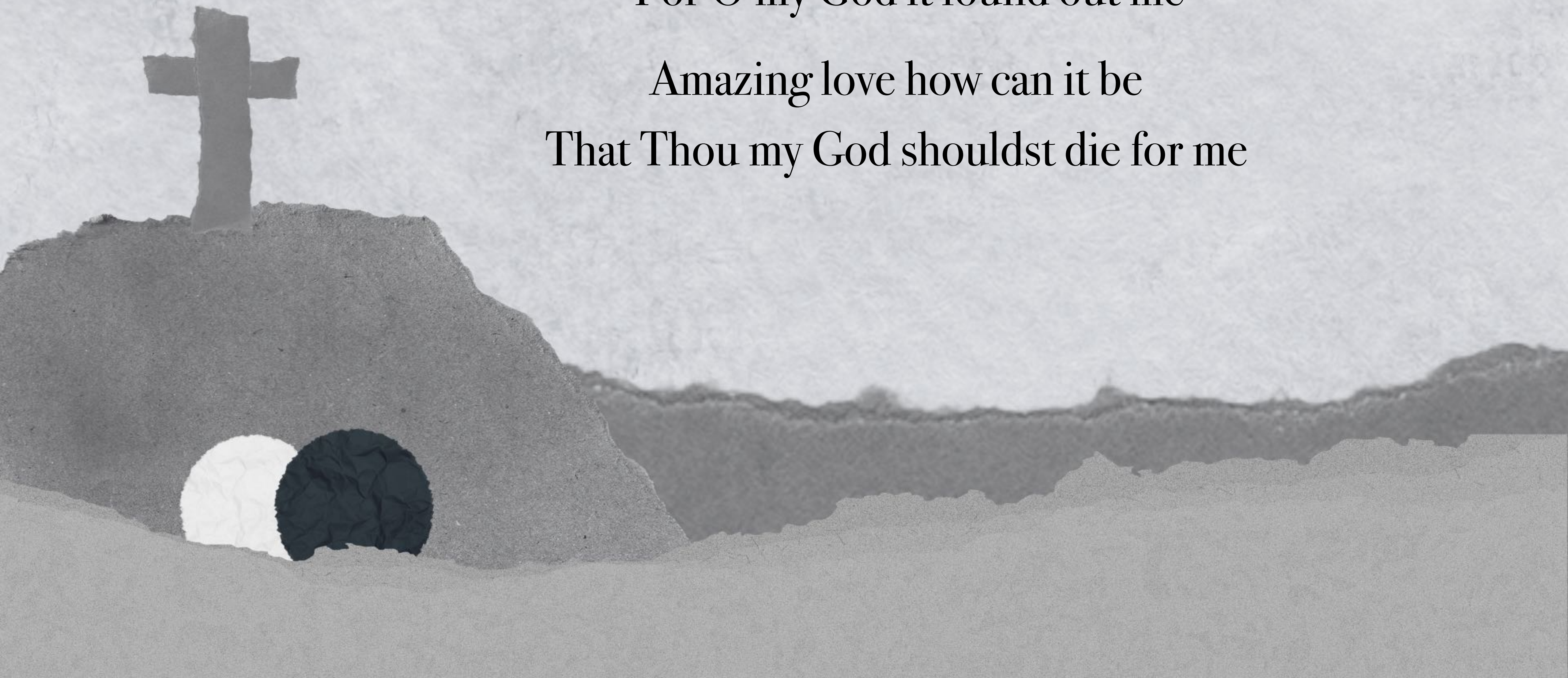
And bled for Adam's helpless race

'Tis mercy all immense and free

