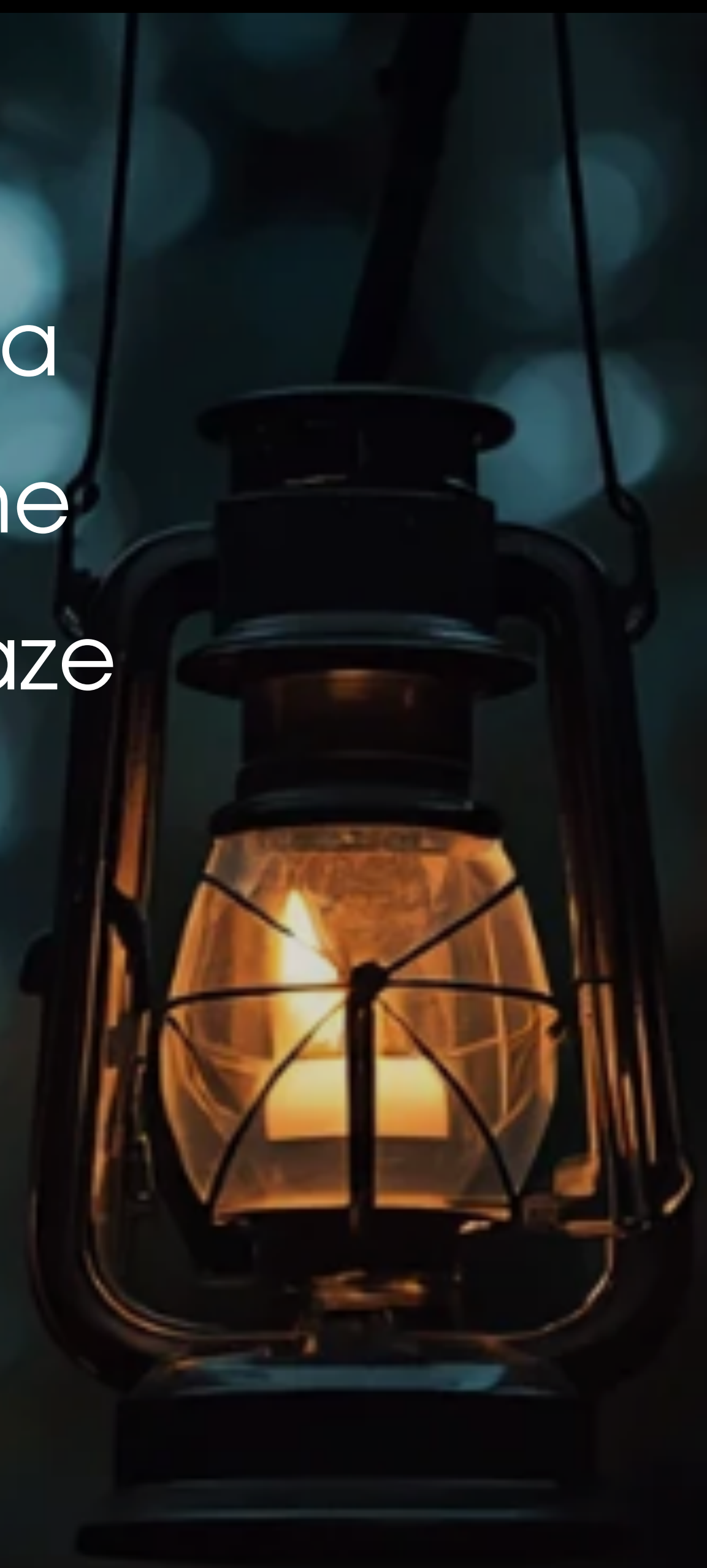

he does not deal harshly with us, as we deserve.

