Only my Holy God!





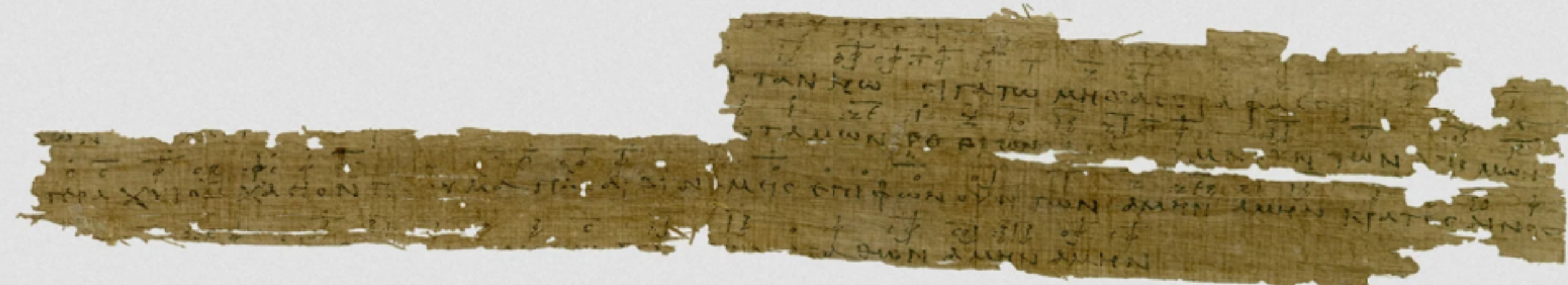