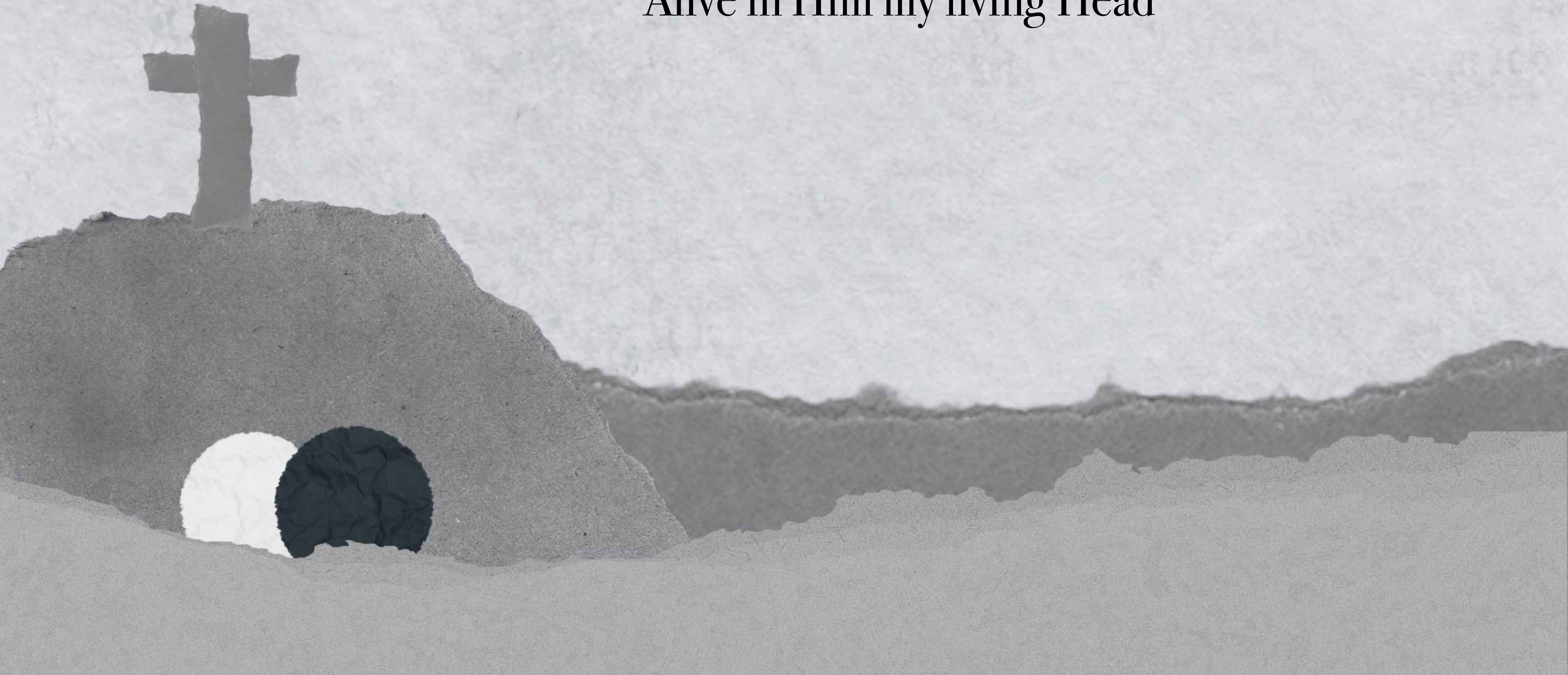
For O my God it found out me

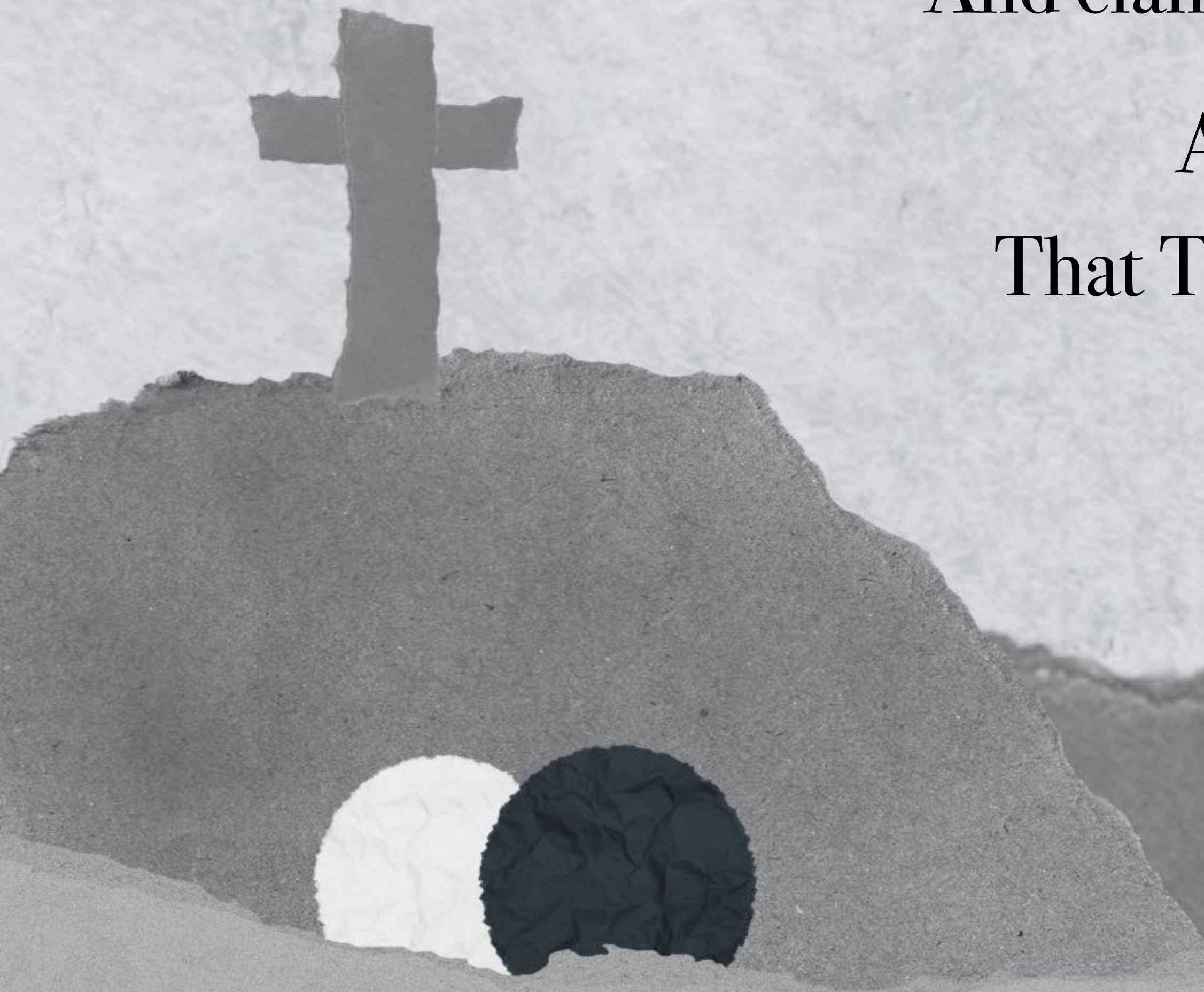

How Can It Be?

