For He dwells in the presence of His people.



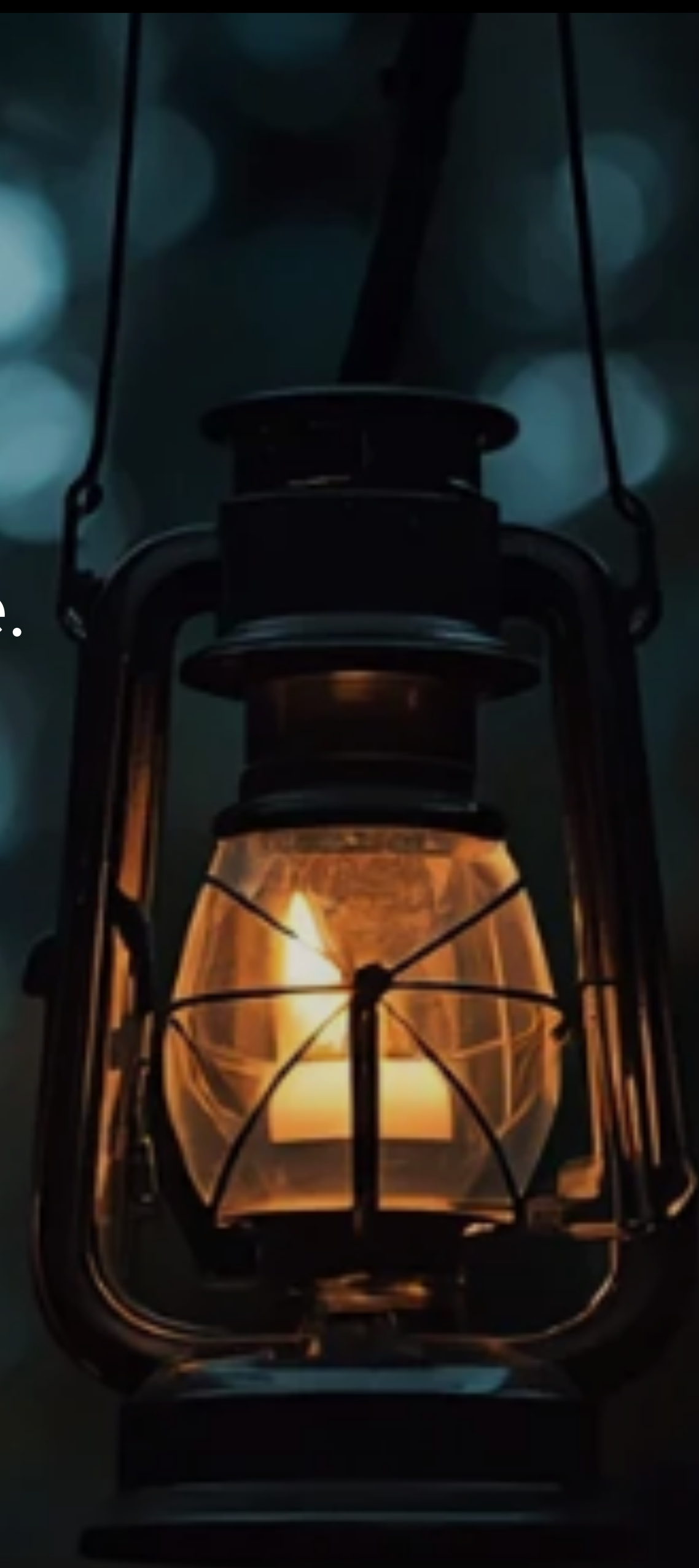
Oh how good it is