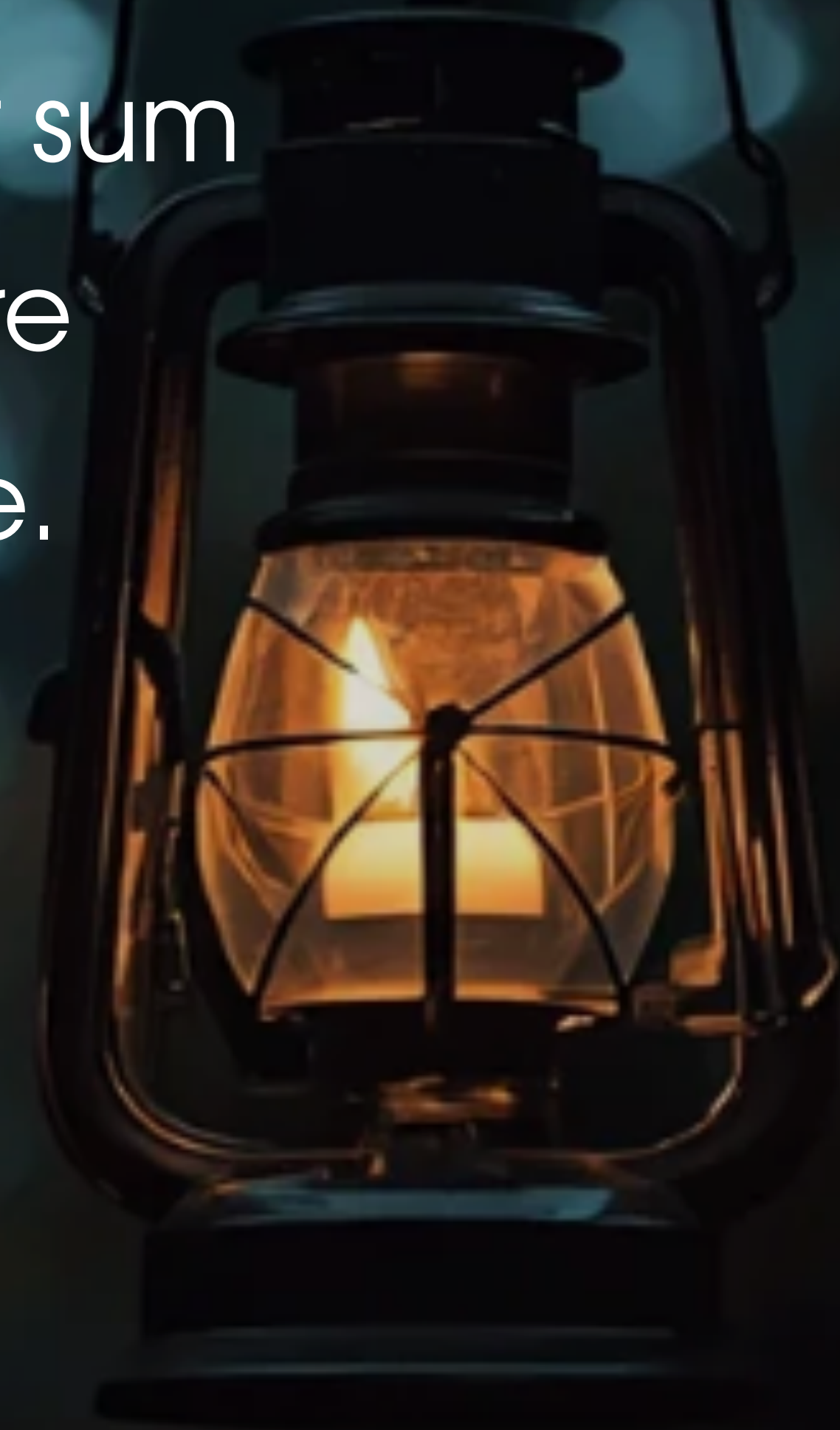

Our sins they are many, His mercy is more

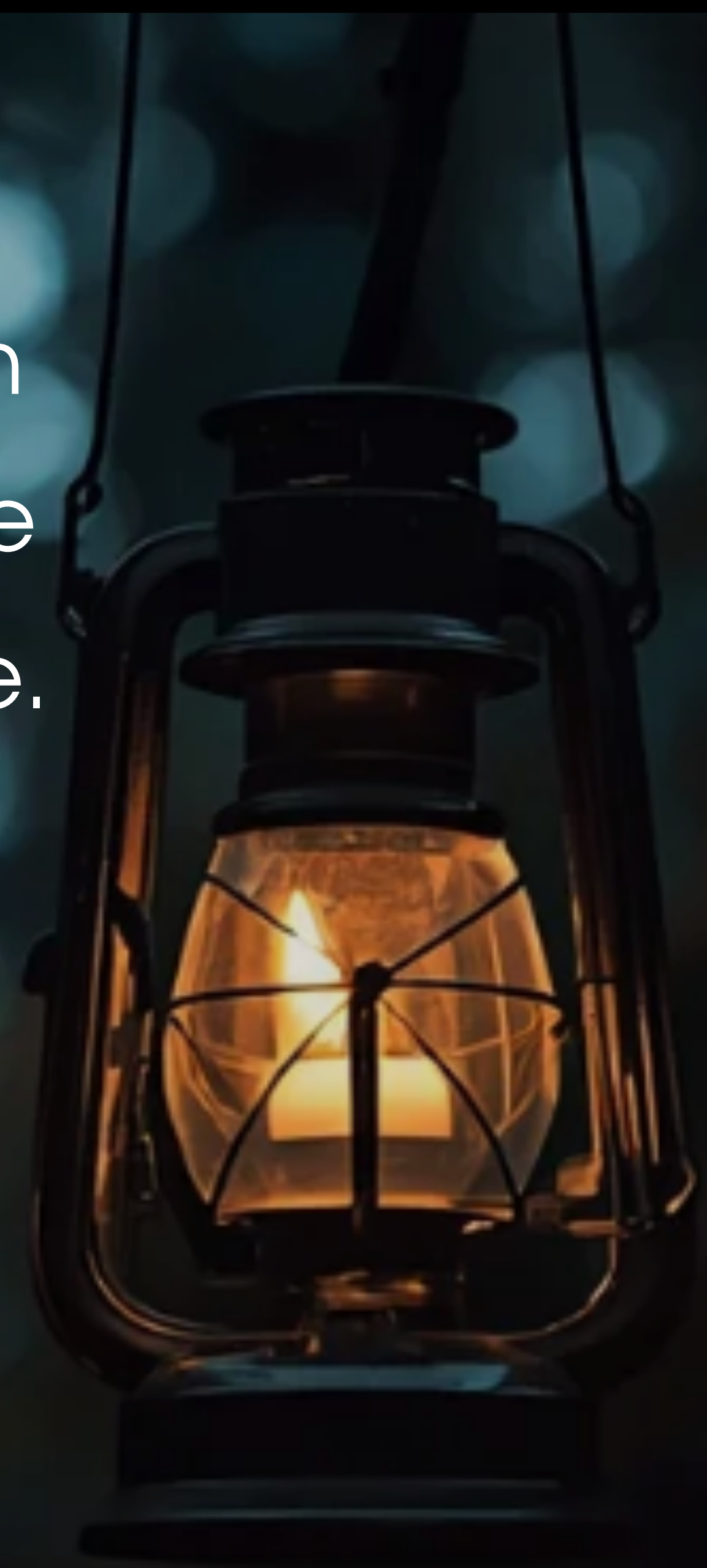