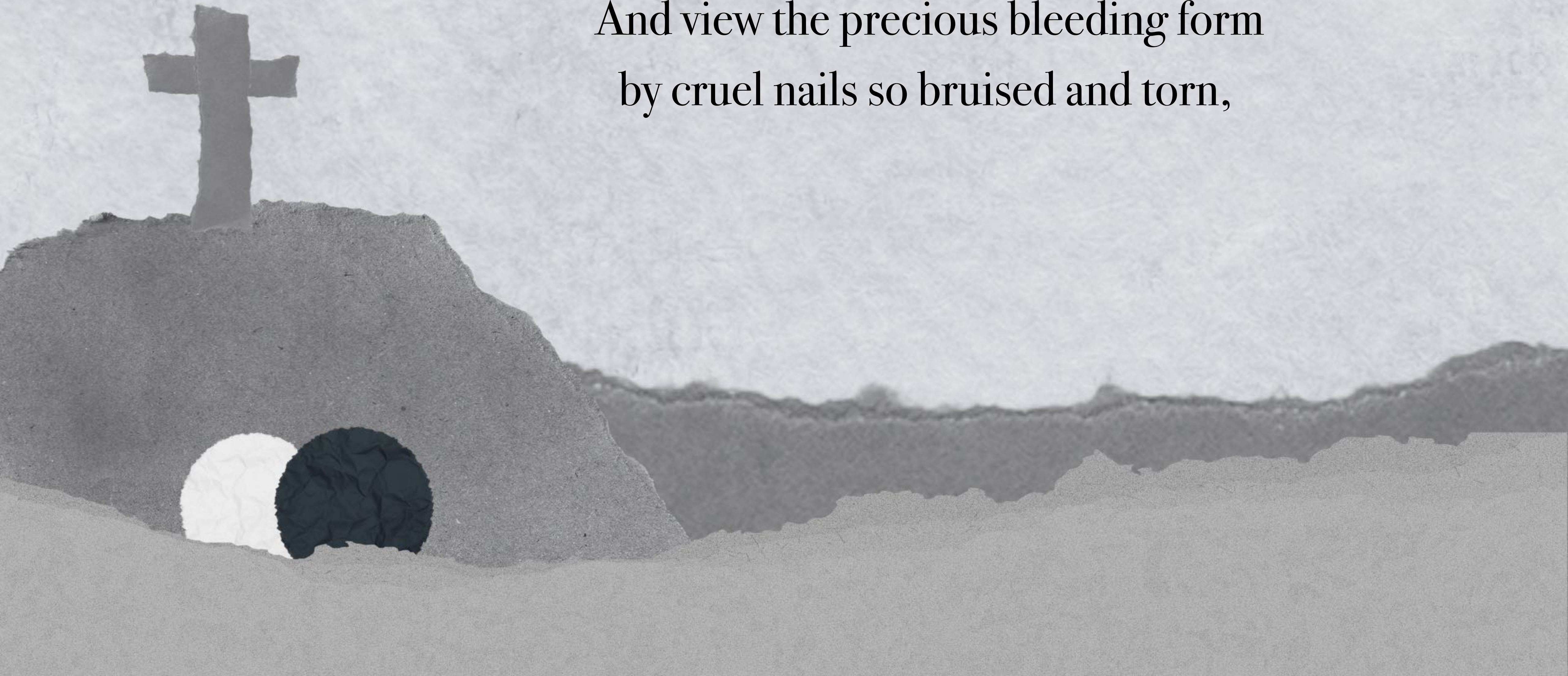
O Savior, as my eyes behold

The vast creation Thou has made-



