I stand in the Gospel of Jesus Christ



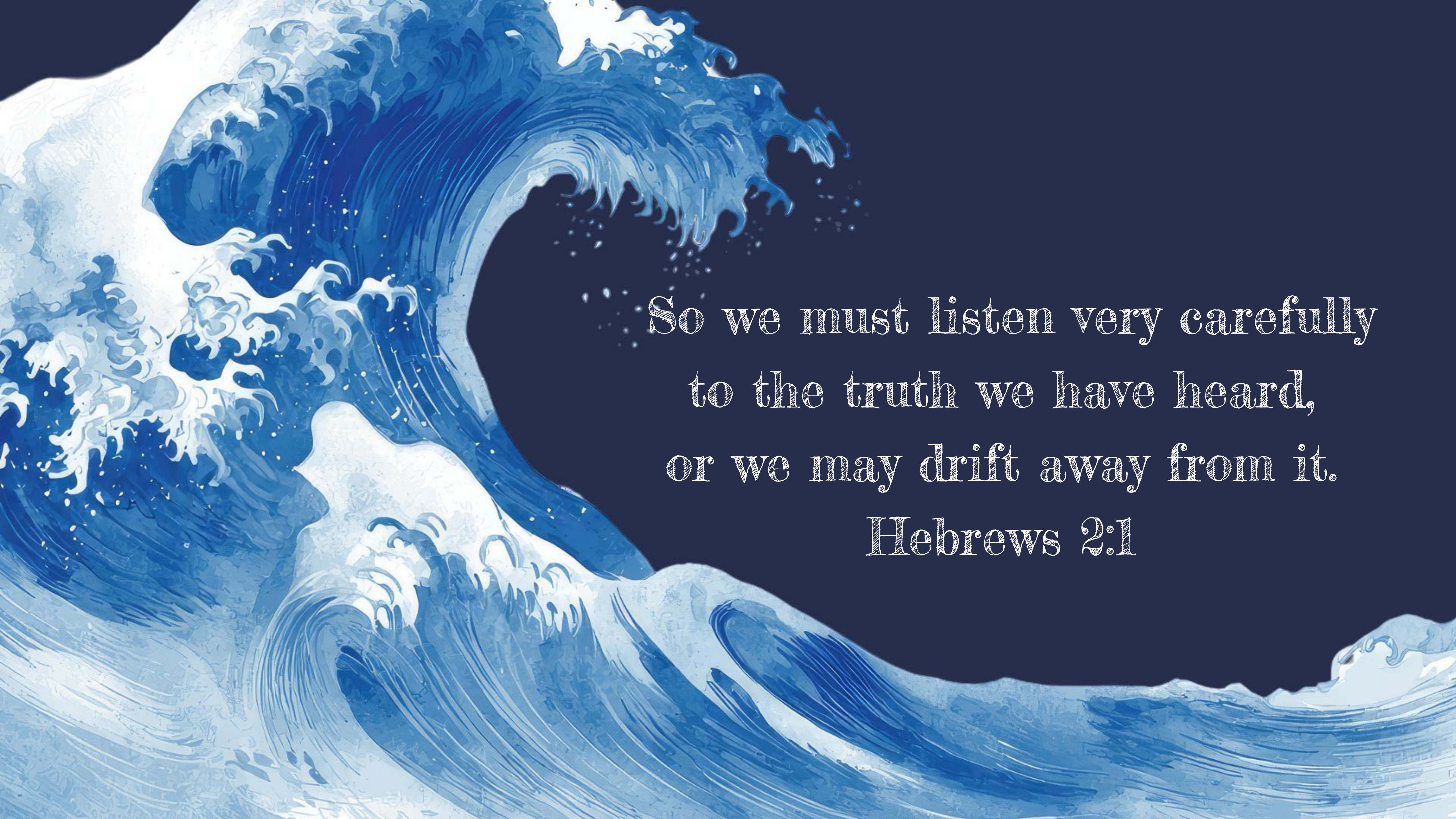