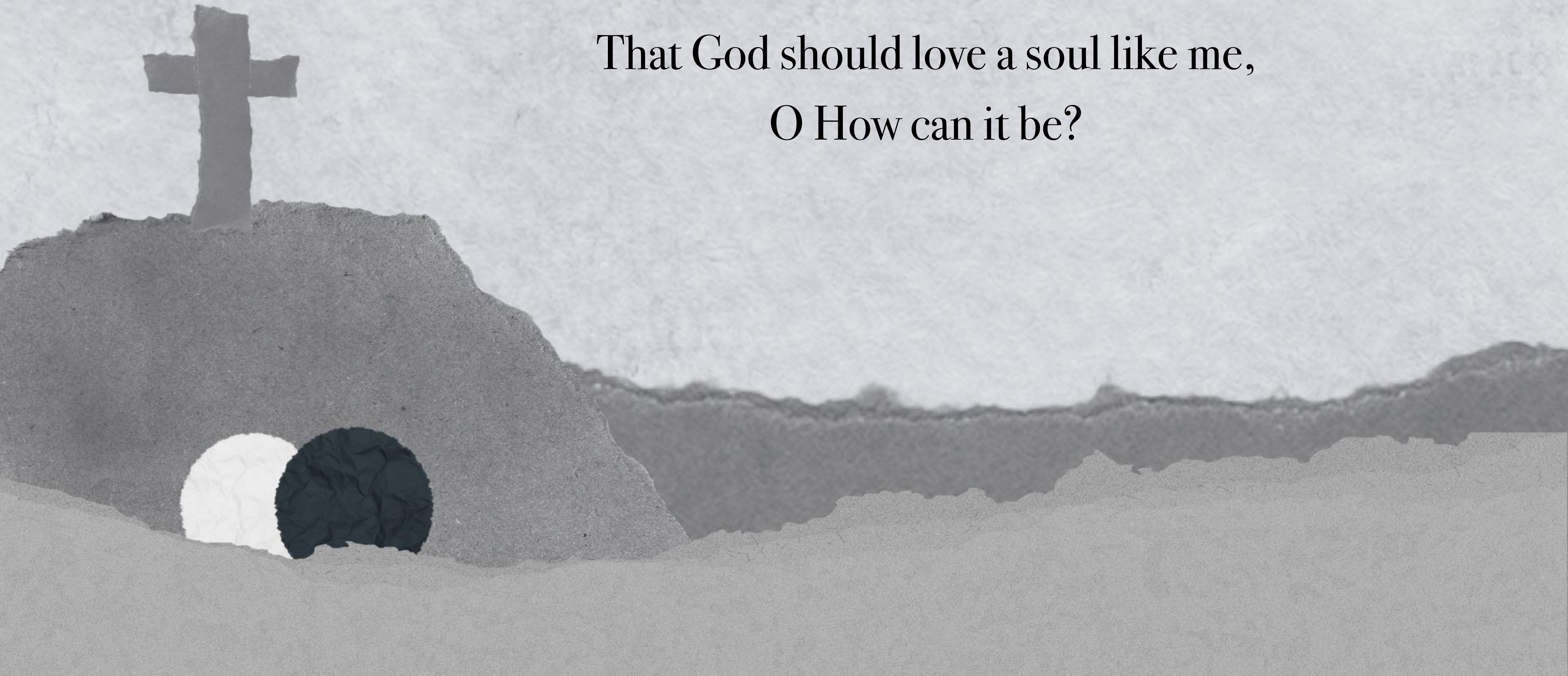
And yet to think Thou lovest me-

by cruel nails so bruised and torn,



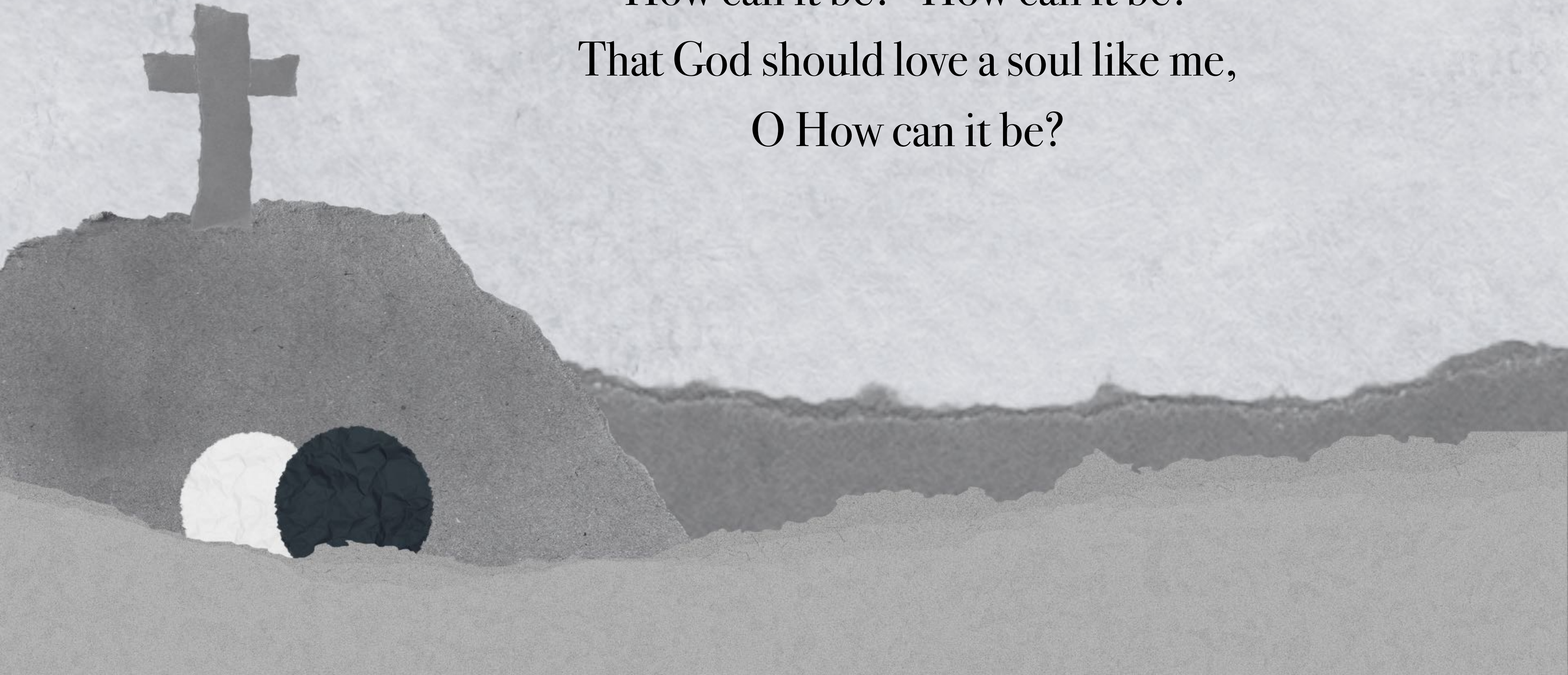
To know Thy suff-ring was for me,

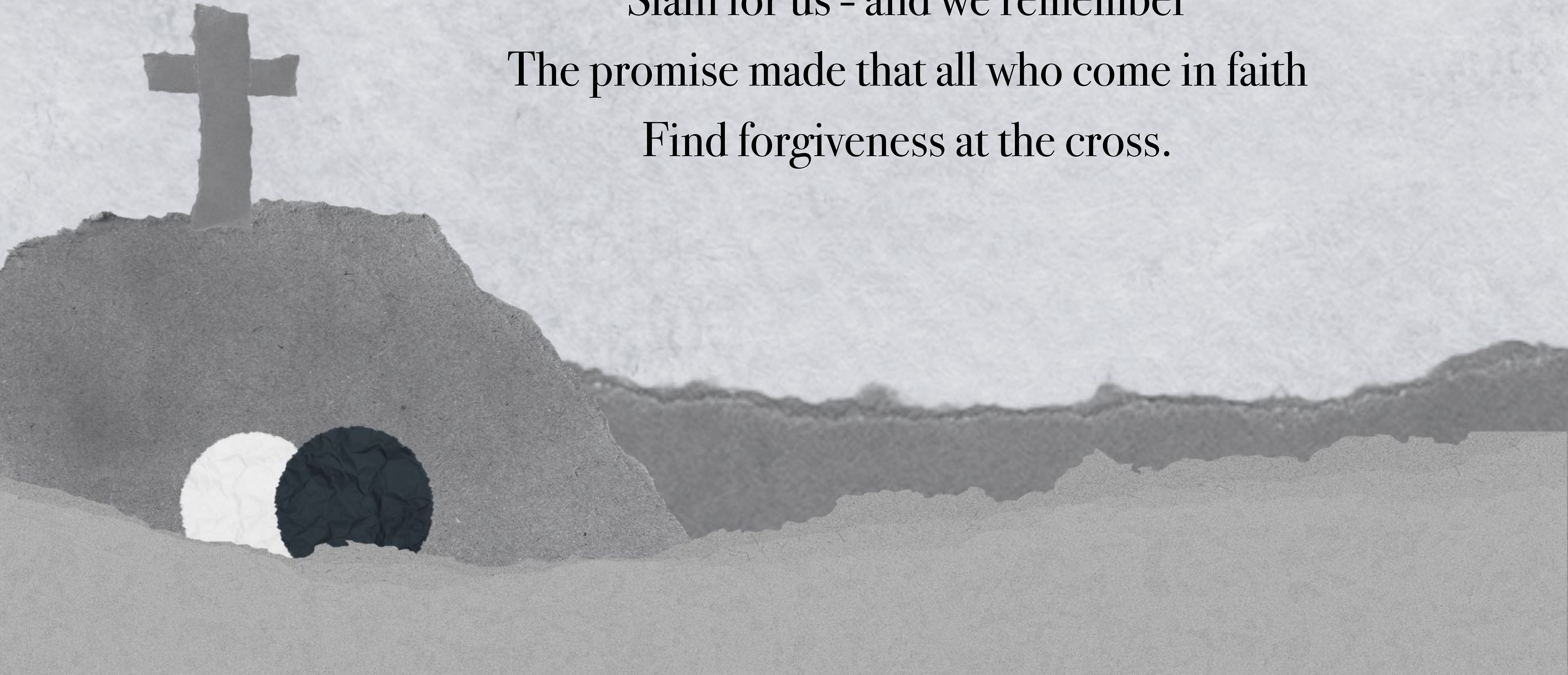
Behold the Lamb

The promise made that all who come in faith

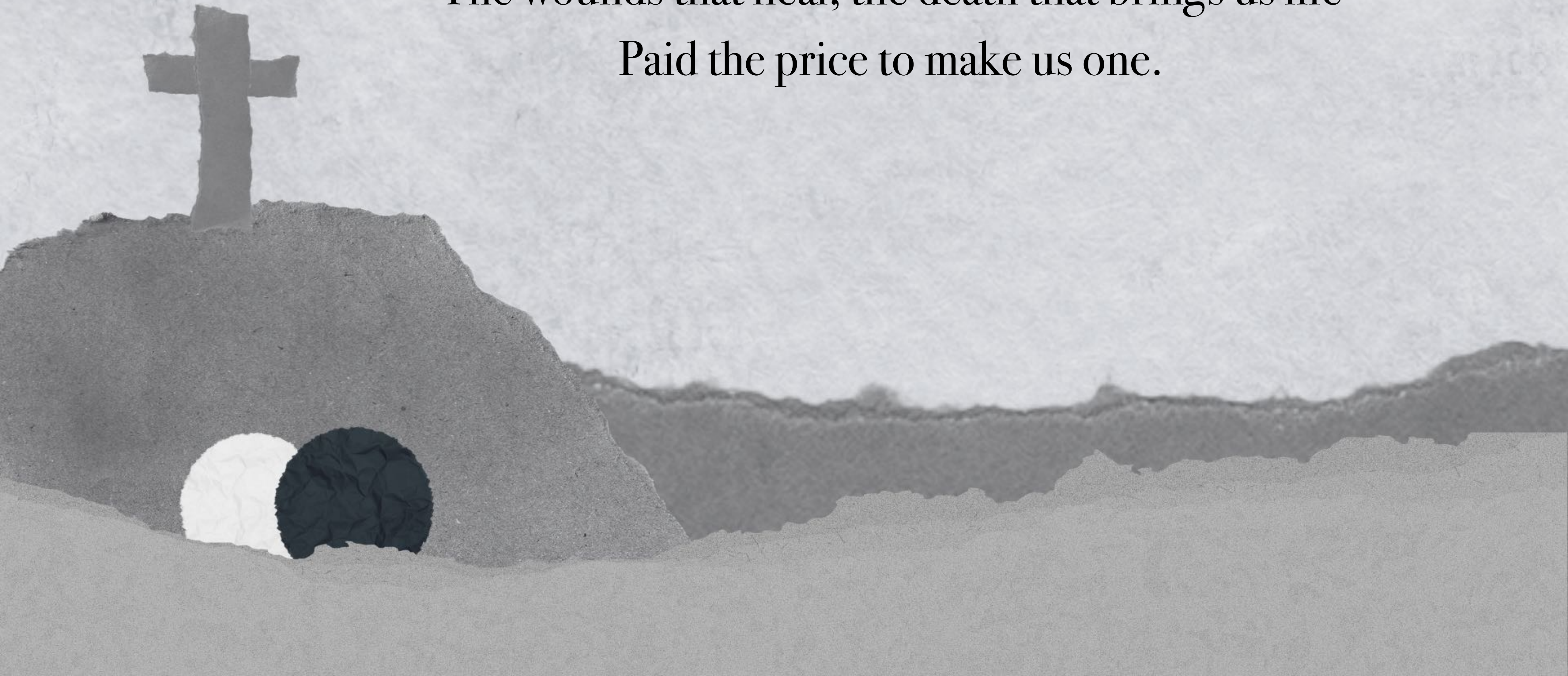
Find forgiveness at the cross.

Around the table of the King.



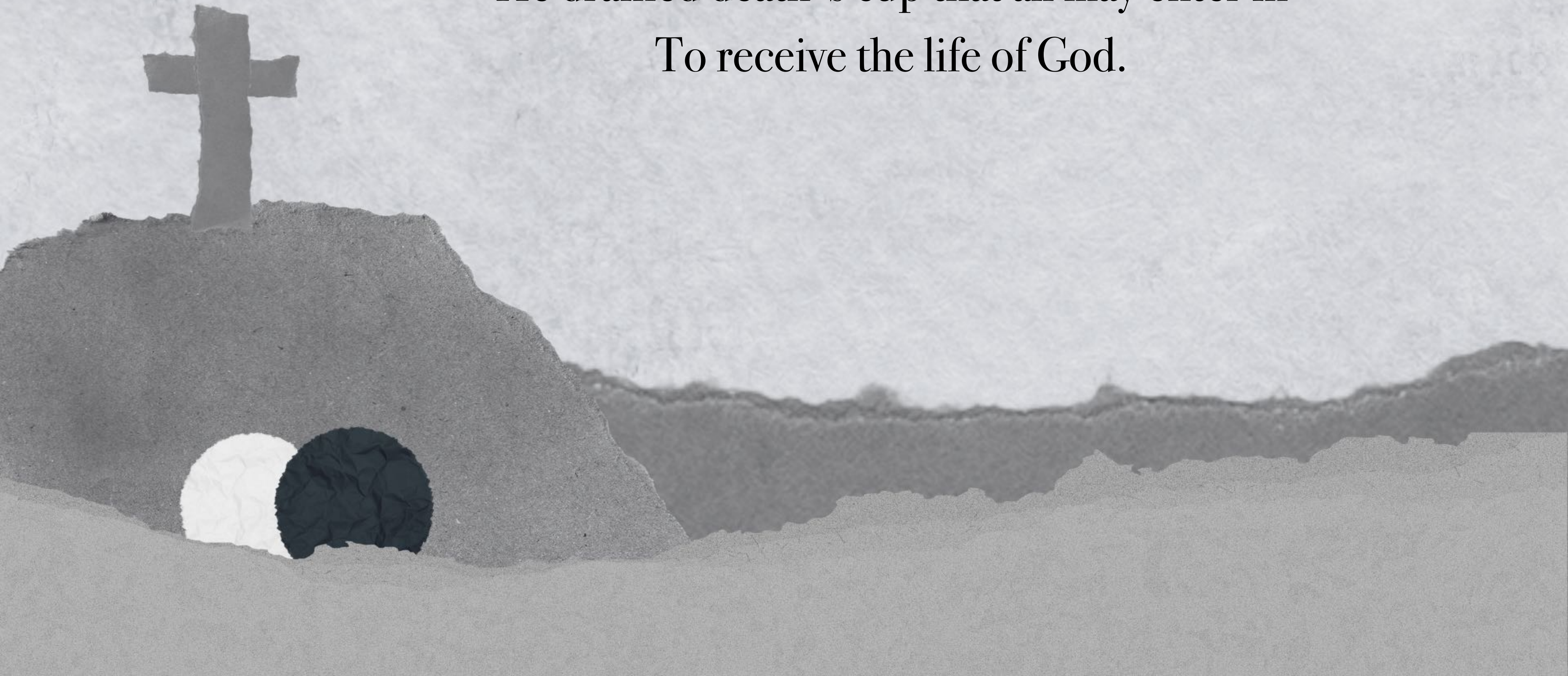
The body of our Savior Jesus Christ,

Around the table of the King.



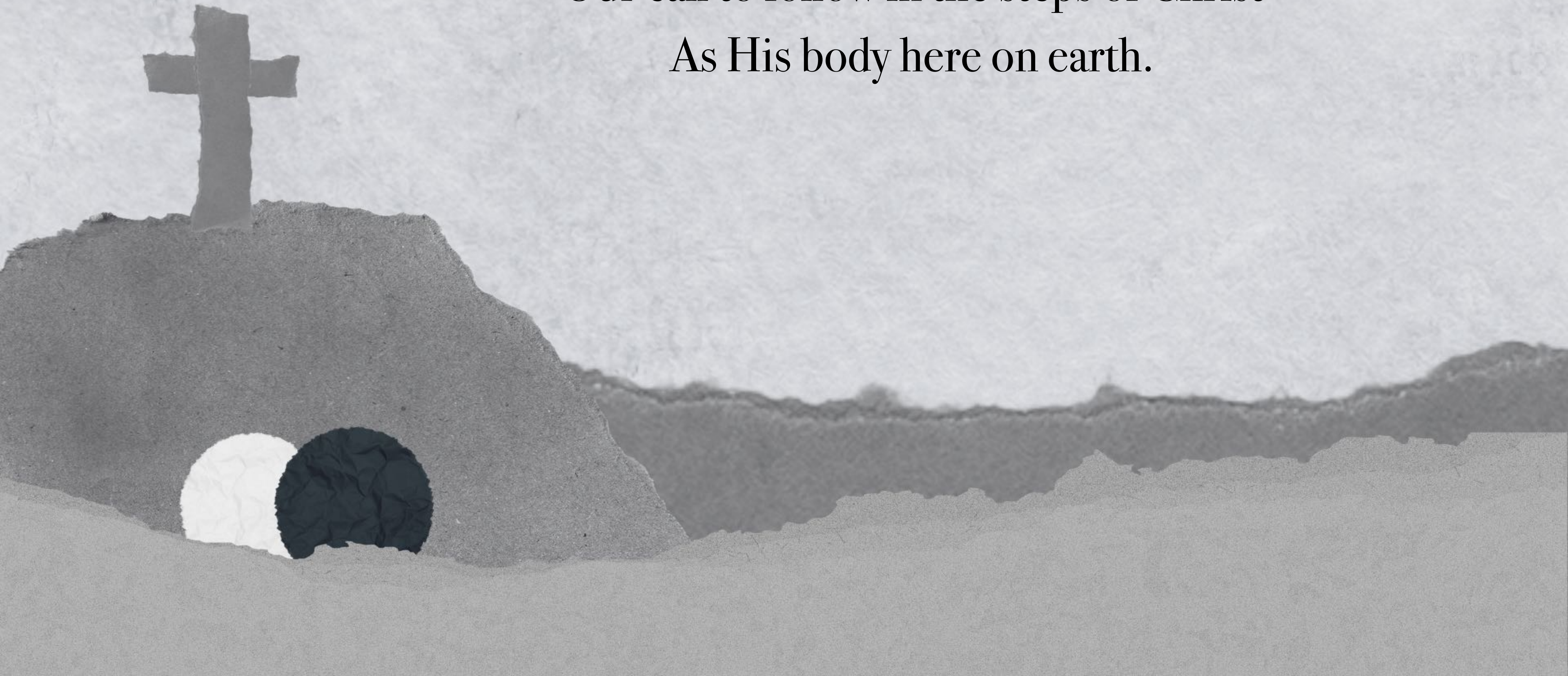
The blood that cleanses every stain of sin,
